**BERGEN COUNTY OPEN SPACE, RECREATION, FARMLAND & HISTORIC
PRESERVATION TRUST FUND APPLICATION**

WHEREAS, the Bergen County Open Space, Recreation, Floodplain Protection, Farmland & Historic Preservation Trust Fund ("Bergen County Trust Fund"), provides grants to municipal governments and to nonprofit organizations for assistance in the acquisition of lands for open space conservation purposes and/or outdoor recreation facilities; and,

WHEREAS, the Borough of Elmwood Park desires to further the public interest by obtaining a grant of \$200,000 from the Bergen County Trust Fund to fund the following project: Elmwood Park Memorial High School Tennis Court Restoration Project; and,

WHEREAS, the Borough Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park has reviewed the Bergen County Trust Fund Program Statement, the County Program Open Space Policy and Procedures Manual, and the open space application and instructions and desires to make an application for such a grant and provide application information and furnish such documents as may be required; and,

WHEREAS, as part of the application process, the governing Council will held the required public hearing on June 15, 2017 to receive comments prior to the submission of said application; and,

WHEREAS, the County of Bergen shall determine whether the application is complete and in conformance with the scope and intent of the Bergen County Trust Fund; and,

WHEREAS, the applicant is willing to use the Bergen County Trust Fund in accordance with such rules, regulations and applicable statutes, and is willing to enter into an agreement with the County of Bergen for the above-named project; and

WHEREAS, if the applicant is successful in acquiring said project through the use of a County Trust Fund grant, then the applicant will permanently preserve said project for open space conservation and/or outdoor recreation purposes though a recorded deed of easement.


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Borough Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park:

**AN ORDINANCE TO BAN SMOKING IN PUBLIC PLACES OWNED OR LEASED BY
THE BOROUGH OF ELMWOOD PARK, BERGEN COUNTY, N.J.**

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park as follows:

Section 1. Chapter III of the Code of the Borough of Elmwood Park titled "Police Regulations" is hereby amended to read as follows:

**§3-7 SMOKING PROHIBITED IN PUBLIC PLACES OWNED OR LEASED BY
THE BOROUGH OF ELMWOOD PARK, BERGEN COUNTY, N.J.**

3-7.1 It shall be unlawful for any person to use, possess or maintain any lighted tobacco products or other smoke producing products, including the use of e-cigarettes or vaping, within any public right of way or any property owned or leased by the Borough of Elmwood Park, including parks, playgrounds, ball fields, athletic facilities, and all buildings and properties owned or leased by the Borough of Elmwood Park;

3-7.2 ENFORCEMENT PROVISION

This Ordinance shall be enforced by the Elmwood Park Police Department or its designees. Any person who commits a violation of this section shall, upon conviction thereof, pay a fine not to exceed \$200 providing that, in accordance with 2C:33-13b, adequate notice of such prohibition has been conspicuously posted. Any person may inform any person perceived to be violating this Ordinance, of the provisions of this Ordinance.

Section 2. If any part of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of the Ordinance.

Section 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed or amended to the extent of such inconsistency.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect upon final passage and publication according to law.

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND the Code of the Borough of Elmwood Park, Chapter II thereof, entitled "Administration".

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park as follows:

Section 1. Chapter II of the Code of the Borough of Elmwood Park, entitled "Administration" is hereby amended, and specifically Ordinance 2-27.1, titled "Creation of the Department ; Members" by deleting the existing section and replacing it with the following:

2-27.1 Creation of the Department; Members.

- a. There are hereby created the following positions in the Police Department of the Borough of Elmwood Park:
 1. One (1) Chief of Police;
 2. Two (2) Captains;
 3. Five (5) Lieutenants;
 4. Four (4) Sergeants.
 5. A maximum of Thirty (30) Patrol Officers
- b. In order to provide for a safe and efficient transition when a member or members of the police force give notice of their intent to retire, there shall be permitted a maximum of two additional Patrol Officers (in addition to the number of Patrol Officers set forth in Par. a.5. above) who may be employed for a maximum of six months for the purpose of training and familiarization with police procedures.
- c. Notwithstanding the limitations set forth above, no officer who is currently employed by the Borough shall be removed from his position or reduced in rank as a result of this Table of Organization, however, upon a vacancy occurring in any of the Lieutenant positions, the number of Lieutenants shall be reduced to four (4).

Section 2. If any part of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of the Ordinance.

Section 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed or amended to the extent of such inconsistency.

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND Chapter 3 of the Code of the Borough of Elmwood Park titled "Police Regulations" by amending Sections 3-8.1 thereof.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park as follows:

Section 1. Ordinance 3-8.1 titled "PROHIBITED PARKING" is hereby amended to read as follows:

3-8.1 Prohibited Parking.

The owner or operator of a vehicle shall not stop, stand or park the vehicle in a roadway other than parallel with the edge of the roadway headed in the direction of traffic, on the right-hand side of the road. All four tires must be on the paved portion of the roadway and with the curb side of the vehicle within six inches of the edge of the roadway, except as follows:

- a. Upon those streets which have been designated by ordinance and have been marked or signed for angle parking, vehicles shall be parked at the angle to the curb designated and indicated by the ordinance and marks or signs.
- b. Upon one-way streets, local authorities may permit parking of vehicles parallel with the left-hand edge of the roadway headed in the direction of traffic, on the left-hand side of the road and with the curb side of the vehicle within six inches of the edge of the roadway.

Parking of motor vehicles on lawns, yards or landscaped areas is prohibited.

Section 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed or amended to the extent of such inconsistency.

**BOROUGH OF ELMWOOD PARK
ORDINANCE 17-22**

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND the Code of the Borough of Elmwood Park, Chapter XXXIV thereof, entitled "Zoning and Site Plan Review" by amending Section 34-3.1 "Definitions" to add a definition for Nightclub or Club.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park as follows:

Section 1. Chapter XXXIV "Zoning and Site Plan Review" of the Code of the Borough of Elmwood Park, and specifically section 34-3.1 thereof titled "Definitions" is hereby amended by adding the following:

NIGHTCLUB or CLUB: Venues or establishments offering live entertainment of any kind, with or without food service, with or without the service of alcohol will be considered nightclubs or clubs.

The term Nightclub includes:

1. Places of entertainment open late at night, offering live music and/or dancing, and/or drinks and sometimes serving food;
2. An entertainment venue which conducts its primary business after dark, at night, after normal restaurant or business operating hours.
3. Establishments which hold events where entertainment would not normally be considered an accessory use to the principal permitted use.
4. Establishments which charge admission or require the purchase of tickets or a "cover charge" for entry.

One element of a nightclub or club which will further distinguish the same is that the patrons of such an establishment will be engaged in drinking alcohol and other beverages with less emphasis on food consumption and using the services provided as part of the primary function of the facility.

Exceptions;

Charitable, Political or recognized community clubs holding special events. Special events require the approval of the Mayor and Council.

A use accessory to a restaurant will not be considered a nightclub only when all of the following conditions are met:

- (1) Where the area permanently devoted to the entertainment use is less than 20% of the gross floor area of the public portions of the restaurant, not including hallways, bars and required aisles, coat check areas, smoking areas, waiter stations and rest rooms.
- (2) Where the occupancy is limited to the number of persons for whom there are tables and chairs.
- (3) Where the restaurant continues unrestricted food service, including all advertised specials and all items on the printed menu, until closing.
- (4) Where the restaurant maintains no less than 75% of the total available seating within the establishment for restaurant patrons ordering or consuming meals.
- (5) When entertainment is provided, it is limited to acoustical, nonamplified entertainment.

Any use which is accessory to a restaurant use which does not satisfy all of the conditions described above shall cause the entire use to be defined as a "nightclub" as defined herein.

Section 2. If any part of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of the Ordinance.

Section 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed or amended to the extent of such inconsistency.



SECTION IV: LONGEVITY

1. A full-time employee shall be entitled to longevity pay based in the following schedule:

Completion of the third year to completion of the fifth year	1%
Beginning of the sixth year to the completion of the eighth year	2%
Beginning of the ninth year to the completion of the eleventh year	3%
Beginning of the twelfth year to the completion of the fourteenth year	4%
Beginning of the fifteenth year to the completion of the twentieth year	5%
Beginning of the twenty-first year to the completion of the twenty-fourth year	6%
Beginning of the twenty-fifth year	8%

2. Any employee hired after January 1, 2007 shall not be entitled to longevity.
3. Such payments shall be added to each employee's base annual salary.

- The anniversary date for payroll purposes only of all employees of the Borough of Elmwood Park after having completed one full year employment shall be January 1.

SECTION V: SICK LEAVE

- All full-time employees shall be compensated annually for up to (15) days absence from work by reason of illness. All sick leave shall be accumulated and any unused portion thereof shall be applied towards future illness.

SECTION VI: HOLIDAY & PERSONAL DAYS

- All Borough employees for who there is provided herein an annual compensation shall be excused from the performance of their duties with continuance of pay on the following days:

- In the event that a holiday falls on a Sunday, the following Monday shall be observed as the holiday. In the event that a holiday falls on a Saturday, the preceding Friday shall be observed as the holiday.
- This section shall not apply to part time employees whom are compensated on an hourly basis.

SECTION VII: VACATION

- All full-time employees shall be allowed vacation leave from their employment with continuance of compensation provided herein, in accordance with the following schedule:

One through five years of service	12 days
Completion of the fifth year to ten years of service	12 days plus one day per year for each up to 17 days
Completion of ten years of service	21 days
Completion of twelve years of service	22 days
Completion of fourteen years of service	23 days
Completion of sixteen years of service	24 days
Completion of eighteen years of service	25 days
completion of twenty years of service and thereafter	30 days

- All employees hired after January 1, 2007 cannot accumulate vacation days other than accrued days from (1) year prior.

SECTION VIII: TERMINAL LEAVE

- All employees hired prior to January 1, 1991 that desire to enter into retirement shall receive terminal leave immediately prior to said retirement provided said employee notified the Borough prior to February 15th of the year he/she intends to retire. PERS will then be notified and the retirement application of the employee will be processed. Such leaves shall be computed at the following rate:

1 to 7 years	1 month
8 to 14 years	2 months
15 to 21 years	3 months
22 years and over	4 months

- In addition to leave granted above, each employee shall receive enumeration for ½ of all accumulated sick days from January 1, 1962 immediately prior to retirement of such employee with a maximum accumulation of 120 working days.
- All employees hired on or after January 1, 1991, shall receive the following terminal leave:

After 10 years of service	1 month
After 20 years of service	2 months

- Each employee shall receive his terminal leave payment as a lump sum payment as of the last day of the performance of duty before commencement of his terminal leave.

SECTION IX: SICK/VACATION DAYS FOR FULL TIME CROSSING GUARDS

- All full time crossing guards shall receive 10 sick/vacation days per school year, September through June. At the end of the school year, all full time crossing guards will receive an additional pay of \$25.00 per day for each sick/vacation day not used during the school year.

SECTION X: REPEAL OF PRIOR ORDINANCES

- All prior Department Head, Non-Union and Part Time Salary Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION XI: EFFECTIVE DATE

- This ordinance shall take effect immediately after publication.
