ORDINANCE NO. : 15-01**

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED, "AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH THE WATER DEPARTMENT OF THE BOROUGH OF ELMWOOD PARK, BERGEN COUNTY, NEW JERSEY, TO FIX THE RATES AND PRICES TO BE CHARGED FOR THE USE OF WATER AND ESTABLISH RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE DISTRIBUTION, SUPPLY, USE AND PROTECTION OF SAID WATER AND PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION OF CERTAIN SAID RULES AND REGULATIONS.

WHEREAS, due to a aggregate 4 % increase in water consumption from bulk water supplier, Passaic Valley Water Commission, the following is necessary;

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Council, of the Borough of Elmwood Park as follows:

Section 1 A fixed charge known as "the service charge," will be made to each Consumer for each meter based on the size of the meter or connection regardless of the amount of water consumed as follows:

5/8 in. Meter (average 1 and 2 family homes)	\$42.59
¾ in. Meter	\$47.90
1 in. Meter	\$51.10
1 ½ in. Meter	\$55.35
2 in. Meter	\$56.42
3 in. Meter	\$80.84
4 in. Meter	\$95.72
6 in. Meter	\$123.34
Flush tank connection	\$39.38

Section 2: The following water rates and changes are hereby established for water supplied by the Department.

The minimum quarterly bill for metered service shall be "the service charge"entitling the consumer to 5,000 gallons of water per quarter. All water supplied through meters in excess of the minimum quarterly bill, shall be charged to each consumer at the rate of:

- \$4.70 per 1,000 gallons over 5,000 gallons
- \$5.10 per 1,000 gallons over 70,000 gallons
- \$5.79 per 1,000 gallons over 150,000 gallons
- \$6.21 per 1,000 gallons over 300,000 gallons

3 in. Service	\$170.32
4 in. Service	\$265.71
6 in. Service	\$487.13
8 in. Service	\$765.05
10 in. Service	\$953.80
12 in. Service	\$1277.42

The above schedule for stand by fire line and/or sprinkler connections shall be quarterly charges upon presentation of proper bills from the Water Department of the Borough of Elmwood Park.

Section 3:

The following are hereby established as charges for the installation, repair, replacement and other charges in connection with the operation of the Water Department of the Borough of Elmwood Park:

Turn on charge for non payment of Water Bill	\$120.75
Water Meter Test (if meter found defective, waive fee) Depends on meter size	\$162.75 - \$288.75

A. Construction Water:

One family dwelling per day.....	\$46.88
Two family dwelling per day.....	\$54.68

B. Water Connection.....\$250.42

C. Hydrant Water:

Flat Rate per Day.....	\$46.88
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D. Certified mailing, each occurrence.....\$25.00

E. Residential Meters: (5/8 in. - 1 in.)

- Re-install meter
- Register face
- New dial
- Broken glass
- New bottom
- New Disc
- New register

Installation, replacement, and repair of existing meters shall be charged at actual current cost for labor and material incurred by the Water Department of the Borough of Elmwood Park and/or Passaic Valley Water Commission.

F. All commercial users having meters in excess of 3/4" must have them in working order at all times. In the event said meter is inoperative, and no attempt is made for repair/replacement of same, the existing estimated bill shall be tripled the existing estimated rate, upon the effective date of this ordinance. In the event no meter in excess of 3/4" exist, in addition to the tripled estimated bill, the landlord shall be required to purchase and install same upon written order of the Superintendent of Public Works.

Section 4: "In the event that payment for water charges is in arrears for 30 days from date of billing, the Borough shall send a delinquent notice regular mail, to the owner, occupier, user or responsible party being billed. After 60 days, a door tag shall be hand delivered to terminate water service. On the 67th day of non payment from date of billing, water service will be terminated, and not reinstated until all fees, penalties, are paid in full in cash.

\$137.13 turn on fee, is made to the Borough of Elmwood Park.

Section 4b: "In the event, that water charges are in the arrears, after 60 days, a door tag will be delivered to terminate water service and a fee of \$40.00 will be assessed on to the delinquent water bill.

Section 5: All unpaid water charges as of 12/31 of the present year shall become a Tax Lien on said premises.

Section 6: All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with or in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict or inconsistency. This shall take effect after final passage and publication as required by law.

Section 7: All billings as of March 1, 2014 and thereafter will be subject to said rate.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

Councilman Caramagna questioned why the school district needed a new State Monitor. He expressed his displeasure and discussed the state of the schools.

Council President Dombrowski congratulated Doris Wechtler for her election to the Board of Education for her 4th term. He further congratulated our new Fire Chief on his swearing in and the Police Chief for his taking on OEM duties. He thanked the Mayor for waiving some of his appointment and allowing the Council to make them.

Councilman Vuoncino congratulated Fire Chief Pressler and the EPFD officers who were sworn in this evening. He congratulated all the volunteers. He discussed the Police Department being very busy of late and discussed some of the efforts they are making. He discussed the Police and community partnership here in Elmwood Park. He congratulated Chief Foligno on his appointment as OEM coordinator. The Councilman discussed the support of the Volunteer Ambulance Corps. He expressed his condolence to the DeVito Family on the loss of Mr. DeVito, a former VAC Captain. He announced that the NJ SEM gas commodity data results will be available soon.

Councilman Martino discussed the dedication of the Police Department, Fire Department and the Ambulance Corps. here in town.

Councilman Pettigano congratulated the newly installed Fire Department officers and board members.

Councilman Colletti was pleased with the instillation of the Fire Department officers. He discussed recent calls the Fire Department has had and announced that the ladder truck is now back in service. The Fire Department dinner will now be held at the Elk's Club.

Mayor Mola discussed the formation of the 100th Anniversary Committee. He also expressed his condolences on the loss of Mr. DeVito.

A motion was made by Councilman Martino to open the public hearing, seconded by Councilman Vuoncino. The motion carried unanimously.

PUBLIC HEARING


Doris Wechtler, Phillip Avenue stated she was concerned regarding Jamie Silverman not being reappointed to the Library Board. She discussed Mrs. Silverman's knowledge of the laws and operations of the Library. She asked the Council to reconsider her appointment.

James D'Amico, Willow Street discussed various issues ongoing over at the Board of Education. He referred to the two referendums which were voted down to improve the athletic fields. He discussed the school deficit and the cost for the State Monitor. He indicated that the loan from the State of \$2 million dollars requires the district to have a State Monitor until it is repaid which could be up to 10 years. He reviewed the cost of the State requirements. Mr. D'Amico discussed the Board of Education utilizing \$2 million dollars to build a new football field rather than pay back the State. He stated that taxes have gone and will go up significantly on the Board of Education side. The \$2 million could have been used for repairs to the school rather than raising taxes as a result of the approved referendum. He discussed the conditions of the schools, the removal of bussing and a lack of teachers. A football field is great, but what about these other issues. Council President Dombrowski discussed the Board of Education seeking a cost estimate for the football field, however, as he believes it, there was no aware or vote to proceed. Mr. D'Amico discussed his discussions with the State.

Kenneth Arabia, Locust Street stated he is against the tank being painted for \$50,000. The Mayor stated that it has not been discussed yet. Mr. Arabia discussed the storefront vacancies in town, especially on Market Street. The town needs a lot of fixing. He asked that the lights in the parking lot be fixed.

A motion was made by Councilman Martino to adjourn the meeting, seconded by Council President Dombrowski. The motion carried unanimously.
