

**BOROUGH OF ELMWOOD PARK
ORDINANCE 16-04**

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND Chapter VII of the Code of the Borough of Elmwood Park titled "Traffic."

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park as follows:

Section 1. Chapter VII of the Code of the Borough of Elmwood Park titled "Traffic" is hereby amended by deleting existing section 7-8.3 e titled "Temporary Parking Prohibition for Snow Plowing and Removal," and replacing it with the following:

§7-8.3 e.

Unless some other penalty is expressly provided by New Jersey statute, every person convicted of a violation of this subsection or any supplement thereto, shall be liable for a penalty of two hundred (\$200.00) dollars or imprisonment for a term not exceeding fifteen (15) days or both.

Section 2. If any part of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of the Ordinance.

Section 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed or amended to the extent of such inconsistency.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect upon final passage and publication according to law.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

Councilman Martino discussed various teams in which has been a part of his life. One was a baseball team in which he coached and described a game in which his kid played in. He then discussed his team (the Democratic Party) not supporting him (for re-election) last night, how he feels about it and the reaction which followed. He stated it is about serving the 19,000 people in Elmwood Park. He said his family is the priority and spoke about the priorities of the people who made this decision.

Councilman Chirido reported on the DPW filling some potholes in town, beyond that he reported progress.

Councilman Colletti reported on the upcoming JIF Safety Breakfast. He discussed the Council reviewing the hockey rink planned at Borough Field and the Fire Department seeking new recruits.

Councilman Vuoncino congratulated our new Police Officer and commented on his vote on the snow parking ordinance. He spoke about the NJ SEM program auction. The Councilman further reported on the joint meeting the Council had with the Library Board a few weeks back and his concerns with the lack of answers to the questions which were asked.
