AN ORDINANCE AMENDING Article 2 of the Borough of Elmwood Park titled "Offices Created."

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park that Ordinance 2-7.3 titled "Compensation Additional." is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 1. The Municipal Clerk shall receive compensation as fixed annually by the Borough Council. In addition, when the Municipal Clerk is required to be present at an election or election related matter during a time when other Municipal employees are off, such as late night voter registration, primary election day and general election day, he or she will receive additional pay at such time equal to the time spent working outside of the regular work day.



AN ORDINANCE AMENDING Chapter II the Code of the Borough of Elmwood Park, titled "Administration" by establishing a new ordinance 2-60 to be titled "Volunteer Ambulance Corps Stipend".

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park as follows:

Section 1. The Code of the Borough of Elmwood Park is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section, to be known as 2-60 to read as follows:

2-60 VOLUNTEER AMBULANCE CORPS. STIPEND

- a. The personnel of the Volunteer Ambulance Corps shall be entitled to a stipend of \$20.00 per daytime call.
- b. The Ambulance Corps Chief and/or Officer shall certify to the amount of the stipend earned by each number on a quarterly basis and shall submit same to the Chief Financial Officer. Said list shall include the name, date of service and time of service for each call which payment is requested.

Section 2. If any part of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

Section 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed or amended to the extent of such inconsistency.



COMMITTEE REPORTS

Councilman Caramagna thanked Senator Pou for aiding Elmwood Park in receiving a Streetscape Improvement Grant. Councilman Caramagna discussed an increase in the attendance at the latest Homeowners Association meeting. He further discussed an upcoming Mount Airy bus trip through the Homeowners Association.

Councilman Conboy reminded residents that registration is still open for the Recreation Summer Camp. Councilman Conboy discussed a Splash Night on June 28, 2013 in which the spray park will be open and the night will be concluded with a showing of Finding Nemo. Refreshments will be available for purchase. Councilman Conboy discussed the registration for the Bombers Football and Cheerleading teams. He encouraged residents to become involved.

Councilman Vuoncino commended the Police Department in the investigation and the subsequent arrest for the threat made to the High School. He further discussed upcoming meetings between the Police Department and the District to review the procedures that took place during the investigation so changes or improvements can be discussed. Councilman Vuoncino discussed the recent Sergeant's exam which took place. He further discussed a total of 13 officers took the exam to fill the one open position in the Police Department. Councilman Vuoncino discussed the pedestrian crossing near the Broadway train station. The Borough received a letter stating that the Department of Transportation will continue with the Borough of Elmwood Park and the Borough of Fair Lawn to install a hawk light at the crossing. Councilman Vuoncino discussed an article called "D-Day Greatest Lesson".

Councilman Castiglia discussed two applications that came before the Planning Board. Councilman Castiglia discussed how the streets are selected to be included in the Road Resurfacing Program. He further discussed the selection of alternate roads. Councilman Castiglia discussed attending a Community Development meeting with Mayor Mola in hopes to secure \$172,000 to improve Orange Avenue. He further stated that the Borough will be receiving the full \$172,000. Councilman Castiglia reminded residents of the weekly Bingo that is held at the American Legion on Tuesday nights.

Councilman Pettigano reported that approximately 100 people attended the free rabies vaccination clinic. Councilman Pettigano stated sighting of the coyotes have begun again. He stated that sign warning residents of their presence should be considered. Mayor Mola pointed out that Ms. Milsap from the Community News was present and commented that possibly a story in the Community News could notify residents of the coyotes. Mayor Mola stated that he saw a coyote that was bald near the hind legs and tail. Councilman Pettigano stated that is mange and raises concern as to the health of the animals.

Councilman Colletti discussed the length of time that issues such as the pedestrian crossing on Broadway can take to resolve. He further discussed the steps that were taken to keep the process moving in resolving the crosswalk. Councilman stated that perseverance has made it possible to get the Broadway pedestrian walk the Hawk light that is needed. Councilman Colletti discussed the memorial service at the Fireman's Memorial. Councilman Colletti thanked Ms. Puglisi and the Recreation Department for Community Day.

Mayor Mola discussed a letter that he just received requesting a block party on Speidel Avenue. Mayor Mola discussed the Community Development funds for paving Orange Avenue. Mayor Mola discussed a park-n-ride located at the end of Locus Street in which the State has responded funds are not available for the project. Mayor Mola discussed the revamp of the intersection of River Road and River Drive which is being funded by the Freeholders. Mayor Mola discussed the upcoming heavy rains and the all work that has been done with Fleischer's Brook to reduce flooding. He reported the Department of Public Works have removed waste from stream such as televisions and asked that such items be disposed of properly. Mayor Mola discussed the hazardous crossing by the Broadway train station. Mayor Mola followed up on Councilman Vuoncino's comments regarding D-Day. He mentioned the experience of Former Fire Prevention Official Jack McGrath. He stated soldiers from World War II do not typically discuss their experiences from the war. Jack McGrath's experiences were mentioned in the book and the movie Band of Brothers. He further discussed a gentleman, Joseph Brix, who was the topic of an article in which he maintains the gravesite of an American soldier named Vincent Miles. Mayor Mola stated that he presented Mr. Brix with a plaque in which a Borough street was named after him to be placed on his gravesite. Mayor Mola shared the story of Vincent Miles explaining he parachuted into Holland. On his descent his parachute became caught in trees and Mr. Miles was then shot. Mayor Mola further stated that Mr. Miles gave so much to so many people even though his feet never touched European soil.

PUBLIC COMMENT

Steven Conti, Market Street, asked about the status of the County Park and the Library. Mayor Mola stated that the County stated that they would only clean up to ten feet into the park from the curb. He further stated the County owns the park and should be responsible for more than ten feet. The Borough has been promised funds by the County for the park and Mayor Mola assured Mr. Conte that the Borough will


keep approaching the County regarding the funds. Mr. Conte inquired about Fleischer's Brook and inquired if the brook in Garfield has been cleaned. Mayor Mola stated the Borough is working with Garfield to procure Community Development funds to keep Fleischer's Brook cleared in Garfield as well. Mr. Conte inquired if the paving of Market Street is on hold and when will the work at the intersection of Market Street and Boulevard commence. Mr. Giblin stated that three of the four corner properties the Borough have reached agreements on the easements. He is working with the fourth owner and is hopeful an agreement will be reached soon. Mr. Conte inquired if that intersection is where the clock will be placed. Mr. Conte inquired if there is a Resource Officer at the High School. Mayor Mola stated there is not. Mr. Conte inquired about putting a speed bump on Broadway. Mayor Mola stated that would be up to the Department of Transportation. Councilman Vuoncino stated that the State ruled out bump outs because they did not feel they would be effective. Mr. Conte inquired about the process of cleaning out the fallen trees and branches along River Drive. Mr. Conte asked if he would be able to fill in the pot holes on Terrace Street. Mayor Mola stated if it's a Borough road the Department of Public Works will patch the holes. Mr. Conte asked if the number of calls the Police received in the first half of the year is available. Councilman Vuoncino stated he would need to speak with the Chief of Police. Mr. Conte inquired as to the number of the abandoned properties within the Borough. Councilman Castiglia stated he believes the Department of Public Work's count was ten. Mr. Kazmark stated that a new law has been put into effect, whereas the bank is responsible to send notification to the Borough Clerk and those letters are maintained in the Clerk's office. However, having a letter on file does not necessarily mean the property is not being maintained. Therefore the Building Inspector determines if the homes are not being maintained. For properties that are not maintained efforts are made to contact the bank, when all fails the Department of Public Works maintain the property and a lien will be placed on the property and must be satisfied at the time of sale. Mr. Conte inquired when the next phase of the Riverfront apartments will begin. Mayor Mola stated that it is slated to begin. Mr. Conte discussed his thoughts on different properties within the Borough and his opinion on how they could have been utilized. He believes that the Borough has missed some opportunities. Mayor Mola stated that the Hillman property was made to be for business however COAH overturned the Borough's ruling. Mayor Mola commented on an accusation by members of the Paterson Council in which the Borough along with other municipalities have been accused of urban profiling. Mayor Mola stated this is due the traffic stops that are performed on Broadway. Councilman Castiglia stated that Broadway is a flourishing retail business and therefore more traffic is coming into Elmwood Park. Mr. Conte stated this goes back to his inquiry as to the number of police calls there were the first half of the year. He further stated that he believes the numbers could be substantially more than Fair Lawn or Saddle Brook in which both towns have larger police forces. Mr. Conte asked if the figures of the amount of calls could be available for the next meeting.

Jeffrey Freitag, Hillman Drive, inquired about the coyotes sightings. Mr. Freitag inquired about the Hawk light and the additional lights on Broadway. He further inquired if jaywalking summons have been issued.

Rich Trawinski, Walnut Street, inquired if the Library is moving forward with their \$1.2 million expansion. Mayor Mola stated the expansion is not \$1.2 million, other updates and repairs are being done. Mr. Trawinski hopes the Council looks into having some of the funds go back to the tax payers to pay down Borough taxes. He stated that the money belongs to the taxpayers not to the Library, and it is due diligence to save money. Mayor Mola stated that the Library has saved that money over the years and plan to use it for upgrades and repairs. He further stated that if the Library did not save the money the Borough would need to pay for the repairs.

A motion was made by Councilman Conboy and seconded by Councilman Pettigano to adjourn the meeting. Motion carried unanimously.
