ORDINANCE NO. 14-08**

**CALENDAR YEAR 2014 ORDINANCE TO EXCEED THE MUNICIPAL BUDGET  
APPROPRIATION LIMITS AND TO ESTABLISH A CAP BANK (N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-45.14)**

**WHEREAS**, the Local Government Cap Law, N.J.S. 40A: 4-45.1 et seq., provides that in the preparation of its annual budget, a municipality shall limit any increase in said budget up to .5% unless authorized by ordinance to increase it to 3.5% over the previous year's final appropriations, subject to certain exceptions; and

**WHEREAS**, N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-45.15 a provides that a municipality may, when authorized by ordinance, appropriate the difference between the amount of its actual final appropriation and the 3.5% percentage rate as an exception to its final appropriations in either of the next two succeeding years; and

**WHEREAS**, the Governing Body of the Borough of Elmwood Park in the County of Bergen finds it advisable and necessary to increase its CY 2014 budget by up to 3.5% over the previous year's final appropriations, in the interest of promoting the health, safety and welfare of the citizens; and

**WHEREAS**, the Governing Body hereby determines that a 3.0 % increase in the budget for said year, amounting to \$523,471 in excess of the increase in final appropriations otherwise permitted by the Local Government Cap Law, is advisable and necessary; and

**WHEREAS** the Governing Body hereby determines that any amount authorized hereinabove that is not appropriated as part of the final budget shall be retained as an exception to final appropriation in either of the next two succeeding years.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED**, by the Governing Body of the Borough of Elmwood Park, in the County of Bergen, a majority of the full authorized membership of this governing body affirmatively concurring, that, in the CY 2014 budget year, the final appropriations of the Borough of Elmwood Park shall, in accordance with this ordinance and N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-45.14, be increased by 3.0 %, amounting to \$523,471 and that the CY 2014 municipal budget for the Borough of Elmwood Park be approved and adopted in accordance with this ordinance; and

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED**, that any that any amount authorized hereinabove that is not appropriated as part of the final budget shall be retained as an exception to final appropriation in either of the next two succeeding years; and



**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING AN ORDINANCE (ORDINANCE NO.:  
88-1 ET SEQ. OF THE BOROUGH OF ELMWOOD PARK.**

**WHEREAS**, CHAPTER 88-7 of the Code of the Borough of Elmwood Park” provides “Definitions and Word Usage”; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and Council believe that it would be beneficial to add a definition for “Fast Food Restaurant” and permit “Fast Food Restaurants and Drive-In Restaurants” in Certain Districts.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED** by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park, County of Bergen and State of New Jersey as follows:

**SECTION 1:** Chapter 88-7 shall be amended to include the following new definition:

**FAST-FOOD RESTAURANT-** An establishment or business, which is essentially designed to dispense a limited variety of food and beverages, which are so prepared, packaged in paper, or in other types of disposable wrappers and containers in a form for quick or ready consumption. The aforementioned may or may not be sold for consumption inside the building or on or off the premises.

**SECTION 2:** Chapter 88-20.3 shall be amended as follows: Fast Food Restaurants and Drive-In Restaurants are permitted in the following districts: C-L ( Local Commerce), C-G (General Commerce) & C-O (Office). Conditional in District POP (Planned Office Park).

**SECTION 3: Repealer**

All Ordinances of the Borough of Elmwood Park to the extent that same are not inconsistent with this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect until modified or repealed pursuant to law. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed as to such inconsistencies.

**SECTION 4: Invalid Provisions**

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

**SECTION 5: Effective Date**

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage and publication thereof as provide by law.



**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 3-10 OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF ELMWOOD PARK TITLED "AN ORDINANCE TO PROHIBIT PARKING VEHICLES ON POSTED LANDS IN THE BOROUGH OF ELMWOOD PARK AND TO FIX PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF."**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park, County of Bergen, and State of New Jersey as follows:

**SECTION 1:**

1. Unlawful to Park or Leave Standing.

It shall be unlawful for any person to park or-leave standing any vehicle on lands of another, whether publicly or privately Owned, in the Borough of Elmwood Park, after notice has been posted as hereinafter provided by the owner, occupant, lessee or licensee prohibiting such parking. Nothing herein contained shall apply to any lands lying within the bounds of any public street or highway.

2. Posting of Signs.

Suitable signs not less than eighteen (18) inches by twenty-four (24) inches, bearing the words "NO PARKING," together with any qualifications or restrictions of such parking, if any, and conspicuously displayed, shall be posted on said lands by the owner, occupant, lessee or licensee thereof where this section is effective. Defacing, tampering with or damaging such signs when posted shall constitute a violation of this section.

3. Penalties

Any person violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be subject to a fine not exceeding fifty \$50 dollars or imprisonment for a term not exceeding fifteen (15) days or both at the discretion of the Municipal Magistrate/Judge.

**SECTION 2: Repealer**

All Ordinances of the Borough of Elmwood Park to the extent that same are not inconsistent with this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect until modified or repealed pursuant to law. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed as to such inconsistencies.

**SECTION 3: Invalid Provisions**


If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

**SECTION 4: Effective Date**

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage and publication thereof as provide by law.

**RESOLUTION CALLING ON THE LEGISLATURE TO MAKE PERMANENT THE 2% CAP  
ON INTEREST ARBITRATION AWARDS**

**WHEREAS**, on December 21, 2010, Governor Christie signed into law reforms to the Arbitration process that took effect January 1, 2011; and

**WHEREAS**, the reforms capped arbitration awards on economic factors to no more than 2%, provided for random selection of arbitrators, expedited the determination of awards, required the arbitrator to provide a written report detailing the weight accorded to each of the required considerations and expedited the appeal process; and

**WHEREAS**, these reforms marked a dramatic change to the arbitration process and have helped municipalities to control the never-ending rise in public safety personnel costs; and

**WHEREAS**, a key element of the reforms, capping arbitration awards on economic factors to no more than 2% of the property tax levy will expire on April 1, 2014; and

**WHEREAS**, while municipalities are statutorily limited to raise their property tax levy by no more than 2%, with very limited exceptions, failure to extend the 2% cap on interest arbitration awards will force municipalities throughout the State to further reduce or even eliminate crucial services, personnel, and long-overdue infrastructure improvement projects in order to fund an arbitration award; and

**WHEREAS**, the 2% Interest Arbitration cap has controlled one of the largest municipal expense, public safety salaries, not only through arbitration awards but through contract negotiations; and

**WHEREAS**, absent further action by the Legislature, any contract that expires on or after April 1, 2014, will be subject to all new procedures and requirements, EXCEPT the 2% awards cap; and

**WHEREAS**, without those limits, arbitrators will be able to impose awards that do not account for the 2% limit on the property tax levy, which would immediately threaten funding for all other municipal services; and

**WHEREAS**, without the 2% cap on Interest Arbitration Awards but with the 2% cap on property tax levy local budget makers could be forced to reduce other essential municipal services to fund an arbitration award;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Mayor and Council, of the Borough of Elmwood Park, County of Bergen strongly urges the Legislature to permanently extend the 2% cap on interest arbitration awards prior to the April 1, 2014 sunset; and



## COMMITTEE REPORTS

Councilman Martino discussed the meeting date for the upcoming Homeowners' Association meeting. He discussed the Grand Opening of the Goodwill store.

Councilman Pettigano discussed the clean-up of the Borough Fields in preparation of spring sports. He further discussed programs such as basketball, soccer and street hockey. Councilman Pettigano discussed events such as Spring Camp, Community Day and Summer Camp. Councilman Pettigano discussed the spring clean-up by the Department of Public Works. He asked residents to be patient due to the harsh winter which will make the clean-up more difficult. He asked residents to call the Department of Public Works for any area that may have been missed during the clean-up. Councilman Pettigano congratulated Michele Steepy on her appointment to the Board of Health.

Councilman Colletti congratulated Michele Steepy on her appointment to the Board of Health. He discussed the agreement between the Borough and the Board of Health regarding the use of district busses for the Recreation Summer Camp. Councilman Colletti discussed the Council approval to grant the request by the Fire Department to purchase fire hydrant markers. He stated that the Joint Insurance Fund is in good standing.

Councilman Caramagna congratulated the poster winners and the Bomber Cheerleaders. He further wished Vinnie Fava the best on his accomplishment in placing 3<sup>rd</sup> in the Country for wrestling. Councilman Caramagna discussed the school budget and stated some of the Council members went to the High School to verify reports of nails sticking out the floor. He stated there were not any nails found and hoped that the flooring of the gym be redone in a year or two in an effort to keep the budget down. Mr. Kazmark discussed the municipal cap bank and the difference between the surplus and the cap bank.

George Nestory, Sabo Court, inquired about the cap bank. Mr. Nestory inquired about the breakage in salaries from the retirement of Police Officers. Mr. Nestory discussed no parking during certain hours for street cleaning. He then discussed Fleischer's Brook and the grant to de-snag the brook. Mr. Nestory discussed resident parking and cleaning the storm drains.

A motion was made by Councilman Dombrowski and seconded by Councilman Martino to adjourn. Motion carried unanimously.
