Donations

Donations of food and personal products for the pantry are accepted year-round. For large donations, please call before delivery.

Monetary donations are accepted and checks should be made payable to "Residents Assistance Program".

Non-perishable food and personal product donations can be dropped off Monday- Friday, 8:30 a.m. - 4:00p.m. at Borough Hall, 182 Market Street Ave. There is a bin directly inside of the back Lobby Entrance to the building. Please do not leave any foods that need to be refrigerated or frozen.

Right now, physical donations are best. Gift card donations (\$20/\$25 increments are best) can either be mailed to the above-mentioned address or dropped in the metal payment box in lobby marked Residents Assistance Program /The People's Pantry.
