AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED, "AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH THE WATER DEPARTMENT OF THE BOROUGH OF ELMWOOD PARK, BERGEN COUNTY, NEW JERSEY, TO FIX THE RATES AND PRICES TO BE CHARGED FOR THE USE OF WATER AND ESTABLISH RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE DISTRIBUTION, SUPPLY, USE AND PROTECTION OF SAID WATER AND PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION OF CERTAIN SAID RULES AND REGULATIONS.

WHEREAS, due to a aggregate 4 % increase in water consumption from bulk water supplier, Passaic Valley Water Commission, the following is necessary;

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Council, of the Borough of Elmwood Park as follows:

Section 1 A fixed charge known as "the service charge," will be made to each Consumer for each meter based on the size of the meter or connection regardless of the amount of water consumed as follows:

5/8 in. Meter (average 1 and 2 family homes)	\$44.51
¾ in. Meter	\$50.06
1 in. Meter	\$53.40

Section 2: The following water rates and changes are hereby established for water supplied by the Department.

The minimum quarterly bill for metered service shall be "the service charge" entitling the consumer to 5,000 gallons of water per quarter. All water supplied through meters in excess of the minimum quarterly bill, shall be charged to each consumer at the rate of:

\$4.91 per 1,000 gallons over 5,000 gallons

\$5.33 per 1,000 gallons over 70,000 gallons

\$6.05 per 1,000 gallons over 150,000 gallons

\$6.49 per 1,000 gallons over 300,000 gallons

Installation, replacement, and repair of existing meters shall be charged at actual current cost for labor and material incurred by the Water Department of the Borough of Elmwood Park and/or Passaic Valley Water Commission.

F. All commercial users having meters in excess of 3/4" must have them in working order at all times. In the event said meter is inoperative, and no attempt is made for repair/replacement of same, the existing estimated bill shall be tripled the existing estimated rate, upon the effective date of this ordinance. In the event no meter in excess of 3/4" exist, in addition to the tripled estimated bill, the landlord shall be required to purchase and install same upon written order of the Superintendent of Public Works.

Section 4: "In the event that payment for water charges is in arrears for 30 days from date of billing, the Borough shall send a delinquent notice regular mail, to the owner, occupier, user or responsible party being billed. After 60 days, a door tag shall be hand delivered to terminate water service. On the 67th day of non payment from date of billing, water service will be terminated, and not reinstated until all fees, penalties, are paid in full in cash.

\$137.13 turn on fee, is made to the Borough of Elmwood Park.

Section 4b: "In the event, that water charges are in the arrears, after 60 days, a door tag will be delivered to terminate water service and a fee of \$40.00 will be assessed on to the delinquent water bill.

Section 5: All unpaid water charges as of 12/31 of the present year shall become a Tax Lien on said premises.

Section 6: All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with or in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict or inconsistency. This shall take effect after final passage and publication as required by law.

Section 7: All billings as of March 1, 2016 and thereafter will be subject to said rate.

CAPITAL ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF ELMWOOD PARK, IN THE COUNTY OF BERGEN, NEW JERSEY, AUTHORIZING THE REHABILITATION OF THE HOCKEY RINK AT THE RECREATION CENTER IN, BY AND FOR THE BOROUGH, APPROPRIATING THEREFOR THE SUM OF \$133,640 AND PROVIDING THAT SUCH SUM SO APPROPRIATED SHALL BE RAISED FROM THE BOROUGH'S RESERVE FOR RECREATION EXPENDITURES.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park, in the County of Bergen, New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1. The Borough of Elmwood Park, in the County of Bergen, New Jersey (the "Borough") is hereby authorized to rehabilitate the Hockey Rink at the Recreation Center in, by and for the Borough. Said improvement shall include all work, materials and appurtenances necessary and suitable therefor.

Section 2. The sum of \$133,640 is hereby appropriated to the payment of the cost of the improvement authorized and described in Section 1 hereof (hereinafter referred to as "purpose"). Said appropriation shall be raised from the Borough's Reserve for Recreation Expenditures, as hereinafter provided. The sum of \$133,640 is hereby appropriated from the Borough's Reserve for Recreation Expenditures to the payment of the cost of said purpose. It is anticipated that the Borough shall receive a \$54,320 grant from the Bergen County Open Space, Recreation, Floodplain Protection, Farmland and Historic Preservation Trust Fund to finance the cost of said purpose. Any of said grant funds so received shall be used to reimburse the Borough's Reserve for Recreation Expenditures.

Section 3. Said improvement is a lawful capital improvement of the Borough having a period of usefulness of at least five (5) years. Said improvement shall be made as a general improvement, no part of the cost of which shall be assessed against property specially benefited.

Section 4. The capital budget is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this capital ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency therewith and the resolutions promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing full detail of the amended capital budget and capital

program as approved by the Director, Division of Local Government Services, is on file with the Borough Clerk and is available for public inspection.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect at the time and in the manner provided by law.

Section 1. Chapter II of the Code of the Borough of Elmwood Park, entitled "Administration" is hereby amended, and specifically Ordinance 2-27.1, titled "Creation of the Department; Members" by deleting the existing section and replacing it with the following:

2-27.1 Creation of the Department; Members.

- There are hereby created the following positions in the Police Department of the Borough of Elmwood Park:

 - 4. Four (4) Sergeants.
 - 5. A maximum of twenty-nine (29) Patrolmen.
- In order to provide for a safe and efficient transition when a member or members of the police force give notice of their intent to retire/resign, there shall be permitted a maximum of two additional Patrolmen (in addition to the number of Patrolmen set forth in a. 5 above) who may be employed for a maximum of six months for the purpose of training and familiarization with police procedures.

Notwithstanding the limitations set forth above, no officer who is currently employed by the Borough shall be removed from his position or reduced in rank as a result of this Table of Organization.

Section 2. If any part of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of the Ordinance.

Section 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed or amended to the extent of such inconsistency.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect upon final passage and publication according to law.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

Councilman Martino discussed the incident last evening with one of our Police Officers who was hurt in the line of duty. He stated that our Police Officers never know what will happen on their shift. He also asked anyone who may have additional information about the event to contact the Police Department.

Councilman Chirdo echoed Councilman Martino's statement about Officer Nichols. He further congratulated those who received awards tonight for life saving actions. He discussed in detail the DPW snow removal operation during the recent blizzard. He also discussed what residents can do to help during a snow storm. Councilman Chirdo also reported on recent water main breaks, one of which was on school property and it was corrected within 24 hours by the Department of Public Works.

Councilman Colletti congratulated those who received the lifesaving awards tonight and the situation with the raccoon attack. He further reported on the Recreation Advisory Board meeting and how the hockey rink will be constructed at Borough Field while maintaining the basketball area. Councilman Colletti announced the upcoming JIF safety breakfast. He also discussed the Fire Departments efforts to clear hydrants of snow.

Council President Vuoncino discussed a letter sent home to school parents regarding inappropriate photos being sent electronically. He addressed parents' responsibility in protecting their children. Council President Vuoncino stated that the Mayor and Council did meet with the Library Board tonight. He will continue to press for data to support their project and for transparency. He congratulated those who received awards this evening.

Councilman Dombrowski congratulated those who received awards. He addressed the raccoon attack and the Police Officer who was injured. He reported on the Board of Health's actions following the raccoon incident. Councilman Dombrowski reported on the Chamber of Commerce meeting and on the recent Homeowner's Association meeting with the Police Department. He discussed his experience driving around town early on Sunday after the snow storm and the streets being passable. Tom Conboy, Tuella Avenue discussed the joint meeting with the Library Board and asked whether any Council members had a relationship with the architect hired by the Library Board. Councilwoman Giandomenico responded that she worked on a professional basis with the architect when she worked for the County. Mr. Conboy asked whether there were any Council members who have relatives working at the library. Councilwoman Giandomenico responded that her brother works for the library. Mr. Conboy spoke about the dynamics changing at with

the Library Board and the proposed project. He wants to see the project get done and discussed his concerns about the progress. He then read from a campaign newspaper about limiting time at the Council meeting public hearing. He expressed his concern about the time limit. Mr. Conboy discussed the solid waste and recycling bin discussion at the previous work session and how he feels the many discussions are tied to Councilman Dombrowski being up for re-election. Discussion as to broken garbage cans on Market Street ensued.
