BOROUGH OF ELMWOOD PARK
CALENDAR YEAR 2017
ORDINANCE TO EXCEED THE MUNICIPAL BUDGET APPROPRIATION LIMITS
AND TO ESTABLISH A CAP BANK
(N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-45.14)

WHEREAS, the Local Government Cap Law, N.J.S. 40A: 4-45.1 et seq., provides that in the preparation of its annual budget, a municipality shall limit any increase in said budget up to .5% unless authorized by ordinance to increase it to 3.5% over the previous year's final appropriations, subject to certain exceptions; and,

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-45.15a provides that a municipality may, when authorized by ordinance, appropriate the difference between the amount of its actual final appropriation and the 3.5% percentage rate as an exception to its final appropriations in either of the next two succeeding years; and,

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park in the County of Bergen finds it advisable and necessary to increase its CY 2017 budget by up to 3.5% over the previous year's final appropriations, in the interest of promoting the health, safety and welfare of the citizens; and,

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council hereby determines that a 3 % increase in the budget for said year, amounting to \$565,658 in excess of the increase in final appropriations otherwise permitted by the Local Government Cap Law, is advisable and necessary; and,

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council hereby determines that any amount authorized hereinabove that is not appropriated as part of the final budget shall be retained as an exception to final appropriation in either of the next two succeeding years.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park in the County of Bergen, a majority of the full authorized membership of this governing body affirmatively concurring, that, in the CY 2017 budget year, the final appropriations of the Borough of Elmwood Park shall, in accordance with this ordinance and N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-45.14, be increased by 3 %, amounting to \$565,658, and that the CY 2017 municipal budget for the Borough of Elmwood Park be approved and adopted in accordance with this ordinance; and,

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that any that any amount authorized hereinabove that is not appropriated as part of the final budget shall be retained as an exception to final appropriation in either of the next two succeeding years; and,

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that a certified copy of this ordinance as introduced be filed with the Director of the Division of Local Government Services within 5 days of introduction; and,

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that a certified copy of this ordinance upon adoption, with the recorded vote included thereon, be filed with said Director within 5 days after such adoption.



**BOROUGH OF ELMWOOD PARK
ORDINANCE #17-07**

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND the Code of the Borough of Elmwood Park by amending Chapter 4 thereof, titled "Towers and Towing."

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park as follows:

Section 1. The Code of the Borough of Elmwood Park is hereby amended by deleting Chapter 4-34.1 through 4-34.4 titled "Towers and Towing" in its entirety and replacing it with the following:

4-34 WRECKERS AND TOW TRUCKS.

4-34.1 Definitions.

As used in this section, the following terms shall have the meanings indicated:

Cruising shall mean the operation of an unengaged wrecker along the public streets in any fashion intended likely or calculated to solicit business.

Owner shall mean a person, firm or corporation who owns and/or operates a vehicle on the roads and highways within the Borough of Elmwood Park, which vehicle, by reason of being disabled or being unlawfully upon said roads, requires towing services.

Towing operator shall mean a person, firm or corporation engaged in the business of providing wrecker services and storage services for vehicles towed, which services are made available to the general public upon such rates, charges and fees as determined by said person, firm or corporation and who is licensed under the provisions of this section.

Wrecker shall mean a vehicle driven by mechanical power and employed for the purpose of towing, transporting, conveying or removing any and all kinds of vehicles or parts of vehicles which are unable to be operated under their own power, for which a service charge or fee is exacted.

4-34.2 License Required; Fees; Expiration.

a. *License Required.* No towing operator shall operate within the Borough of Elmwood Park without obtaining a license in accordance with the provisions of this section. Specifically exempted are towing operators which are directly and privately engaged or designated by the owner of the vehicle towed, transported, conveyed or removed, as long as the towing operator does not also provide towing services to the general public.

b. The fee for the license issued under this section shall be five hundred (\$500.00) dollars. The license shall remain in effect from January 1 to December 31 of each year or any part thereof.

c. Applications for a towing license shall be made available to the public at the Borough Clerk's office on October 1 and shall be due no later than October 31 of that year. The Borough shall post notice of opportunities for licenses on its website and in the official Borough newspaper. Applications will be investigated by the Police Department on a first-come-first-served basis. The first four towing contractors who submit completed applications to the Borough Clerk and who, upon investigation by the Police Department, are determined by the Police Department to successfully meet all of the requirements for towing services of this article shall be issued towing licenses.

4-34.3 License Application.

An application for a license as a proprietor of a towing or wrecking business shall be made by the person or firm engaged in operating a wrecker or wreckers. The fee for applying for such license shall be five hundred (\$500.00) dollars. The application shall be made on forms furnished by the Police Department and specifically report the following facts:

a. The full name and address of the applicant. If the application is made for a corporation, it shall state the names and addresses of the officers and directors thereof, its registered office and its registered agent.

b. The year, make and type of each wrecker used in said business, its serial number, registration number and registered owner.

c. The street address of the applicant's storage facilities, including a description of size and capacity.

d. The address where the wrecker or wreckers shall be regularly garaged, the telephone numbers available on a twenty-four-hour-per-day basis and the names of all operators, their addresses and the driver's license numbers of their New Jersey motor vehicle licenses. In order to ensure rapid response to requests for service, all applicants shall maintain a regular place of business within the Borough of Elmwood Park, or within a reasonable distance of the Borough of Elmwood Park not to exceed three (3) miles.

4-34.4 Operating Conditions.

By making application to be licensed as a towing operator in the Borough of Elmwood Park, the person or firm agrees to the following conditions:

a. Provide a prompt, courteous response to each call.

b. Clean all debris at the accident site emanating from an accident.

c. Provide the Police Department with the following information on vehicles unclaimed over thirty (30) days:

1. Year, make, color, registration and vehicle identification number.

2. Owner's name and address.

3. Copy of certified letter advising the owner of the vehicle's whereabouts.

4. Photograph of vehicle.

d. Maintain a record in a bound volume of all towing and wrecking jobs handled, the name of the owner or operator involved, the charge made for the service, the date and the amount of payment.

e. Maintain a written schedule of all rates and charges, in compliance with this agreement, and make such schedule available when requested; have conspicuously displayed at the place of business, either painted or permanently affixed, a schedule of maximum towing charges and storage charges permitted by this section. Business hours shall be posted. Whenever practicable, the owner or driver of any vehicle utilizing towing service shall be given a copy of a full statement of rates at the time that the towing services are rendered. In any event, a full schedule of rates shall be annexed to each bill for towing service.

f. No towing operator or firm licensed under this section may charge rates in excess of the following for towing, conveying, road service or storage of a motor vehicle:

1. Service charges shall be as follows:

(a) Jumpstarts between 8:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. weekdays: \$50.00. Between 6:00 p.m. and 8:00 a.m., the following day: \$60.00.

(b) Road service at any other time: \$60.00, plus \$1.75 per mile.

(c) The service charge assessed for the release of a towed vehicle during other than the business hours of 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.: \$0.00 (no charge).

2. Towing charges shall be as follows:

- (a) Automobiles between 8:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. weekdays: \$75.00, plus \$1.75 per mile.
- (b) Automobiles between 6:00 p.m. and 8:00 a.m., weekends and holidays: \$100.00, plus \$1.75 per mile.
- (c) Vehicles over ten thousand pounds: not to exceed \$200.00 per hour, which includes operator and vehicle.

3. Dolly service charges shall be as follows:

- (a) Any automobile, at any time: \$25.00.
- (b) Flatbed truck between 8:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m.: \$125.00, plus \$1.75 per mile.
- g. Flatbed truck between 6:00 p.m. and 8:00 a.m.: \$150.00, plus \$1.75 per mile.

1. Winching service charges shall be \$30.00 per hour.

2. The service charge for storage after twenty-four (24) hours shall be as follows:

- (a) Inside building storage facility with a capacity of twenty-one (21) or more spaces: \$30.00 per day.
- (b) Outside secured storage facility with a capacity of twenty-one (21) or more spaces: \$20.00 per day.
- (c) Outside storage for commercial vehicles for trucks over one (1) ton, buses, tractor-trailers: \$50.00 per day.

3. Notwithstanding the foregoing provisions, no towing operator licensed by the Borough of Elmwood Park shall charge or receive fees for towing, services or storage at rates higher than that permitted by the New Jersey State Department of Insurance.

h. In addition to the fees set forth herein, each vehicle towed shall be charged a forty (\$40.00) dollar administrative fee. The administrative fee shall be collected by the tower and remitted to the Borough of Elmwood Park within thirty (30) days.



AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE BOROUGH OF ELMWOOD PARK, BY AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING CHAPTER 4-6 ENTITLED "HAWKERS, PEDDLERS AND SOLICITORS" TO AUTHORIZE "NO SOLICITATION SIGNS"

SECTION 1. Chapter 4-6.7 of the Borough Code is hereby deleted and replaced by the following:

4-6.7 General Regulations.

All persons to whom a license shall be issued hereunder shall observe the following regulations, and for any violation thereof, the license shall be immediately revoked by the Chief of Police.

- a. No person or vehicle shall stand or be parked for the purpose of displaying or selling wares or merchandise on public or private property within a business district.
- b. No person covered by this section shall sell or attempt to sell, in accordance with the terms of this section, before 9:00 a.m. or after 5:00 p.m., prevailing time. The aforesaid time limitation shall not apply to persons who are expressly invited into homes by the occupant thereof.
- c. No person shall hawk or sell wares within a distance of five hundred (500) feet of the nearest public building or commercial establishment.
- d. No vehicle shall be parked upon any public street, at a fixed location, for the purpose of displaying or selling wares or merchandise.
- e. A. Display of No Solicitation Signs. All residents of the Borough may display "No Solicitation" signs in a clearly visible location (e.g., front door or window adjacent to the front door) indicating that they do not want individuals or organizations that are required to register and obtain a permit under this Chapter (e.g., canvassers, distributors, solicitors, peddlers, transient merchant or hawkers of any sort) to approach their homes and/or seek personal contact with the occupants of the residence displaying a "No Solicitation" sign. By displaying a "No Solicitation" sign, the resident acknowledges that the Borough Police, Fire and other Emergency Services groups are exempt from the requirements of this section. No hawker, peddler or solicitor may attempt to contact any person who resides in a location which displays a "No Solicitation" sign.

SECTION 2. If any provision or portion of a provision of this ordinance is held to be unconstitutional, preempted by Federal or State law, or otherwise invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining provisions of the ordinance shall not be invalidated and shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days after final adoption and publication required by law.

SECTION 4. All ordinances and parts of ordinances which are inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.





AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED, “AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH THE WATER DEPARTMENT OF THE BOROUGH OF ELMWOOD PARK, BERGEN COUNTY, NEW JERSEY, TO FIX THE RATES AND PRICES TO BE CHARGED FOR THE USE OF WATER AND ESTABLISH RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE DISTRIBUTION, SUPPLY, USE AND PROTECTION OF SAID WATER AND PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION OF CERTAIN SAID RULES AND REGULATIONS.

WHEREAS, due to a aggregate 5 % increase in water consumption from bulk water supplier, Passaic Valley Water Commission, the following is necessary;

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Council, of the Borough of Elmwood Park as follows:

Section 1 A fixed charge known as “the service charge,” will be made to each Consumer for each meter based on the size of the meter or connection regardless of the amount of water consumed as follows:

5/8 in. Meter (average 1 and 2 family homes)	\$46.74
¾ in. Meter	\$52.57
1 in. Meter	\$56.07

Section 2: The following water rates and changes are hereby established for water supplied by the Department.

The minimum quarterly bill for metered service shall be “the service charge”entitling the consumer to 5,000 gallons of water per quarter. All water supplied through meters in excess of the minimum quarterly bill, shall be charged to each consumer at the rate of:

\$5.16 per 1,000 gallons over 5,000 gallons

\$5.60 per 1,000 gallons over 70,000 gallons

\$6.35 per 1,000 gallons over 150,000 gallons

\$6.81 per 1,000 gallons over 300,000 gallons

Installation, replacement, and repair of existing meters shall be charged at actual current cost for labor and material incurred by the Water Department of the Borough of Elmwood Park and/or Passaic Valley Water Commission.

F. All commercial users having meters in excess of ¾” must have them in working order at all times. In the event said meter is inoperative, and no attempt is made for repair/replacement of same, the existing estimated bill shall be tripled the existing estimated rate, upon the effective date of this ordinance. In the event no meter in excess of ¾” exist, in addition to the tripled estimated bill, the landlord shall be required to purchase and install same upon written order of the Superintendent of Public Works.

Section 4: “In the event that payment for water charges is in arrears for 30 days from date of billing, the Borough shall send a delinquent notice regular mail, to the owner, occupier, user or responsible party being billed. After 60 days, a door tag shall be hand delivered to terminate water service. On the 67th day of non payment from date of billing, water service will be terminated, and not reinstated until all fees, penalties, are paid in full in cash.

\$137.13 turn on fee, is made to the Borough of Elmwood Park.

Section 4b: “In the event, that water charges are in the arrears, after 60 days, a door tag will be delivered to terminate water service and a fee of \$40.00 will be assessed on to the delinquent water bill.

Section 5: All unpaid water charges as of 12/31 of the present year shall become a Tax Lien on said premises.

Section 6: All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with or in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict or inconsistency. This shall take effect after final passage and publication as required by law.

Section 7: All billings as of March 1, 2017 and thereafter will be subject to said rate.

Section 1.

2-22 PUBLIC DEFENDER.

- a. Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 2A:158A-1 et seq., there is hereby created the Office of the Municipal Public Defender of the Borough.
- b. The Municipal Public Defender shall be an attorney-at-law of the State of New Jersey and shall provide representation to indigent defendants who qualify for appointment of counsel as required by law; the Municipal Court Judge shall approve all applications for appointment of the Public Defender to represent said persons as required by law.
- c. The term of office of the Municipal Public Defender shall be for one (1) year, effective January 1st of each year and until December 31st of the same year and until the appointment and qualification of a successor.
- d. The compensation of the Municipal Public Defender shall be based upon a retainer as provided for in the current Salary Ordinance of the Borough.
- e. Those persons applying for representation by the Municipal Public Defender shall pay an application fee of two hundred (\$200.00) dollars at the time of presentation of an application for the Public Defender. The Judge of the Municipal Court may, however, in his or her discretion, waive any required application fee in whole or in part if the Judge determines, in his or her discretion, that the application fee represents an unreasonable burden on the person seeking representation.

Section 2. If any part of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

Section 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed or amended to the extent of such inconsistency.

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 3 OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF ELMWOOD PARK TITLED "POLICE REGULATIONS"

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND the Code of the Borough of Elmwood Park by amending Section 3-16 titled "Games of Chance and Raffles on Sunday "

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park as follows:

Section 1. Section 3-16 of the Code of the Borough of Elmwood Park is hereby amended by repealing the existing section and replacing it with the following:

§ 3-16.1 Raffle; raffle license.

Pursuant to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 5:8-51, the Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park may issue a license to any qualified organization, as that term is defined in N.J.A.C. 13:47-1.1, to hold and operate the specific kind of game or games of chance commonly known as a "raffle" or "raffles," played by drawing for prizes or the allotment of prizes by chance, by the selling of shares or tickets or rights to participate in such game or games and by conducting the game or games accordingly when the entire net proceeds of such games of chance are to be devoted to educational, charitable, patriotic, religious or public-spirited uses and, in the case of senior citizen associations and clubs, to the support of these organizations and for any such organization or association, church, congregation, society, club, company or squad when so licensed (or without any license when a senior citizen association or club holds, operates and conducts games of chance solely for the amusement and recreation of its members under a special license issued pursuant to N.J.S.A. 5:8-51.1) to hold, operate and conduct such game of chance by its active members pursuant to law and such license in the Borough of Elmwood Park and to sell shares or tickets or rights to participate in such game or games of chance therein and under such conditions and regulations for the supervision and conduct thereof as shall be prescribed by the rules and regulations duly adopted from time to time by the Legalized Games of Chance Control Commission, but only when the entire net proceeds thereof are devoted to the uses afore stated, and for any person or persons to participate in and play such games of chance conducted under any such license.

§ 3-16.2 Procedure for license application.

Each applicant for a license shall file with the Borough Clerk a written application as provided for in N.J.S.A. 5:8-52 and N.J.A.C. 13:47-3.2 (Form 2R-A).

§ 3-16.3 Filing of application.

License application shall be filed in quadruplicate with the Municipal Clerk in accordance with the provision of N.J.A.C.13:47-3.3, or as such regulations may be amended. One copy shall be retained by the Municipal Clerk, the second copy shall be returned to the applicant after a license has been granted or denied; third copy shall be forwarded to the Control Commission by the Municipal Clerk and the fourth copy shall be delivered to the Police Department. The application shall be submitted to the Borough Clerk not later than during her regular business hours on the Tuesday preceding any regular meeting of the Mayor and Council. License fees shall be set as set forth in N.J.S.A. 5:8-53.

§ 3-16.4 Time of operation restricted.

On-premises raffle, as defined by law and the rules and regulations of said Legalized Games of Chance Commission, shall not be conducted after midnight of the day for which a license has been issued to conduct said games of chance.

§ 3-16.5 Sunday operation permitted.

Licenses for raffles are hereby authorized to be issued covering operation of said games on Sunday, under the authority of N.J.S.A. 5:8-31 and 5:8-58.

§ 3-16.6 Violations and penalties.

Any person, firm, or corporation violating any of the provisions of this chapter shall be subject to such penalties as are provided for in Chapter I, Section 1-5 General Ordinances of the Borough of Elmwood Park.

§ 3-16.7 Authority to approve granting of raffle licenses.

The Borough Clerk is hereby delegated the authority to approve the granting of raffle licenses within the Borough of Elmwood Park.

Section 2. If any part of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

Section 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed or amended to the extent of such inconsistency.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect upon final passage and publication according to law.



**BOROUGH OF ELMWOOD PARK
ORDINANCE 17-03**

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND the Code of the Borough of Elmwood Park, Chapter III thereof, entitled Police Regulations, to add a new section providing for the prohibition of overnight parking at the Elmwood Park Public Library.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park as follows:

Section 1. Chapter III of the Code of the Borough of Elmwood Park is hereby amended to add a new section as follows:

3-7 Prohibition of overnight parking at the Elmwood Park Public Library.

3-7.1 It shall be unlawful for any person to park, permit the parking of, or leave unattended, any vehicle, in the Elmwood Park Public Library parking lot overnight or at any time when the library is not open to the public.


3-7.2 Failure to comply with the provisions of this section shall subject the owner of the vehicle to a fine of one hundred (\$100.00) dollars for a first violation. For a second violation, the owner of the vehicle shall be subject to a fine of two hundred (\$200.00) dollars. For a third or subsequent violation, the owner of the vehicle shall be subject to a fine of three hundred (\$300.00) dollars.

Section 2. If any part of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of the Ordinance.

Section 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed or amended to the extent of such inconsistency.



COMMITTEE REPORTS

Council President Giandomenico discussed recent meetings with Department Head regarding the municipal budget. She reminded residents of the upcoming Board of Education meeting. Council President Giandomenico discussed the upcoming street dedication of Mola Boulevard. She stated her satisfaction with the Council in appointing Millennium Strategies as the Borough's grant writer.

Councilman Chirido discussed snow removal by the Department of Public Works. He also discussed the clearing of snow along sidewalks and around fire hydrants. He then discussed a special meeting held by the Library Board to give residents the opportunity to share their thoughts and suggestions for the capital plan.

Councilman Golabek thanked Elmwood Park Takes Action for meeting with the Council and discussing their desire for creating a Stigma Free Task Force. He stated that it may be the opinion of some residents that violations issued for parking during a snow incident is a cash grab, however he stated it is to ensure residents park legally which will aid in the clearing of snow effectively by the Department of Public Works. He stated it was a wise decision to appoint Millennium Strategies as the Borough's grant writer. He discussed attending the special meeting of the Library Board regarding the Capital plan.
