



ELMWOOD PARK COVID 19 - COMMUNITY OUTREACH

The Elmwood Park Residents Assistance Program (RAP), Elmwood Park PBA Local 185 and members of the EPPD Command Staff have partnered together to spearhead an initiative to help families who have been impacted financially by the COVID-19 situation.

As a joint effort, we were able to raise \$2,000.00 and purchased (80) \$25.00 food gift certificates that will be provided to families in need.
