WHEREAS, the litigation relates to a public records request Gannett Satellite Information Network, LLC made to the Borough under the Open Public Records Act and the common law; and

WHEREAS, the Borough and Gannett Satellite Information Network have negotiated a settlement that fully resolves the litigation by way of the Borough's provision of redacted records and \$2,000.00 in attorneys' fees to Gannett, in exchange for Gannett's dismissal of the pending litigation; and

WHEREAS, settlement of the pending litigation will avoid the significant expenditure of resources and costs on the part of the Borough which would be necessitated by continued litigation of the pending matter; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Mayor and Council hereby approves settlement of the pending litigation; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor and Council authorize the appropriate personnel from the Borough's administration to implement the terms of settlement, including payment of the \$2000.00 attorneys' fees to Gannett Satellite Information Network and executing and/or filing appropriate settlement documents, in conjunction with and under the direction of the Borough's Special Counsel handling the litigation.
