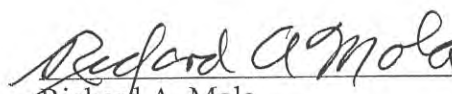

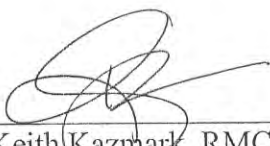

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND Chapter 7 of the Code of the Borough of Elmwood Park titled "Traffic" by amending Ordinance 7-23 thereof.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park as follows:

Section 1. Ordinance 7-23 titled "Turn prohibitions" is hereby amended by adding the following:

§7-23 - Turn prohibitions.


For vehicles with a gross vehicle rating of over fifteen (15) tons, the following turns are prohibited:

<u>Intersection</u>	<u>Turn Prohibited</u>	<u>Movement Prohibited</u>
Block 1508, Lots 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17 A/K/A Midland Avenue and Industrial Avenue	Right	From Midland Avenue South onto Industrial Avenue
Block 1508, Lots 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17 A/K/A Midland Avenue and Industrial Avenue	Left	From Industrial Avenue East onto Midland Avenue

Section 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed or amended to the extent of such inconsistency.


Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect upon final passage and publication according to law.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

Councilman Castiglia discussed an application brought to the Planning Board regarding the location of the former Elmwood Ford. He further discussed the forecast of snow for the coming evening and stated that the Department of Public Works is ready if the forecasted amount of snow does fall. Councilman Castiglia discussed the Council's discussions pertaining to the chain of command in the Department of Public Works. He further reminded residents that the American Legion's breakfast and an upcoming tricky tray on March 22, 2013.

Councilman Pettigano discussed the upcoming Health Clinics. He further reminded residents to renew dog and cat licenses. Councilman Pettigano stated that the Health Department utilizing the Borough's facebook page. He further discussed a posting from that day pertaining to carbon monoxide.

Councilman Colletti congratulated all the Fire Prevention Poster winners. Councilman Colletti discussed the February 26, 2013 Board of Education meeting. He further stated that uniformed and non-uniformed officers have been present in the schools. Councilman Colletti discussed upcoming meetings for JIF, Fire Chief's Meeting and the Board of Education in which he plans to attend.

Councilman Caramagna congratulated the Fire Prevention Poster winners. He further discussed the recyclable debris along Gilbert Avenue due to strong winds. He stated that the Department of Public Works should clean up the debris. Mayor Mola suggested to Councilman Caramagna that if it happens again to call up Mr. Kazmark in the Municipal Clerk's office. Councilman Caramagna discussed the costs incurred in engineering fees.

Councilman Conboy congratulated the Fire Prevention Poster winners. Councilman Conboy discussed the Mayor and Council meeting with the Borough's Chief Financial Officer and Municipal Auditor Paul Lerch discussed the 2013 Municipal Budget. Councilman Conboy stated that he hopes the budget will be finalized in April. He further stated that there will be a quarterly increase to the Municipal tax of approximately \$16.75. 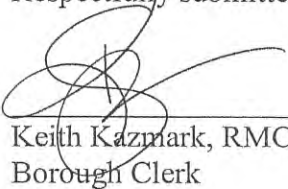

Geroge Stack, Outreach Director for the New Jersey College Coalition, he discussed the 2004 Highlands Water Protection Act. He stated that 75% of Elmwood Park water comes from the Highlands. Mr. Stack gave a sample resolution to Mr. Kazmark along with contact information if needed.

Mayor Mola closed the public portion.

A motion was made by Councilman Vuoncino and seconded by Councilman Caramagna to adjourn. Motion carried unanimously.
