
**WHEREAS**, on October 20, 2016, Mayor Richard A. Mola passed away creating a vacancy in the Mayoral seat; and





# BOROUGH OF ELMWOOD PARK

## ORDINANCE 16-21

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING** Chapter II of the Code of the Borough of Elmwood Park, titled "Administration".

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park that Sections 2-57.1, 2-57.2, 2-57.3 and 2-57.5 of the Code of the Borough of Elmwood Park titled "Emergency Services Volunteer Length of Service Award Program: LOSAP " shall be amended by deleting the above listed existing sections and inserting in their place the following:

### Section 1

#### **2-57 EMERGENCY SERVICES VOLUNTEER LENGTH OF SERVICE AWARD PROGRAM: LOSAP.**

##### **2-57.1 Findings.**

The Borough of Elmwood Park deems it appropriate and necessary to act to ensure the retention of existing members and to provide incentives for recruiting new Ambulance Squad Members, and has determined that the creation of a Length of Service Awards Program will enhance the ability of the municipality to retain and recruit volunteer ambulance squad members.

##### **2-57.2 Creation of Program.**

A Length of Service Awards Program (**LOSAP**) is herewith created in accordance with Chapter 388 of the Laws of 1997, to reward members of the Volunteer Ambulance Squad members for their loyal, diligent, and devoted services to the residents of the Borough of Elmwood Park.

##### **2-57.3 Annual Contribution for Each Volunteer Member.**

a. The **LOSAP** shall provide for fixed annual contributions to a deferred account for each volunteer member that meets the criteria set forth below; that such contributions shall be made in accordance with a plan that shall be established by the Borough of Elmwood Park pursuant to P.L. 1997 C.388; and that such plan shall be administered in accordance with the laws of the State of New Jersey, the U.S. Internal Revenue Code, and this section.

b. The **LOSAP** shall provide for annual contributions to each eligible member that meets the criteria, as follows:

1. One hundred (100) points are required for an Ambulance Corps member to be eligible for an annual contribution.

2. Five (5) years of service are required for vesting.

3. The annual contribution shall be seven hundred (\$700.00) dollars per eligible member.

##### **2-57.5 Points for Active Volunteers.**

Each active volunteer member shall be credited with points for volunteer services provided to the Volunteer Ambulance Corps in accordance with the following schedule:

Schedule A relating to Volunteer Firefighters is hereby repealed

Elmwood Park Volunteer Ambulance Corps: See Schedule B

**Editor's Note:** See Schedule B in the Office of the Municipal Clerk.

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED** by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park as follows:

**Section 2**

Chapter II of the Code of the Borough of Elmwood Park titled "ADMINISTRATION" is hereby amended by adding a new section, titled "Volunteer Fire Department Stipend" to be designated as Ordinance 2-62 as follows:

**2-62.1 Scope**

- A. All active Officers and Firefighters are eligible for the stipend program.

**2-62.2 Credit and Definitions**

- A. Volunteer Firefighters must attend 40% of all Fire Calls, Chiefs Calls and Drills for that month to receive the Tier 1 payment and must attend 60% of the above to receive the Tier 2 payment. There shall be no exceptions or leniency to this rule.
- B. Fire calls are defined as:
- i) Any call for service dispatched through Fire Headquarters (Police Desk)
  - ii) Any call for service reported at the Fire Station and subsequently logged and dispatched through Fire Headquarters.
  - iii) For each fire call that is between the hours of 11:00pm and 7:00am, firefighters will receive credit for two calls during that time period.

Chiefs Calls are defined as:

- i) Any Mutual Aid Call, Department Drill or Stand By call where attendance is required under the existing Department S.O.G's.
- ii) Borough of Elmwood Park parades and/or activities.
- iii) Drills, which are defined required weekly firematic training, and which shall count as one call.

The following activities shall NOT be accredited under the stipend program.

- i) Fire Board, Officer's or business meetings.
  - ii) Special work details and assignments.
  - iii) Out of town parades, conventions and other social events.
- C. Members attending mandated training approved by the Chief of Department or his Assistant Chief Officers will

receive credit should the respective company respond to a call during the training session.

- D. Firefighters injured in the line of duty will receive credit for calls that his/hers company is dispatched to while out injured, until such time that he/she can return to full active duty. If the said firefighter is deemed unfit to return to full active duty due to the injury by the Fire Department's authorized medical doctor, the stipend will cease at that time.
- E. There shall be no credit afforded for vacations.
- F. Borough of Elmwood Park employees will receive credit for responding to calls while on the clock working for the Borough.

#### **2-62.3 Attendance Procedure**

- A. Personnel must report to the fire station or to the fire scene and must remain until the call is terminated.
- B. Personnel must respond in proper protective clothing and be prepared to perform a function.
- C. Upon returning to the fire station, each responder must sign in on the appropriate form to receive credit for the call. Substitute signatures are not acceptable. The sign in form shall remain available for 10 minutes after returning to quarters to allow ample time for all personnel to report.
- D. *Exceptions to this rule.*
  - 1. Personnel that are required to remain at the scene by orders of an officer shall be given an attendance slip by that officer and submitted when the firefighter is cleared from the scene.
  - 2. Chief Officers records of attendance will be maintained by the Borough Clerk.
- E. *Extended Fire Calls;* Members will receive credit for one call for the initial 3 2 hour time period, and credit for one additional call for every two hour period after the initial period. In addition, credit for all extended fire calls that occur between the hours of 11 PM and 7 AM shall be doubled pursuant to section 2-62.2 B. Note: Keep in mind the firefighter will only receive the hourly credit based on the time that he/she reports to the scene, example, a 3 hour call and you get there in the last hour you will receive credit for one call for the hour you were there.

#### **2-64.4: Attendance with another Company.**

- A. When attending a fire call with another Elmwood Park Fire company, personnel shall be required to follow

all of the procedures set forth in section 2-62.3 of this ordinance. Upon returning to the fire station, the member shall obtain an attendance slip from the company officer of the responding company in which the call was attended. The attendance slip shall be completed and signed by the member and the issuing company officer. The issuing company shall keep the white copy; the yellow copy shall be submitted to the members' company officer; the member shall maintain the pink copy for record.

- B. The attendance slip must be submitted to the company captain prior to the end of the month. Attendance slips may not be carried over to the next month. Late submission shall not be accepted.

#### **2-64.5: Record Keeping**

- A. The company captain shall maintain accurate records and submit a stipend report to the Stipend Committee, which shall be comprised of four firematic officers of the Elmwood Park Fire Department as selected by the Chief of the Department in accordance with the schedule that is set by the Committee.
- B. The Chief of Department shall insure that all of the records are accurate and shall submit a Department stipend request with supporting documentation to the Mayor and Council for payment.

#### **2-64.6: Payment**

Payment for attending Fire Calls, as defined above, shall be earned monthly and payable quarterly at the following rates:

- A. Tier 1 (40% attendance in a month) payment will be based upon \$2,000.00 per year.
  - B. Tier 2 (60% attendance in a month) payment will be based upon \$3,000.00 per year.
- A. Although stipends shall be earned and records maintained and forwarded on a monthly basis, the stipend payments shall be made by the Borough on a quarterly basis.
  - B. The stipend program shall not affect the department's payment of the clothing allowance.

#### **2-64.7: Violations**

- A. Any member of the Department found to have violated the Stipend Program in any way to insure that he/she or another member receives a monthly payment shall 1) be suspended immediately for 30 days and will be brought up on official Elmwood



Pak Fire Department charges with a recommendation for termination; and 2) forfeit his or her eligibility to receive stipends in the future.

**2-64.8: Stipend Figures**

- A. Tier 1 payment @ 40% = \$166.75 a Month X 12 Months = a maximum of \$2,000.00 per year.
- B. Tier 2 payment @ 60% = \$250.00 a Month X 12 Months = a maximum of \$3,000.00 per year.

**2-64.9: Evaluation**

This program shall be implemented beginning on January 1, 2017 and shall be evaluated by the Mayor and Council after the first 18 months of implementation in order to determine whether to continue, modify or amend the stipend program. The stipend program shall continue if the fire call participation percentage, based upon all members of the department, demonstrates an average participation rate of at least thirty percent (30%).


**Section 3.** If any part of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

**Section 4.** All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed or amended to the extent of such inconsistency.

**Section 5.** This Ordinance shall take effect upon final passage and publication according to law.

**AUTHORIZE SHARED SERVICE AGREEMENT BETWEEN BERGEN COUNTY &  
THE BOROUGH OF ELMWOOD PARK FOR INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENTS  
AND SIGNALIZATION AT MARKET STREET AND BOULEVARD**

**WHEREAS** an agreement is necessary to delineate the responsibilities of the County and the Borough of Elmwood Park for the improvement and signalization of Market Street and Boulevard;

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, upon the recommendation of the Department of Planning & Engineering that the County of Bergen be and is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with the Borough of Elmwood Park with the following condition:

**RESPONSIBILITIES:**

**A. COUNTY OF BERGEN:** The County of Bergen is solely responsible for the performance and cost of the following:

1. Design the intersection layout including road alignment, lane configuration, traffic signal design, electrical plans, and signing and striping plans, in accordance with all applicable Federal, State and County guidelines. Consideration will be given to municipal input in the design process.
2. Prepare the bid specifications for the intersection improvement project.
3. Review and approve the final construction drawings, advertise for bids, award construction contracts, and make payments to the contractor.
4. Undertake the construction and re-signalization of the intersection of Market Street & Boulevard in accordance with the design plans.
5. Perform construction management and inspection.
6. At completion and acceptance of intersection improvement project, maintain all traffic signs (other than parking signs) and pavement markings on the County road and Borough road approaches within the limits shown on the plan.
7. After completion and acceptance of traffic signal, own, operate and maintain the traffic signal system.
8. The County will only install topsoil/grass seed or macadam within disturbed areas of the existing and proposed easements or rights-of-way within the project limits.

**B. BOROUGH OF ELMWOOD PARK:** The Borough of Elmwood Park is solely responsible for the performance and cost of the following:

1. Perform all necessary survey and field work, certified by a licensed surveyor, which shall be submitted to the County, in AutoCAD format, for its use in designing the project.
2. Provide the County with individual acquisition maps showing the land to be acquired, together with description of same.
3. Acquire any necessary property, slope rights, temporary and permanent construction easements, as well as any rights of entry, in the name of the municipality, and, if necessary, convey same to the County.
4. Prepare final construction plans based on the field survey and the County's conceptual design plans. Reproduce sets of the construction plans and specification, as requested by the County, for bidding and for contractor use. Documents shall be of a suitable quality and size as requested by the County.
5. Prepare and submit plans and application fee to Bergen County Soil Conservation District for Soil Erosion and Sediment Control permit as required for the project. Obtain all other permits required to perform the project.
6. Be responsible for restoration, modification, alteration, relocation or removal of any appurtenances located within the easements or rights-of-way, including but not limited to landscaping, planters, walls, fences, signs, building structures, awnings, underground storage tanks, utilities, fire hydrants, monitoring wells, parking lots, etc. The Borough's responsibility shall include but not be limited to the relocation of the military tank on the northwest corner and the Elmwood Park Diner sign on Market Street.
7. If any structure within and/or adjacent to the easement or right-of-way is not currently in compliance with the High Voltage Proximity Act or would not be in compliance with the High Voltage Proximity Act as measured from the existing and/or proposed overhead utility line location, the structures shall be relocated so that they will be in compliance with the High Voltage Proximity Act (NJSA 34:6-47.1 (b), "High voltage lines" and NJSA 34:6-4.2 Prohibited Activity).
8. If stamped crosswalks are used, the Borough is responsible for the difference in cost between textured bituminous concrete surface course (crosswalks) and bituminous concrete surface. The cost of proposed sidewalk (concrete or decorative) in areas that do not currently have sidewalk is the responsibility of the Borough.
9. If any type of enhanced sidewalk design is used including scored concrete, brick pavers, etc. the difference in cost between enhanced sidewalk and concrete sidewalk is the responsibility of the Borough.
10. If decorative (powder coated or otherwise) traffic signal poles are used, the difference in cost between standard steel traffic signal poles and arms, and decorative steel poles and arms is a municipal responsibility. The municipality is also required to stock replacement decorative poles and arms in the event of an emergency repair.
11. Own and maintain any shade trees placed within the easement or rights-of-way. The County prefers that trees be placed outside of the rights-of-way.
12. Provide uniform police officers, at the Borough's sole expense, for the maintenance and protection of traffic in accordance with the following:
  - a. It is mandatory to have municipal police present when intersecting roadways cannot be fully closed to frame during the following construction phases: Installation of underground traffic signal conduit in the intersection; installation of



underground storm-water drainage systems in the intersection; installation of new overhead traffic signal hardware or removal of existing traffic signal hardware; performing work within 100' of a signalized intersection: pavement milling operations; final paving operations; sign "turn- on".

- b. The municipality shall provide police when the Chief of Police deems their presence necessary on any County or Municipal road or signalized intersection within the municipality, either during construction, or continued maintenance by the County or the County's contractors.
  - c. The municipality shall provide police when requested by the County Engineering Division.
  - d. All municipal Police costs will be at the sole expense of the municipality. Only certified traffic floggers (not Police) used by the contractor will be compensated by the County in accordance with the bid documents.
13. The American with Disabilities Act Accessibility Guidelines requires all pedestrian facilities within the project scope to be reconstructed in strict compliance with ADA guidelines. The municipality agrees to provide signed and sealed handicap ramp plans to be incorporated into the construction plans, as well as signed and sealed County "Compliant Design Certification" forms. Upon completion of the intersection improvement project, the municipality agrees to provide signed and sealed "as-built" plans of the handicap ramps, and County "Compliant Construction Certification" forms. The municipality also acknowledges and agrees that, per State Statute, ownership and maintenance of the sidewalk, handicap ramps, and curbs are the responsibility of the municipality. The municipality shall hold the County harmless with respect to any action arising out of the design and construction of the municipality's sidewalks, handicap ramps and curbs.
  14. Own and maintain any island constructed within the intersection, with the exception of any traffic signal equipment, which will be maintained by the County. Per state statute, the County is only responsible for road maintenance from curb face to curb face.
  15. Provide the County with any survey information necessary for the construction layout of the intersection, as well as provide "as-built" construction plans (including the signing and striping) at project completion.
  16. Adopt by ordinance the necessary traffic regulations as determined by the finalized intersection layout and traffic signal plans. The municipality agrees to submit a certified copy of the ordinance, resolution, and/or regulations to the County.
  17. Grant permission to the County to install, maintain, and repair any portion of the traffic signal equipment located in or adjacent to the intersection.
  18. Maintain all parking regulatory signs on the County and Borough road approaches to the intersection. The Borough will require the property owner to maintain the One Way, Stop, Do Not Enter, and turn prohibition signs on the commercial driveway approaches. (The County will maintain the far side turn prohibition signs).
  19. Provide continued electrical power for traffic signals and street lights.
  20. Conduct a street lighting survey and provide additional lighting facilities, as indicated by the survey.
  21. Provide to the County prior to the construction contract award the funding necessary for any construction items deemed to be a municipal responsibility, either in accordance with the responsibilities outlined above or as deemed by the County Engineer if items are not addressed herein. The cost estimate of same will be as determined by the Engineer's estimate. Upon knowing final project costs and the actual municipal share of the project, the municipality shall either 1) provide additional funding to the County to cover the actual cost of items that are a municipal

responsibility, or 2) reimbursed the difference between actual cost and the estimated cost for municipal items if actual costs were less than estimated costs.


22. The municipality's design engineer shall be available through the bidding process and completion of construction in order to address design related issues that may arise, including but not limited to: design related Requests for Information (RFI's) from potential bidders or the contractor; field conflicts; field modifications; design changes, etc.
