

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND Chapter VII of the Code of the Borough of Elmwood Park titled "Traffic."

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park as follows:

Section 1. Chapter VII of the Code of the Borough of Elmwood Park titled "Traffic" is hereby amended by deleting existing section 7-8.3 e titled "Temporary Parking Prohibition for Snow Plowing and Removal," and replacing it with the following:

§7-8.3 e.

Unless some other penalty is expressly provided by New Jersey statute, every person convicted of a violation of this subsection or any supplement thereto, shall be liable for a penalty of two hundred (\$150.00) dollars or imprisonment for a term not exceeding fifteen (15) days or both.

Section 2. If any part of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of the Ordinance.

Section 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed or amended to the extent of such inconsistency.



**CALENDAR YEAR 2016 ORDINANCE TO EXCEED THE MUNICIPAL BUDGET
APPROPRIATION LIMITS AND TO ESTABLISH A CAP BANK (N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-45.14)**

WHEREAS, the Local Government Cap Law, N.J.S. 40A: 4-45.1 et seq., provides that in the preparation of its annual budget, a municipality shall limit any increase in said budget up to 0% unless authorized by ordinance to increase it to 3.5% over the previous year's final appropriations, subject to certain exceptions; and,

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-45.15a provides that a municipality may, when authorized by ordinance, appropriate the difference between the amount of its actual final appropriation and the 3.5% percentage rate as an exception to its final appropriations in either of the next two succeeding years; and,

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the Borough of Elmwood Park in the County of Bergen finds it advisable and necessary to increase its CY 2016 budget by up to 3.5% over the previous year's final appropriations, in the interest of promoting the health, safety and welfare of the citizens; and,

WHEREAS, the Governing Body hereby determines that a 3.5% increase in the budget for said year, amounting to \$624,765 in excess of the increase in final appropriations otherwise permitted by the Local Government Cap Law, is advisable and necessary; and,

WHEREAS the Governing Body hereby determines that any amount authorized hereinabove that is not appropriated as part of the final budget shall be retained as an exception to final appropriation in either of the next two succeeding years.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the Governing Body of the Borough of Elmwood Park, in the County of Bergen, a majority of the full authorized membership of this governing body affirmatively concurring, that, in the CY 2016 budget year, the final appropriations of the Borough of Elmwood Park shall, in accordance with this ordinance and N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-45.14, be increased by 3.5 %, amounting to \$624,765, and that the CY 2016 municipal budget for the Governing Body be approved and adopted in accordance with this ordinance; and,

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that any that any amount authorized hereinabove that is not appropriated as part of the final budget shall be retained as an exception to final appropriation in either of the next two succeeding years; and,

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that a certified copy of this ordinance as introduced be filed with the Director of the Division of Local Government Services within 5 days of introduction; and,

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that a certified copy of this ordinance upon adoption, with the recorded vote included thereon, be filed with said Director within 5 days after such adoption.



**BOROUGH OF ELMWOOD PARK
ORDINANCE NO. 16-07**

AN ORDINANCE TO PREVENT THE UNLAWFUL ENROLLMENT OF SCHOOL CHILDREN IN THE ELMWOOD PARK PUBLIC SCHOOL SYSTEM AND TO PROVIDE PENALTIES THEREFORE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park that the following be added to the Code of the Borough of Elmwood Park:

Ineligible student enrollment prohibition; penalties.

(a) Purpose. A section to prohibit and penalize: (i) any parent or other person enrolling a student in the Elmwood Park School District, claiming that his or her child is a resident of Elmwood Park, seeking free of charge education, when such student is ineligible for free of charge education.

(b) Prohibited conduct. It shall be unlawful for any person who is 18 years old and older, to:

(1) Knowingly register or enroll a student in the Elmwood Park School District seeking free of charge education or maintain the enrollment of a student receiving free of charge education when the student is ineligible for free of charge education pursuant to N.J.S.A. Title 18A; or

(2) Knowingly assist, aid or permit a student to register or enroll in the Elmwood Park School District seeking free of charge education when the student is ineligible to attend free of charge pursuant to N.J.S.A. Title 18A; or

(3) Knowingly permit his or her name, address or other residence designating documentation to be utilized in the registration or enrollment of any student seeking free of charge education in the Elmwood Park School District when the student is ineligible to attend free of charge pursuant to N.J.S.A. Title 18A; or

(4) Does not notify or inform the Elmwood Park School District when a student is no longer a resident in the household of that person who had previously knowingly permitted his or her name, address or other residence designating documentation to be utilized in the registration or enrollment of the student in the Elmwood Park School District.

(c) Requirements. Upon the request of the Elmwood Park School District, the parent or guardian of a student registered in the Elmwood Park School District shall be required to complete documentation intended to determine the student's eligibility to attend school in the Elmwood Park School District free of charge in accordance with N.J.S.A. Title 18A. All residents hosting other families or individuals, with a student enrolled in the Elmwood Park School District in their residence, must register with the Elmwood Park School District and must notify the Elmwood Park School District when such other families or individuals no longer reside with the resident.

(d) Enforcement. (i) Sections (a), (b) and (c) may be enforced by the administrative officials of the Elmwood Park School District in their sole discretion.

(e) Penalty. Any person violating the provisions of Sections (a), (b) or (c) shall, upon conviction thereof, be sentenced to pay a fine of up to \$2,000 and to the maximum lawful extent make restitution to the Elmwood Park Board of Education. In determining the amount of restitution, the Municipal Court of the Borough of Elmwood Park shall include amounts incurred by the Elmwood Park Board of Education, including but not limited to tuition costs, investigation expenses and attorneys' fees.

(f) Restitution. Restitution ordered by the Municipal Court of the Borough of Elmwood Park, shall be paid to the Elmwood Park Board of Education within thirty (30) days of such an order being final and not subject to further appeal. Unpaid restitution and fines may, upon the petition of the Elmwood Park Board of Education to the Municipal Court of the Borough of Elmwood Park, be converted into liens against the properties of the offending parties.

(g) Severability. Each section, subsection, sentence, clause and phrase of this section is declared to be an independent section, subsection, sentence, clause and phrase, and the finding or holding of any such portion of this section to be unconstitutional, void or ineffective for any cause, or reason, shall not affect any other portion of this chapter.


Except as provided for herein, all other provisions of the Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

If any section, subsection, part, clause or phrase of this Ordinance shall be declared invalid by judgment of any court of competent jurisdiction, such section, subsection, part, clause or phrase shall be deemed to be severable from the remainder of this Ordinance.

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage and publication as required by law.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

Councilman Martino discussed progress with the White Collar negotiations. He also discussed an upcoming Homeowners Association meeting.

Councilman Chirido discussed the Department of Public Works repairing potholes and the collection of yard waste. He further discussed the upcoming clean up at Borough Field.

Councilman Colletti discussed the recent JIF breakfast and the award received by Elmwood Park. He addressed the ongoing discussion about the hockey rink at the Borough Field. He also spoke about the recent string of fires in town this past Sunday. He commended the Fire Departments' professionalism and hard work.

Councilwoman Giandomenico discussed the Board of Education providing the recordings of their meetings on the District website. She further congratulated BOE President Jean Freitag for the recent award she received. The Councilwoman further stated that she has requested a tour of the schools and will be meeting with the Superintendent and the Board President for said tour. She discussed the budget and reiterated that any Council members who have suggested changes to the budget should provide them to her prior to adoption for review. Councilwoman discussed BCCLS listing books that are available in different languages. She further stated that she has been communicating with the Library Director as well as BCCLS to implement what is currently being done in Wallington regarding the cataloging of foreign language books.

Councilman Dombrowski also congratulated Jean Freitag on her award. He further discussed the upcoming Rabies Clinic being held by the Elmwood Park Board of Health. He also discussed what is offered at the Bergen County Animal Shelter.
