

ORDINANCE 17-02

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 3 OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF ELMWOOD PARK TITLED "POLICE REGULATIONS"

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND the Code of the Borough of Elmwood Park by amending Section 3-16 titled "Games of Chance and Raffles on Sunday "

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park as follows:

Section 1. Section 3-16 of the Code of the Borough of Elmwood Park is hereby amended by repealing the existing section and replacing it with the following:

§ 3-16.1 Raffle; raffle license.

Pursuant to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 5:8-51, the Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park may issue a license to any qualified organization, as that term is defined in N.J.A.C. 13:47-1.1, to hold and operate the specific kind of game or games of chance commonly known as a "raffle" or "raffles," played by drawing for prizes or the allotment of prizes by chance, by the selling of shares or tickets or rights to participate in such game or games and by conducting the game or games accordingly when the entire net proceeds of such games of chance are to be devoted to educational, charitable, patriotic, religious or public-spirited uses and, in the case of senior citizen associations and clubs, to the support of these organizations and for any such organization or association, church, congregation, society, club, company or squad when so licensed (or without any license when a senior citizen association or club holds, operates and conducts games of chance solely for the amusement and recreation of its members under a special license issued pursuant to N.J.S.A. 5:8-51.1) to hold, operate and conduct such game of chance by its active members pursuant to law and such license in the Borough of Elmwood Park and to sell shares or tickets or rights to participate in such game or games of chance therein and under such conditions and regulations for the supervision and conduct thereof as shall be prescribed by the rules and regulations duly adopted from time to time by the Legalized Games of Chance Control Commission, but only when the entire net proceeds thereof are devoted to the uses afore stated, and for any person or persons to participate in and play such games of chance conducted under any such license.

§ 3-16.2 Procedure for license application.

Each applicant for a license shall file with the Borough Clerk a written application as provided for in N.J.S.A. 5:8-52 and N.J.A.C. 13:47-3.2 (Form 2R-A).

§ 3-16.3 Filing of application.

License application shall be filed in quadruplicate with the Municipal Clerk in accordance with the provision of N.J.A.C.13:47-3.3, or as such regulations may be amended. One copy shall be retained by the Municipal Clerk, the second copy shall be returned to the applicant after a license has been granted or denied; third copy shall be forwarded to the Control Commission by the Municipal Clerk and the fourth copy shall be delivered to the Police Department. The application shall be submitted to the Borough Clerk not later than during her regular business hours on the Tuesday preceding any regular meeting of the Mayor and Council. License fees shall be set as set forth in N.J.S.A. 5:8-53.

§ 3-16.4 Time of operation restricted.

On-premises raffle, as defined by law and the rules and regulations of said Legalized Games of Chance Commission, shall not be conducted after midnight of the day for which a license has been issued to conduct said games of chance.

§ 3-16.5 Sunday operation permitted.

Licenses for raffles are hereby authorized to be issued covering operation of said games on Sunday, under the authority of N.J.S.A. 5:8-31 and 5:8-58.

§ 3-16.6 Violations and penalties.

Any person, firm, or corporation violating any of the provisions of this chapter shall be subject to such penalties as are provided for in Chapter I, Section 1-5 General Ordinances of the Borough of Elmwood Park.

§ 3-16.7 Authority to approve granting of raffle licenses.

The Borough Clerk is hereby delegated the authority to approve the granting of raffle licenses within the Borough of Elmwood Park.

Section 2. If any part of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

Section 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed or amended to the extent of such inconsistency.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect upon final passage and publication according to law.



ORDINANCE 17-03**

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND the Code of the Borough of Elmwood Park, Chapter III thereof, entitled Police Regulations, to add a new section providing for the prohibition of overnight parking at the Elmwood Park Public Library.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park as follows:

Section 1. Chapter III of the Code of the Borough of Elmwood Park is hereby amended to add a new section as follows:

3-7 Prohibition of overnight parking at the Elmwood Park Public Library.

3-7.1 It shall be unlawful for any person to park, permit the parking of, or leave unattended, any vehicle, in the Elmwood Park Public Library parking lot overnight or at any time when the library is not open to the public.

3-7.2 Failure to comply with the provisions of this section shall subject the owner of the vehicle to a fine of one hundred (\$100.00) dollars for a first violation. For a second violation, the owner of the vehicle shall be subject to a fine of two hundred (\$200.00) dollars. For a third or subsequent violation, the owner of the vehicle shall be subject to a fine of three hundred (\$300.00) dollars.

Section 2. If any part of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of the Ordinance.

Section 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed or amended to the extent of such inconsistency.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect upon final passage and publication according to law.

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE BOROUGH OF ELMWOOD PARK, BY AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING CHAPTER 4-6 ENTITLED "HAWKERS, PEDDLERS AND SOLICITORS" TO AUTHORIZE "NO SOLICITATION SIGNS"

SECTION 1. Chapter 4-6.7 of the Borough Code is hereby deleted and replaced by the following:

4-6.7 General Regulations.

All persons to whom a license shall be issued hereunder shall observe the following regulations, and for any violation thereof, the license shall be immediately revoked by the Chief of Police.

- a. No person or vehicle shall stand or be parked for the purpose of displaying or selling wares or merchandise on public or private property within a business district.
- b. No person covered by this section shall sell or attempt to sell, in accordance with the terms of this section, before 9:00 a.m. or after 9:00 p.m., prevailing time. The aforesaid time limitation shall not apply to persons who are expressly invited into homes by the occupant thereof.
- c. No person shall hawk or sell wares within a distance of five hundred (500) feet of the nearest public building or commercial establishment.
- d. No vehicle shall be parked upon any public street, at a fixed location, for the purpose of displaying or selling wares or merchandise.
- e. A. Display of No Solicitation Signs. All residents of the Borough may display "No Solicitation" signs in a clearly visible location (e.g., front door or window adjacent to the front door) indicating that they do not want individuals or organizations that are required to register and obtain a permit under this Chapter (e.g., canvassers, distributors, solicitors, peddlers, transient merchant or hawkers of any sort) to approach their homes and/or seek personal contact with the occupants of the residence displaying a "No Solicitation" sign. By displaying a "No Solicitation" sign, the resident acknowledges that the Borough Police, Fire and other Emergency Services groups are exempt from the requirements of this section. No hawker, peddler or solicitor may attempt to contact any person who resides in a location which displays a "No Solicitation" sign.

SECTION 2. If any provision or portion of a provision of this ordinance is held to be unconstitutional, preempted by Federal or State law, or otherwise invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining provisions of the ordinance shall not be invalidated and shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days after final adoption and publication required by law.

SECTION 4. All ordinances and parts of ordinances which are inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.



Installation, replacement, and repair of existing meters shall be charged at actual current cost for labor and material incurred by the Water Department of the Borough of Elmwood Park and/or Passaic Valley Water Commission.

F. All commercial users having meters in excess of 3/4" must have them in working order at all times. In the event said meter is inoperative, and no attempt is made for repair/replacement of same, the existing estimated bill shall be tripled the existing estimated rate, upon the effective date of this ordinance. In the event no meter in excess of 3/4" exist, in addition to the tripled estimated bill, the landlord shall be required to purchase and install same upon written order of the Superintendent of Public Works.

Section 4: "In the event that payment for water charges is in arrears for 30 days from date of billing, the Borough shall send a delinquent notice regular mail, to the owner, occupier, user or responsible party being billed. After 60 days, a door tag shall be hand delivered to terminate water service. On the 67th day of non payment from date of billing, water service will be terminated, and not reinstated until all fees, penalties, are paid in full in cash.

Section 4b: "In the event, that water charges are in the arrears, after 60 days, a door tag will be delivered to terminate water service and a fee of \$40.00 will be assessed on to the delinquent water bill.

Section 5: All unpaid water charges as of 12/31 of the present year shall become a Tax Lien on said premises.

Section 6: All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with or in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict or inconsistency. This shall take effect after final passage and publication as required by law.

Section 7: All billings as of March 1, 2017 and thereafter will be subject to said rate.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

Councilman Work congratulated all the Fire Department Officers that were sworn in tonight. He further thanked all the fire fighters that attended tonight's meeting to show their support. He further thanked former Chief Pressler for all the work he put into obtaining a grant for new breathing apparatus. He discussed the sport programs that have ongoing registrations and their contact information. Councilman Work discussed the scheduling for the public to attend games for both basketball and indoor hockey. He discussed a Recreation flier that was mailed to all residents which outlines all the scheduled events for 2017.

Councilman Dombrowski congratulated all the Officers on their promotions and wished the best of luck to Chief Shadwell. He discussed the upcoming Homeowners Association meeting which will have Borough CFO Roy Riggitano as the guest speaker. He discussed upcoming event for both the Homeowner's Association and the Chamber of Commerce. He discussed Inauguration Day.

Councilman Vuoncino discussed items that are before the Planning Board. He discussed a recent meeting of the Library Construction Committee. He is happy with the Library Board and the Council working together in moving forward with the Capital Plan. Councilman Vuoncino stated the electric auction pertaining to SEMS is approaching and soon will be able to report back on the cost the Borough will pay for our electric commodity. He congratulated everyone on their promotions tonight and thanked former Chief Pressler for all he has done. He discussed Inauguration Day and hopes for a peaceful transition.

Council President Giandomenico discussed the planning of budget meeting in the near future. She thanked former Chief Pressler and congratulated all the officers that were sworn in tonight.

Councilman Chirido discussed repairs to the roadway by the Department of Public Works. He direction anyone who would like to report a pothole should contact the Department of Public Works. He discussed the Construction Committee and what the goal is.

Glen Pettigano, Philip Avenue, discussed that Borough appointed towers are not based within the Borough and the costs that residents have paid when their vehicles have been towed. Mayor Colletti discussed a recent discussion pertaining to town towers and meetings being planned to address some of the concerns Mr. Pettigano has. Mr. Kazmark stated that towing rates are set by ordinance and are the same whether the tower is based within Elmwood Park or a neighboring town. He further stated the ordinance is being reviewed and will be brought back to the Council for possible action.

Jeffrey Frietag, Hillman Drive, inquired as to whether a variance has already been issued to one of the local towers. Mr. Kazmark stated the other towers were pre-existing non-conforming uses. Mr. Frietag discussed the survey regarding the parks and inquired if the link can be placed on the Borough's website.

Frank Caramagna, Gilbert Avenue, stated the sound system in the Council Chambers could use some improvement and asked the Council consider adding some speakers. He then discussed the

Borough being responsible for the cleanup of the County Park if the town took ownership and the potential costs. He inquired as to what type of improvements can be made to the marina.
