6c. PUBLIC HEARING ON THE 2015 MUNICIPAL BUDGET

A motion was made by Councilwoman Giandomenico and seconded by Councilman Dombrowski to open the floor for public comment. Motion carried unanimously.

Tom Conboy, Tuella Avenue, inquired about the tax increase on the average home. CFO Roy Riggitano explained the increase of \$49 on the average household. Mr. Conboy stated the Mayor and Council should have come in at a zero increase again this year.

Richard Trawinski, Walnut Street, asked Mr. Riggitano about the school taxes. Mr. Riggitano stated an estimated amount of \$230 on the average household. Mr. Trawinski discussed the school budget and the dedicated staff, however he questioned the administrative salaries.

A motion was made by Councilwoman Giandomenico and seconded by Councilman Colletti.

Councilwoman Giandomenico discussed the preliminary breakdown of taxes. She stated the Board of Education and the County's budgets have not yet been adopted. She discussed the concept of an "artificial" zero tax increase, and the need to stabilize taxes and not have peaks and valleys. Councilwoman Giandomenico thanked everyone who made this budget possible.

Councilman Dombrowski discussed his vote against the municipal budget and why he feels the Borough should have used part of the surplus to come in at a zero tax increase.

Councilman Colletti discussed the process in preparing this year's municipal budget. He further discussed the effort put into prior budgets by former council members. Councilman Colletti discussed the budget being maintained and how a zero tax increase would be welcomed by many, however he stated that is not a reality.

Mayor Mola thanked Councilwoman Giandomenico, Municipal Auditor Paul Lerch, CFO Roy Riggitano and all the Councilmembers for all the hard work in preparing the 2016 Municipal Budget.



NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the governing body of the Borough of Elmwood Park that in accordance with N.J.A.C. 5:30-7.6a & b and based upon the Chief Financial Officer's certification, the governing body has found the budget has met the following requirements:

1. That with reference to the following items, the amounts have been calculated pursuant to law and appropriated as such in the budget.
 - a. Payment of interest and debt redemption charges
 - b. Deferred charges and statutory expenditures
 - c. Cash deficit of preceding year
 - d. Reserve for uncollected taxes
 - e. Other reserves and non-disbursement items
 - f. Any inclusions of amounts required for school purposes.
2. That the provisions relating to limitation on increases of appropriations pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:4-45.2 and appropriations for exceptions to limits on appropriations found at N.J.S.A. 40A:4-45.3 et seq. are fully met. (Complies with the "CAP" law).
3. That the budget is in such form, arrangement, and content as required by the Local Budget Law and N.J.A.C. 5:30-4 and 5:30-5.
4. That pursuant to the Local Budget Law:
 - a. All estimates of revenue are reasonable, accurate, and correctly stated;
 - b. Items of appropriations are properly set forth
 - c. In itemization, form, arrangement, and content the budget will permit the exercise of the comptroller function within the municipality.
5. The budget and associated amendments have been introduced and publicly advertised in accordance with the relevant provisions of the Local Budget Law, except that failure to meet the deadlines of N.J.S.A. 40A:4-5 shall not prevent such certification.
6. That all other applicable statutory requirements have been fulfilled.



ORDINANCE 16-08**

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND Chapter VII of the Code of the Borough of Elmwood Park titled "Traffic."

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park as follows:

Section 1. Chapter VII of the Code of the Borough of Elmwood Park titled "Traffic" is hereby amended by deleting existing section 7-8.3 e titled "Temporary Parking Prohibition for Snow Plowing and Removal," and replacing it with the following:

§7-8.3 e.

Unless some other penalty is expressly provided by New Jersey statute, every person convicted of a violation of this subsection or any supplement thereto, shall be liable for a penalty of one hundred fifty (\$150.00) dollars or imprisonment for a term not exceeding fifteen (15) days or both.


Section 2. If any part of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of the Ordinance.

Section 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed or amended to the extent of such inconsistency.



**RESOLUTION TO SUPPORT TO DENY PAROLE FOR
CHRISTOPHER RIGHETTI**

WHEREAS, on August 31, 1976, Kim Montelaro, a resident of New Milford, Bergen County, then 20 years old, was forcibly abducted, brutally assaulted and murdered by repeat offender, Christopher Righetti; and

WHEREAS, Christopher Righetti, Prisoner #59431, is currently incarcerated for the killing of Kim Montelaro; and

WHEREAS, Christopher Righetti has gone many times before the Parole Board of Northern State Prison. His release was denied each time, as the parole board found that Christopher Righetti was unwilling to take responsibility for abducting, assaulting and murdering Kim Montelaro; and

WHEREAS, Christopher Righetti has never shown any remorse for his crime and has made no substantial progress in addressing the issues that led him to murder Kim Montelaro; and


WHEREAS, Kim's family should not be made to relive this horrible crime every few years when there is a parole hearing. They are forced to travel long distances from their current residence in Florida each time there is a parole hearing for their daughter's killer. They continue to suffer unnecessarily on Christopher Righetti's account; and

WHEREAS, in addition to the efforts of the Montelaro Family, the Borough of Elmwood Park hereby supports the position that Christopher Righetti should not be granted parole and should serve out the full remainder of his life sentence. If a future eligibility date is set, we urge the Board to select a date at least 35 years from now. The abduction, rape and murder of an innocent young woman is a serious crime that demands justice; and the family of Kim Montelaro should be given the peace of mind of knowing that their daughter's murderer will remain behind bars for the rest of his life, as ordered by the court.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Borough of Elmwood Park hereby abides by the conclusion that Christopher Righetti be denied parole and be made to serve out his life sentence, otherwise this creates a grave injustice to the family of Kim Montelaro as well as to society.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a copy of this resolution shall be sent to the Bergen County Police Chiefs Association, the New Jersey PBA, the Office of the Bergen County Prosecutor, Keep NJ Safe, and to Chairman James T. Plousis of the New Jersey State Parol Board.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

Councilman Chirido reported on the Opening Day Ceremonies last Saturday and about ongoing operations at the Public Works Department.

Councilman Colletti discussed the Joint Insurance Fund and encouraged residents to join the volunteer Fire Department. He announced the Opening Day for the Girls Softball league this coming Saturday. Councilman Colletti further discussed the decision made by the Recreation Advisory Board and the Council deciding to install the hockey rink at the location of the current basketball court at Borough Field. He spoke to the history of the project and how he disagrees with the final decision. Mayor Mola stated that he has observed young people using the basketball courts.

Councilwoman Giandomenico discussed the Opening Day of Little League. She announced the upcoming Board of Education and Bergen County budget meetings. The Councilwoman further addressed her view regarding the hockey rink. She discussed drivers who text when driving and the dangers of this behavior.

Councilman Dombrowski reported on the upcoming Rabies Clinic, Chamber of Commerce meeting and Homeowner's Association meeting. He discussed the Library Board meeting which was held last week. He stated that many items discussed at the Library Board that now have to wait to be discussed in another 30 days.

Councilman Vuoncino spoke about the hockey rink decision. He addressed the need for the rink. The Councilman also announced the upcoming PBA and Ambulance Corps. Beefsteaks. He further thanked the Police Department, emergency services and the administrators at the school district for their response to the recent incidents at the schools.

Mr. Giblin had no report.

Mayor Mola reported on the work being done on the Boulevard. He thanked the Centennial Committee for their efforts with the Miss Elmwood Park pageant. He concurred with Councilwoman Giandomenico about texting when driving.

Councilman Colletti again addressed the loss of the basketball court at Borough Field. Councilman Vuoncino and Councilman Dombrowski both suggested the decision was made and should stand. Council Members Chirido and Giandomenico stated they would be willing to discuss it one more time. Councilman Vuoncino stated that the decision was made at the Recreation Advisory Board and at the Council level. Councilman Colletti stated that he feels we should be able to have both facilities. Councilman Vuoncino discussed the challenges of a dual use. Further discussion on this topic ensued amongst the Council Members.

PUBLIC COMMENT

Richard Trawinski, Walnut Street, discussed the hockey rink and feels the issue has been discussed enough. He further questioned Councilman Colletti on his vote against the parking ordinance fine. Councilman Colletti stated that \$150 is too high for this community. Mr. Trawinski discussed the need for the tickets to be a real deterrent for parking illegally during snow storms. He further discussed the Library Board and his desire to see the full plans for the building. He further requested a Library liaison be appointed from the Council.

Robert Burke, 14th Avenue, discussed the hockey rink matter and feels the basketball court should remain at Borough Field. He further discussed his position on the issue.

Jeff Frietag, Hillman Avenue, discussed opening time of the DPW yard on Saturday.

Kenneth Arabia, Locust Street, discussed the light on the back of the Municipal Building shining in the home across the street. He further asked about traffic on the Boulevard. He also discussed the use of cell phones when driving.


