**BOROUGH OF ELMWOOD PARK  
ORDINANCE 15-02**

**AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING CHAPTER 3-28 TO THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF  
ELMWOOD PARK ENTITLED "CURFEW."**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park, County of Bergen, and State of New Jersey as follows:

SECTION 1: The Code of the Borough of Elmwood Park shall entitled is hereby amended by the following

**Chapter 3-28 CURFEW**

ARTICLE I

**Halloween Curfew for Minors**

- § 28-1. **Short title.**
- § 28-2. **Definitions and word usage.**
- § 28-3. **Curfew for minors.**
- § 28-4. **Exceptions.**
- § 28-5. **Parental responsibility.**
- § 28-6. **Police procedures.**
- § 28-7. **Violations and penalties.**

ARTICLE I **Halloween Curfew for Minors**

§ 28-1. **Short title.**

This article shall be known and may be referred to as the "Curfew Ordinance."

§ 28-2. **Definitions and word usage.**

For the purpose of this article, the following terms, phrases, words and their derivations shall have the meanings herein. Where not inconsistent with the context, words used in the present tense include the future, words in the plural number include the singular, and words in the singular number include the plural. The word "shall" is mandatory and not merely directive.

MINOR — Any person under the age of 18 years.

PARENT — Any person having custody of a minor:

- A. As a natural or adoptive parent;
- B. As a legal guardian;
- C. As a person who stands in loco parentis; or
- D. As a person to whom physical custody has been given by order of court.

REMAIN — To stay behind, to tarry and to stay unnecessarily upon the streets in which any minor involved would not be using the streets for ordinary or serious purposes such as mere passage or going home.

STREET — A way or place, of whatsoever nature, open to the use of the public as a matter of right for purposes of vehicular travel, or in the case of a sidewalk thereof, for pedestrian travel. The term "street" includes the legal right-of-way, including but not limited to the cartway of traffic lanes, the curb, the sidewalks, whether paved or unpaved, and any grass plots or the grounds found within the legal right-of-way of a street. The term "street" applies irrespective of what it is called or formally named, whether alley, avenue, court, road or otherwise.



TIME OF NIGHT — Referred to herein is based upon Eastern standard time.

BOROUGH — The Borough of Elmwood Park, Bergen County, New Jersey, with administrative offices at 182 Market Street, Elmwood Park, New Jersey.

YEAR OF AGE — Continues from one birthday, such as the 17th, to (but not including the day of) the next, such as the 18th birthday, making it clear that 17 or fewer years of age is herein treated as equivalent to the phrase "under 18 years of age."

**§ 28-3. Curfew for minors.**

It shall be unlawful for any minor to be or remain in or upon any street, alley, highway, road, park, playground, dock or other public ground or public place, place of amusement, entertainment, vacant lot or other public place within the confines of the Borough each year during the following periods of time: 9:00 p.m. October 30th through 6:00 a.m. October 31st; 9:00 p.m. October 31st through 6:00 a.m. November 1st.

**§ 28-4. Exceptions.**

In the following exceptional cases, a minor on the Borough streets during the hours set forth above shall not be considered in violation of this article:

- A. When accompanied by a parent, legal guardian, or other adult having the care, custody and control of the minor;
- B. When accompanied by an adult authorized by a parent of such minor to take said parent's place in accompanying said minor;
- C. When exercising rights protected by the United States Constitution or its Amendments, such as the free exercise of religion, freedom of speech and the right of assembly. The minor shall first deliver to the Police Department at the Borough Municipal Building, at 182 Market Street, a letter signed by such minor and countersigned by a parent of such minor stating their home address, telephone number and specifying where and in what manner the minor will be on the streets during hours when this article is otherwise applicable;
- D. In the case of reasonable necessity as determined by the Chief of Police or his designee, but only after such minor's parent has written to the Borough Police Department stating their name, address, telephone number and the facts establishing such reasonable necessity and specifying the streets and times for the described purpose, including points of origin and destination;
- E. When the minor is directly in front of the place where such minor resides or directly in front of either next door neighbor, if this neighbor does not object to the minor's presence;
- F. When proceeding by a direct route to or from home, work, a school activity, or an activity of religious or other voluntary association, provided that it is within 1/2 hour of the start or end of the work or activity;
- G. When authorized by the Chief of Police or his designee when necessary nighttime activities of a minor may be inadequately provided for by other provisions of this article;
- H. When the minor is in a motor vehicle engaged in normal travel and with parent's consent, or if the minor is engaged in interstate travel.

**§ 28-5. Parental responsibility.**

It shall be unlawful for any person, parent or guardian having the legal care or custody of a minor knowingly to permit or, by inefficient control, to allow such minor to be or remain upon any Borough street in violation of this article. The term "knowingly" includes knowledge which a parent should reasonably be expected to have concerning the whereabouts of a minor in that parent's custody.

**§ 28-6. Police procedures.**

- A. A police officer of the Borough upon finding or having attention called to any minor on the streets shall take action pursuant to the Borough of Elmwood Park Guidelines/State of New Jersey Attorney General Guidelines.



**§ 28-7. Violations and penalties.**

Penalties for a violation of this article shall be the following: a fine up to \$1,000 and community service for any adult or juvenile found in violation. If both the juvenile and the juvenile's parent or guardian violate this article, they may be required to perform community service together.

**§ 28-8. Effective Date**

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage and publication thereof as provide by law.

## COMMITTEE REPORTS

Councilman Caramagna congratulated the Police Department for doing a great job. They are making arrests and catching people. He stated that the Police are sending a message to stay away from Elmwood Park. He discussed the article in The Community News about peer assistance. He discussed the traffic light on Broadway at the Elmwood Park and Fair Lawn train station. He thanked Senator Pou and Senator Gordon for their efforts. The Councilman met with the new Interim Superintendent, Mr. Greco. He is excited about the position and they discussed the new standardized tests. The Councilman discussed the stress in teaching with regard to all the testing now required. He emphasized safety and education. Councilman Caramagna spoke to Mr. Riggitano regarding holding a budget meeting.

Council President Dombrowski wished the high school cheerleading team well in their competition. He discussed the Board of Health rabies clinic held twice a month at the Bergen County Animal Shelter. He discussed other vaccinations and care which is available from the BCAS. He thanked our veterans and all active military for their service to our country. Mayor Mola discussed finalizing the rabies clinic.

Councilman Vuoncino discussed the traffic signal on Broadway being installed by the end of April. He discussed his sons utilizing the train station on Broadway and the challenges at the crossing with vehicles and pedestrians. The Councilman stated that the best solution in meeting with the DOT was an overhead pedestrian crossing however economically it was not feasible. In conjunction with Fair Lawn, we aided in funding the engineering and he is happy the lights are finally being installed.

Councilman Martino discussed the amount of arrests being made by the Police Department. They have a tough job and are working to address the issues out there. He announced the Homeowner's Association meeting and encouraged people to attend. The high school will be holding a cheer competition this weekend.

Councilman Pettigano discussed the heroin arrests being made by the Police Department. He spoke about the cold weather and the need to check on the elderly and help with snow removal.

Councilman Colletti reported on the traffic light on Route 4. He discussed the history and the previous meetings with the legislators. The Councilman spoke about the EPFD participating in the Edgewater fire. He spoke to Greg Franz the Administrator in Edgewater about the incident. He announced the JIF breakfast which is coming up and the award which the Borough will be receiving. He further discussed the importance of clearing snow from fire hydrants.

Mr. Randazzo reported progress.

Mayor Mola spoke about the Finance Committee meeting which Councilman Caramagna will hold. The Mayor advocated for a zero tax increase for this year. The Mayor appointed Jamie Silverman as his Alternate to the Library Board. He discussed Excel Environmental working in cleaning up the Synkote Paint property. The Mayor has spoken to the Police Chief about a drug drop box to dispose of old medication. He mentioned the crossing at the Route 4 train station. He thanked DOT Commissioner Fox, Senator Pou and our Assembly Members. He discussed the possibility of a future park-and-ride in town. The 100<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Committee has over 50 people interested and he will be sending something out in a few weeks. Commissioner Fox committed to the Mayor that River Drive under Route 80 will be paved this spring. The Mayor addressed the Town Hall meeting on Tuesday regarding to the proposed zone change for Market Street. He also discussed his attendance at a recent Freeholder meeting regarding the County park.

Rich Trawinski, Walnut Street thanked the Council for appointing him to the Library Board. He discussed the funding for the Library Board's proposed improvements.

Kenneth Arabia, Locust Street inquired about the need for no parking signs on Mulberry Street and the problems which exist. He asked about the need for a stop sign at the municipal lot at Mulberry Street.

Rich Trawinski, Walnut Street inquired about the safety measures at the railroad crossing near Midland Avenue. He requested the Council consider a resolution.
