AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING A REDEVELOPMENT PLAN FOR BLOCK 1808, LOTS 7 & 9, IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE LOCAL REDEVELOPMENT AND HOUSING LAW

WHEREAS, in accordance with the Local Redevelopment and Housing Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:12A-1 et. seq. (the "Redevelopment Law") by Resolution 303-21, the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park directed the Elmwood Park Planning Board (the "Planning Board") to undertake a preliminary investigation to determine whether Block 1808, Lots 7 & 9 qualify as an area in need of redevelopment as defined in N.J.S.A. 40A:12A-14; and

WHEREAS, at the conclusion of its preliminary investigations in accordance with the Redevelopment Law, on December 8, 2021 the Planning Board determined Block 1808, Lots 7 & 9 to be areas in need of redevelopment, and recommending that the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park designate the areas as such; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council adopted Resolution 105-22 on February 17, 2022 concurring with the Planning Board's findings and designated Block 1808, Lots 7 & 9 as an area in need of redevelopment as defined in N.J.S.A. 40A:12A-14; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the resolution designating Block 1808, Lots 7 & 9 as an area in need of redevelopment, the Borough authorized the Borough Planners, DMR Architects, to prepare a Redevelopment Plan for Block 1808, Lots 7 & 9 dated May 2023, a copy of which is attached hereto and made part of this Ordinance (the "Redevelopment Plan") and which shall be referred to the Planning Board for its review and consideration pursuant to NJSA 40A:12A-7 and 15; and

WHEREAS, prior to the adoption of the Redevelopment Plan, the Planning Board shall within 45 days after referral by the Borough Council, transmit to the Borough Mayor and Council, a report containing its recommendation concerning the redevelopment plan pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:12A-7 & 15; and

WHEREAS, upon receipt of the Planning Board's recommendation or if the Planning Board fails to transmit a recommendation within 45 days after referral, the Borough Mayor and Council shall act upon this Ordinance adopting the Redevelopment Plan pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:12A-7; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the Borough that Block 1808, Lots 7 & 9 be redeveloped in accordance with the Redevelopment Plan; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park, County of Bergen, State of New Jersey, as follows:

1. Adoption of Redevelopment Plan.

The Mayor and Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park hereby adopts the Redevelopment Plan entitled, "401-407 Route 46 Redevelopment Plan" dated May 2023 as the redevelopment plan for Block 1808, Lots 7 & 9.

2. <u>Amendment of Zoning Map</u>

The Zoning Map of the Borough of Elmwood Park, adopted as Ordinance _____ referred to in Section _____ of the Zoning Ordinance, is hereby amended to reflect the Redevelopment Plan and to provide for Block 1808, Lot 7 & 9.

3. <u>Redevelopment Entity</u>

The Mayor and Council hereby declares that it, without the designation of any other redevelopment entity as defined in the Redevelopment Law, shall exercise all of the powers and discharge all of the duties of the redevelopment entity for purposes of clearance, re-planning, development and redevelopment of Block 1808, Lots 7 & 9 without limiting the generality of the foregoing, shall be the sole body empowered by the Borough to enter into redevelopment agreements with redevelopers subject to such limitations and requirements as are prescribed by the Redevelopment Law.

4. Procedures for Amendment of Redevelopment Plan

This Redevelopment Plan may be amended from time to time, by the Mayor and Council, upon the compliance with all requirements of all applicable law.

5. <u>Severability</u>

If any section, sentence or any other part of this Ordinance is adjudged unconstitutional or invalid, such judgment shall not affect, impair or invalidate the remainder of this Ordinance but shall be confined in its effect to the section, sentence or other part of this Ordinance directly involved in the controversy in which such judgment is rendered.

6. Inconsistent Ordinance Repealed

All other ordinances or parts of Ordinances which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed, but only to the extent of such inconsistencies.

7. Effective Date

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage and publication as provided by law.

Beginning of the twelfth year to the completion of the fourteenth year	4%
Beginning of the fifteenth year to the completion of the twentieth year	5%
Beginning of the twenty-first year to the completion of the twenty-fourth year	6%
Beginning of the twenty-fifth year	8%

2. Any employee hired after January 1, 2007, shall not be entitled to longevity.

3. Such payments shall be added to each employee's base annual salary.

4. The anniversary date for payroll purposes only for all employees of the Borough of Elmwood Park after having completed one full year of employment shall be January 1.

SECTION V: SICK LEAVE

1. All full-time employees shall be compensated annually for up to (15) days of absence from work by reason of illness. All sick leave shall be accumulated and any unused portion thereof shall be applied toward future illness.

2. Part-time employees hired on or after October 29, 2018, per guidelines of the "Sick Leave Act" shall be compensated for a time as per hours worked, up to a maximum of 40 total hours per calendar year. Sick leave time will be available for use 120 days after the first day of employment.

SECTION VI: HOLIDAY & PERSONAL DAYS

All Borough employees for whom there is provided herein an annual compensation shall be excused from the performance of their duties with the continuance of pay on the following days:

In the event that a holiday falls on a Sunday, the following Monday shall be observed as the holiday. In the event that a holiday falls on a Saturday, the preceding Friday shall be observed as the holiday.

This section shall not apply to part-time employees who are compensated on an hourly basis.

SECTION VII: VACATION

All full-time employees shall be allowed vacation leave from their employment with the continuance of compensation provided herein, in accordance with the following schedule:

First-year through five years of service	12 days
Completion of the fifth year to ten years of service	12 days plus 1 day for each year up to 17 days
Completion of ten years of service	21 days
Completion of twelve years of service	22 days
Completion of fourteen years of service	23 days
Completion of sixteen years of service	24 days
Completion of eighteen years of service	25 days
Completion of twenty years of service and thereafter	30 days

2. All employees hired after January 1, 2007, cannot accumulate vacation days other than accrued days from (1) year prior.

SECTION VIII: TERMINAL LEAVE

1. All employees hired prior to January 1, 1991, that desire to enter into retirement shall receive terminal leave immediately prior to said retirement provided said employee notified the Borough prior to February 15th of the year he/she intends to retire. PERS will then be notified and the retirement application of the employee will be processed. Such leaves shall be computed at the following rate:

1 to 7 years	1 month
8 to 14 years	2 months
15 to 21 years	3 months
22 years and over	4 months

2. In addition to leaving granted above, each employee shall receive enumeration for ½ of all accumulated sick days from January 1, 1962, immediately prior to the retirement of such employee with a maximum accumulation of 120 working days.

WHEREAS, The Mayor and Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park have become aware that when a license is inactivated and or is temporarily retired, known and referred to as "POCKETING," there is no procedure to investigate that the premises where the license was used no longer continue the activity of the sale of alcohol; and

WHEREAS, The Mayor and Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park are very concerned that without an investigation of the premises to ensure that in the facilities, alcoholic beverages are longer served or sold or in any form continues to serve, sell or distributed such alcoholic beverages without the existing license; and

WHEREAS, The Mayor and Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park have determined that there needs to be an assurance that such violation of the sale, distribution, and or consumption of alcoholic beverage in violation of the licensing laws of the State of New Jersey and the municipal alcoholic beverage control ordinance.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park, in the County of Bergen, in the State of New Jersey, that Chapter VI of the Code of the Borough of Elmwood Park more specifically Sections 6-4 is

hereby amended to incorporate the following new section:

Chapter VI of the code entitled Alcoholic Beverages Control.

Section 6-4.9 ENTITLE INACTIVATED-TEMPORARILY RETIREMENT OF LICENSE "POCKET" LICENSE.

- a. When any license issued by the issuing authority, is presented to the agent of the municipal authority for the purpose of inactivation and or retiring from use, referred to as "Pocketing" the party owning said licenses shall certify that the premises where said license was used in no longer active and no alcoholic beverages are present on said premises and further that the activity of selling said alcoholic beverages, distributing or consumption of same is no longer practiced and that such activity is no longer perused.
- **b.** The agent of the Municipal authority shall at such time of accepting the license for inactivation or retiring referred to as "pocketing" shall forthwith contact the responsible assigned agent in the Police Department and advise and make that person aware of the for inactivation or retiring referred to as "pocketing."
- **c.** The assigned agent of the Police Department vested with the investigative role of investigating all issuances of alcoholic beverage licenses the duty to investigate and ensure that the premises where the license was used no longer serve, sell, distribute, or serve Alcoholic beverages in any form.
- **d.** Any violation of consumption, distribution, sale, or service of alcoholic beverage where a license was inactivated and or retired "Pocketed" shall be a violation of the license and will subject the owner of said license to fines and suspensions and or revocation of said license in violation to the laws of the state of New Jersey and Local municipal Ordinance.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that all other terms and provisions of Chapter VI of the Borough Code shall remain unchanged.

Construction Official shall, with the advice of the subcode officials, prepare and submit to the Mayor and Borough Council bi-annually, a report recommending a fee schedule based on the operating expenses of the agency, and any other expenses of the municipality fairly attributable to the enforcement of the State Uniform Construction Code Act.

7. In order to provide for the training, certification, and technical support programs required by the Uniform Construction Code Act and the Regulations, the Enforcing Agency shall collect, in addition to the fees specified above, a surcharge fee of <u>\$0.00371</u> per cubic foot of volume of new construction <u>and \$1.90 per</u> <u>1,000 of volume of construction</u>. Said surcharge fee shall be remitted to the Bureau of Housing Inspection, Department of Community Affairs, on a quarterly basis for the fiscal quarter ending September 30, December 31, March 31, and June 30 and not later than one month next succeeding the end of the quarter for which it is due. In the fiscal year in which the Regulations first become effective, said fee shall be collected and remitted for the third and fourth quarters only.

8. The Enforcing Agency shall report annually at the end of each fiscal year to the Bureau of Housing Inspection, and not later than July 31, the total amount of the surcharge fees collected in the fiscal year. When The Regulations first become effective in the fiscal year, the report shall be for the third and fourth quarters only.


