

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING CHAPTER 34 OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF ELMWOOD PARK, BERGEN COUNTY, NEW JERSEY ENTITLED "ZONING AND SITE PLAN REVIEW REGULATIONS OF THE BOROUGH OF ELMWOOD PARK" CREATING AN AH-3 AFFORDABLE HOUSING – 3 ZONE FOR MIXED USE AND INCLUSIONARY RESIDENTIAL DEVELOPMENT**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to the Municipal Land Use Law, N.J.S.A. 40:55D-32, the Governing Body is empowered to adopt and amend zoning and site plan review regulations; and

**WHEREAS**, the Governing Body has entered into a settlement agreement with River Drive Development, LLC and the Fair Share Housing Center in connection with the Borough of Elmwood Park's affordable housing obligation; and

**WHEREAS**, as part of the settlement the Governing Body has agreed to rezoning Lot 2.01 in Block 1201 with a street address of 778 River Drive to accommodate a mixed-use development with an affordable housing component; and

**WHEREAS**, the Governing Body has determined that amendments herein to the Zoning and Site Plan Review Regulations of the Borough of Elmwood Park are in the best interests of the citizens of the Borough of Elmwood Park;

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED**, by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park, that the Zoning and Site Plan Review Regulations of the Borough of Elmwood Park be amended as follows:

## SECTION 1

Section 34-5 concerning the establishment of districts shall be amended to read as follows:

### 34-5 ESTABLISHMENT OF DISTRICTS.

#### 34-5.1 Division into Districts.

The Borough of Elmwood Park, New Jersey is hereby divided into seventeen (17) zoning districts to be designated as follows:

<i>Designation</i>	<i>Description</i>
AH-1	Affordable Housing-1
AH-2	Affordable Housing-2
AH-3	Affordable Housing-3

## SECTION 2

The official Zoning Map as referenced in Section 34-5.2 shall be amended to show Lot 2.01 in Block 1201 as in a new AH-3 Zone and a new subparagraph 9 shall be added to Section 34-5.2. b. referencing this Zoning Map amended to read as follows:

### 34-5.2 Zoning District Map.

- b. Amendments to zoning district boundaries shall be entered on said map and a record of such amendments noted therein.
9. Pursuant to Ordinance No. 2018-11, the Zoning Map is revised to depict Lot 2.01 in Block 1201 as within the AH-3 Affordable Housing Zone.

## SECTION 3

A new Section 34-13.1 shall be added to read as follows:

### 34-13 AH-3 AFFORDABLE HOUSING DISTRICT

#### 34-13.1 Purpose.

The purpose of this district is to encourage the development of multi-family housing that would include rental units for low and moderate-income households in the amount of fifteen (15%) percent of the total number of dwelling units and to allow in residential buildings certain nonresidential uses.

**34-13.2 Permitted Uses.**

The following uses are permitted in the AH-3 Affordable Housing District:

a. *Principal Permitted Uses.*

Multi-family housing including both age-restricted non-age-restricted units at a maximum density of thirty-five (35) dwelling units per acre, but not to exceed 390 dwelling units in the AH-3 Zone. Age-restricted buildings shall contain dwelling units where the head of household is at least 55 years of age in accordance with federal law.

Commercial uses in residential buildings as permitted in the C-L Local Commerce Zone except that drive-in restaurants shall not be permitted and that gymnasiums, health clubs, swim clubs, tennis clubs and hotels shall be permitted.

Community or assembly rooms for senior citizens in an age-restricted building that shall be available for use by the general public subject to reasonable restrictions established by the property owner.

Hotel uses.

Assisted living facilities.

b. *Accessory Uses.*

Uses and structures customarily incidental to principal permitted uses in the AH-3 Zone including but not limited to driveways, parking areas, signs, community rooms, and active and passive recreational facilities.

**34-13.3 Area and Bulk Tract Regulations.**

The following area and bulk regulations apply to the entire AH-3 Zone as one development entity. Lands in the AH-3 Zone may be subdivided into individual lots encompassing buildings or use areas for the purposes of phasing, ownership, financing or related issues in which case the Tract Regulations shall not apply to individual lots within the AH-3 Zone.

Tract Regulations	AH-3 District
Minimum tract area	10 acres
Minimum tract frontage	100 feet
Minimum front yard	0 feet
Minimum side yard	20 feet
Minimum rear yard	60 feet
Maximum building coverage	40% of tract area
Maximum impervious coverage	70% of tract area
Maximum building height	5 stories
Maximum number of principal buildings	4 principal buildings
Minimum parking setback to principal building	5 feet

#### 34.13.4 Additional Regulations.

The following additional regulations shall apply in the AH-3 Zone:

- a. Fifteen (15%) of the dwelling units in the AH-3 Zone shall be dedicated for rental occupancy by low and moderate-income households. Such units shall be deed-restricted for a period of at least 30 years and shall comply with Uniform Housing Affordability Controls (N.J.A.C. 5:80-26.1 et seq.) or any successor regulation with respect to bedroom distribution, income distribution, pricing requirements, affirmative marketing, candidate qualifications and screening and any other requirement necessary to assure that such affordable units count for the Borough of Elmwood Park's affordable housing obligation, with the exception that in lieu of ten (10%) percent of affordable units in rental projects being required to be at 35% of median income, 13 percent of affordable units shall be at thirty (30%) percent of medium income.
- b. The provisions of Section 34-21 concerning multiple dwellings and townhouses shall not be applicable to the AH-3 Zone.
- c. Required parking for dwelling units shall be 1.75 spaces per unit and required parking for nonresidential uses shall be one (1) space for each three hundred (300) square feet of leasable floor area.
- d. Wall-mounted signs for nonresidential tenants shall be permitted up to a maximum of two (2) square feet for each foot of length of exterior building wall facing a street.
- e. Development in the AH-3 Zone shall adhere to the following limitations and shall be phased in accordance with the following standards:
  - (1) Development in the AH-3 Zone shall consist of a maximum of four principal buildings referenced as Buildings A, B, C and D and a riverfront walkway.
  - (2) Building A shall be a maximum of four (4) stories and consist of a maximum of 128 dwelling units, six (6) units of which shall be affordable units.
  - (3) Building B shall be an age-restricted building with a maximum of four (4) stories, a maximum of 54 dwelling units, 22 units of which shall be age-restricted affordable units, shall contain a community room that is available for use by the general public, and may contain a maximum of 25,000 square feet of leasable area of nonresidential tenant space (A minimum of 10,000 sf is required in either Building C or Building B but not both).



(4) Building C shall be a maximum of five (5) stories and consist of a maximum of 112 dwelling units, 22 of which shall be affordable units and may contain a maximum of 25,000 square feet of leasable area of nonresidential tenant space (A minimum of 10,000 sf is required in either Building C or Building B but not both).

(5) Building D shall be a maximum of four (4) stories and consist of a maximum of 96 dwelling units, nine (9) units of which shall be affordable units.

#### **SECTION 4**

All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent with or in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed as to said inconsistencies and conflicts.

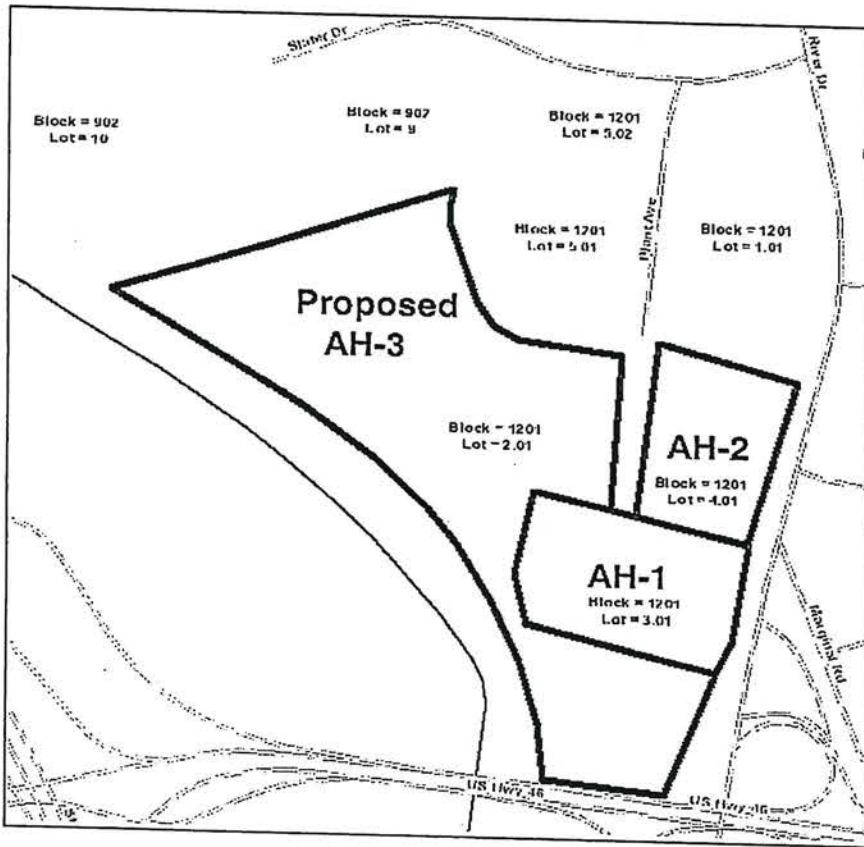
#### **SECTION 5**





**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park, County of Bergen, and State of New Jersey as follows:

**SECTION 1:** Chapter VII of the Code of the Borough of Elmwood Park titled "Traffic" Section 7-21 titled "Multi-Way Stop Intersections," is amended as follows:

**§7-21 MULTI-WAY STOP INTERSECTIONS:**

Pursuant to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 39:4-140, the intersections herein described are designated as Multi-Way Stop(4-Way) Intersections. STOP signs shall be installed as provided herein

**Intersection:**

Speidel Avenue and Lincoln Ave  
Speidel Avenue and Washington Avenue  
Speidel Avenue and Gilbert Avenue  
Speidel Avenue and Falmouth Ave  
16<sup>th</sup> Avenue and East 53<sup>rd</sup> Street



**AN ORDINANCE TO ADDRESS THE ISSUE OF CROWD CONTROL WITHIN THE BOROUGH OF ELMWOOD PARK**

**1. Outdoor Event**

In an effort to maintain crowd control within the Borough, the Borough intends to regulate certain outdoor events. An “outdoor event” under this ordinance shall mean any event that: 1) anticipates attendance of 75 or more persons; and 2) occurs on either private or public property.

**2. Location of Outdoor Event**

An “outdoor event” under this ordinance may only occur in the following zoning districts within the Borough:

R-3	Low/Medium Density Housing
R-5	Low/Medium Density Housing
R-9	Medium Density Housing
R-18	Medium/High Density Housing
R-MF	Multi-Family Housing
C-L	Local Commerce
C-G	General Commerce
C-O	Office
N-C	Neighborhood Commercial (Ord. No. 2015-13)
I-R	Restricted Industrial
I-G	General Industrial
POP	Planned Office Park
ARHO	Age Restricted Housing Overlay
AH-1	Affordable Housing-1
AH-2	Affordable Housing-2
AEO	Adult Entertainment Overlay

**3. Application**

The organizer of any outdoor event under this ordinance is required to obtain an application from the Borough at least 30 days in advance of the event. The application must include the nature of the event, the location, the start and end times of the event, identification and contact information of a responsible party or organizer, and a site diagram which depicts the entire area in which persons will be attending the event.

**4. Proof of Insurance**

An applicant must obtain general liability insurance with a minimum coverage of \$1,000,000.00 before the Borough will approve an application under this ordinance. The policy must name the Borough as an additional insured.



**5. Fees**

An application fee of \$250.00 will be assessed for any applications filed under this ordinance. The application fee will be waived for Borough sponsored events and certified non-profit organizations.

**6. Approving Authority**

All applications under this ordinance shall be filed with the Municipal Clerk and reviewed by the Elmwood Park Police Department, the Fire Department, Code Enforcement officials, and, if necessary, the Board of Health. The Mayor and Borough Council will have final approval on all applications issued under this ordinance, which will be granted by vote via Resolution.

**7. Penalty**

Any person who violates this provision shall be subject to a fine of not more than \$500.00 for each separate offense and/or confinement in the Passaic County Jail for a period of not more than 90 days. In addition, the applicant is responsible for all "emergent costs" incurred as a direct result of the scheduled event.







BE IT ORDAINED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park, in the County of Bergen, New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1. The Borough of Elmwood Park, in the County of Bergen; State of New Jersey (the "Borough") is hereby authorized to undertake various improvements to the intersection of Market Street and Mola Boulevard (work being undertaken by the County of Bergen) in, by and for said Borough. Said improvements shall include all work, materials and appurtenances necessary and suitable therefor.

Section 2. The sum of \$173,400 is hereby appropriated to the payment of the cost of making the improvements described in Section 1 hereof (hereinafter referred to as "purpose"). Said appropriation shall be met from the proceeds of the sale of the bonds authorized and the down payment appropriated by this ordinance. Said improvements shall be made as general improvements and no part of the cost thereof shall be assessed against property specially benefited.

Section 3. It is hereby determined and stated that (1) the making of such improvements is not a current expense of said Borough, and (2) it is necessary to finance said purpose by the issuance of obligations of said Borough pursuant to the Local Bond Law (Chapter 2 of Title 40A of the New Jersey Statutes Annotated, as amended; the "Local Bond Law"), and (3) the estimated cost of said purpose is \$173,400, and (4) \$8,400 of said sum is to be provided by the down payment hereinafter appropriated to finance said purpose, and (5) the estimated maximum amount of bonds or notes necessary to be issued for said purpose is \$165,000, and (6) the cost of such purpose, as hereinbefore stated, includes the aggregate amount of \$15,000 which is estimated to be necessary to finance the cost of such purpose, including architect's fees, accounting, engineering and inspection costs, legal expenses and other expenses, including interest on such obligations to the extent permitted by Section 20 of the Local Bond Law.

Section 4. It is hereby determined and stated that moneys exceeding \$8,400, appropriated for down payments on capital improvements or for the capital improvement fund in budgets heretofore adopted for said Borough, are now available to finance said purpose. The sum of \$8,400 is hereby appropriated from such moneys to the payment of the cost of said purpose.

Section 5. To finance said purpose, bonds of said Borough of an aggregate principal amount not exceeding \$165,000 are hereby authorized to be issued pursuant to the Local Bond Law. Said bonds shall bear interest at a rate per annum as may be hereafter determined within the limitations prescribed by law. All matters with respect to said bonds not determined by this ordinance shall be determined by resolutions to be hereafter adopted.

Section 6. To finance said purpose, bond anticipation notes of said Borough of an aggregate principal amount not exceeding \$165,000 are hereby authorized to be issued pursuant to the Local Bond Law in anticipation of the issuance of said bonds. In the event that bonds are issued pursuant to this ordinance, the aggregate amount of notes hereby authorized to be issued shall be reduced by an amount equal to the principal amount of the bonds so issued. If the aggregate amount of outstanding bonds and notes issued pursuant to this ordinance shall at any time exceed the sum first mentioned in this section, the moneys raised by the issuance of said bonds shall, to not less than the amount of such excess, be applied to the payment of such notes then outstanding.

Section 7. Each bond anticipation note issued pursuant to this ordinance shall be dated on or about the date of its issuance and shall be payable not more than one year from its date, shall bear interest at a rate

per annum as may be hereafter determined within the limitations prescribed by law and may be renewed from time to time pursuant to and within limitations prescribed by the Local Bond Law. Each of said notes shall be signed by the Mayor and by a financial officer and shall be under the seal of said Borough and attested by the Borough Clerk or Deputy Borough Clerk. Said officers are hereby authorized to execute said notes and to issue said notes in such form as they may adopt in conformity with law. The power to determine any matters with respect to said notes not determined by this ordinance and also the power to sell said notes, is hereby delegated to the Chief Financial Officer, who is hereby authorized to sell said notes either at one time or from time to time in the manner provided by law.

Section 8. It is hereby determined and declared that the period of usefulness of said purpose, according to its reasonable life, is a period of ten years computed from the date of said bonds.

Section 9. It is hereby determined and stated that the Supplemental Debt Statement required by the Local Bond Law has been duly made and filed in the office of the Borough Clerk of said Borough, and that such statement so filed shows that the gross debt of said Borough, as defined in Section 43 of the Local Bond Law, is increased by this ordinance by \$165,000 and that the issuance of the bonds and notes authorized by this ordinance will be within all debt limitations prescribed by said Local Bond Law.

Section 10. Any funds received from private parties, the County of Bergen, the State of New Jersey or any of their agencies or any funds received from the United States of America or any of its agencies in aid of such purpose, shall be applied to the payment of the cost of such purpose, or, if bond anticipation notes have been issued, to the payment of the bond anticipation notes, and the amount of bonds authorized for such purpose shall be reduced accordingly.


Section 11. The capital budget is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency therewith and the resolutions promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing full detail of the amended capital budget and capital program as approved by the Director, Division of Local Government Services, is on file with the Borough Clerk and is available for public inspection.

Section 12. The Borough intends to issue the bonds or notes to finance the cost of the improvements described in Section 1 of this bond ordinance. If the Borough incurs such costs prior to the issuance of the bonds or notes, the Borough hereby states its reasonable expectation to reimburse itself for such expenditures with the proceeds of such bonds or notes in the maximum principal amount of bonds or notes authorized by this bond ordinance.

Section 13. The full faith and credit of the Borough are hereby pledged to the punctual payment of the principal of and the interest on the obligations authorized by this ordinance. Said obligations shall be direct, unlimited and general obligations of the Borough, and the Borough shall levy ad valorem taxes upon all the taxable real property within the Borough for the payment of the principal of and interest on such bonds and notes, without limitation as to rate or amount.





**An Ordinance of the Borough of Elmwood Park in Bergen County, State of New Jersey,  
Amending Section 2-27 entitled "Police Department" of the Borough of Elmwood Park  
General Ordinances to add Subsection 27.26 to be entitled  
"Outside Employment of Off-Duty Police Officers"**

WHEREAS, the Borough of Elmwood Park (the "Borough") has permitted private contractors to retain the services of off-duty police officers to provide police officer services; and

WHEREAS, in order to ensure that the Borough is paid for these services, and that assignments to outside contractors do not conflict with the needs of the Borough, it is appropriate to establish hourly rates and procedures to be followed by private contractors and the Borough of Elmwood Park Police Department,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park as follows:

Section 2-27 entitled "Police Department" of Chapter 2 entitled "POLICE DEPARTMENT", of the Borough of Elmwood Park General Ordinances is hereby amended to add Subsection 27.26 entitled "Outside Employment of Off-Duty Police Officers" as follows:

§2-27.26.

**Outside Employment of Off-Duty Police Officers.**

1. Police Officers may work for outside private contractors and entities on their off-duty hours with the approval of and provided the Chief of Police determines, in his discretion, that there are sufficient police personnel available, that the outside employment assignment will not interfere with the needs of the Borough, and that sufficient funds have been deposited in an escrow account with the Borough Chief Financial Officer to cover the anticipated costs of such off-duty assignments. The Borough's Chief Financial Officer shall remit invoices to all outside private contractors and entities upon notification from the Police Chief on all outside employment.
2. The Borough has established an escrow account dedicated to the payment of off-duty police officers for outside employment by private contractors or private entities. Any prospective contractor or private entity must apply to the Chief of Police, requesting off-duty police services. The Chief of Police will then notify the Borough Clerk and Chief Financial Officer of the request and forward to them the completed application, when received. The written application shall include the following information:
3. The dates that off-duty police services and police vehicle(s) will be needed.
4. An estimate of the number of hours the contractor or private entity anticipates using the off-duty police officer(s) and, if appropriate, police vehicles.
5. A check to cover the cost of off-duty police services and use of any Borough vehicles based on the estimated number of hours shall be submitted before the start of off-duty employment in accordance with state and Division of Local Government services regulations. No police officer shall work off-duty for any private contractor or entity prior to clearance of the funds in the escrow account.
  - a. If the contractor's or private entity's needs exceed the estimated sum in the escrow account, the Borough's Chief Financial Officer shall immediately notify the contractor or outside entity that the funds in the escrow account are insufficient to pay for continued off-duty police services. The contractor or private entity shall then either replenish the escrow account with a check sufficient to pay for continued services or the Chief of Police shall immediately terminate provision of the off-duty police services to the contractor or private entity.
  - b. If the contractor's or private entity's estimated costs exceed the actual costs incurred, then the Borough shall, upon proper notice to the Borough Chief Financial Officer, refund the remainder of the escrow account.

6. Rates for off-duty police services are:

- a. The rate of pay for off-duty police work charged to private contractors and entities, for either security or traffic control, is \$75 an hour.
- b. The rate of pay charged to private entity performing work for or pursuant to a contract for services with the Borough of Elmwood Park is \$60 an hour.
- c. The rate of pay charged to Public and Private Schools and not-for-profit organizations or corporations located in Elmwood Park or staging events in Elmwood Park is \$50 an hour.

d. All off-duty work officers will be guaranteed a minimum of 4 hours of work and will be compensated for any fraction of in quarter hour increments, or whole hour, thereafter. The failure of a contractor or private entity to contact the Police Department at least 3 hours in advance of the start of an assignment to cancel the request for off-duty police services will result in the 4 hour minimum charge to the contractor or private entity.

e. An addition to the amounts noted above, a per hour Administrative Fee of \$45 for traffic duty and \$15 per hour Administrative Fee for Security detail will be charged to the contractor or private entity which includes a Borough Police vehicle.

7. Whenever a contractor or outside entity contracts with the Borough Police Department for the services of a police officer during his or her off-duty hours to engage in police-related activities, that outside entity must first:

- a. Indemnify and hold the Borough harmless from and against any and all losses, claims, damages or expenses, including reasonable attorney fees, arising from the performance of police-related duties by such off-duty Borough police officer on behalf of such entity. Such indemnity agreement shall be in a form acceptable to the Borough Attorney.
- b. Provide the Borough, prior to utilization of the Borough police officer, with a certificate of insurance from a company authorized to do business in the State of New Jersey evidencing workers' compensation coverage, personal liability and comprehensive general liability with policy limits of not less than one million (\$1,000,000) dollars and property damage liability coverage of not less than three hundred thousand (\$300,000) dollars. Such policies shall name the Borough as an additional insured and shall remain in effect during the entire period that the officer is employed by the outside entity.

8. In the event a contractor determines not to use off-duty police officers, the contractor must provide for their own traffic control and signage unless the Chief of Police or the Borough determines that the contractor must utilize off-duty police officers for safety purposes. In no event does this provision preclude the Chief of Police from using on-duty police officers, at any time, to perform these functions.

9. All other ordinances in conflict or inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby repealed, to the extent of such conflict or inconsistency. In the event of any inconsistencies between the provisions of this Ordinance and any prior ordinance of the Borough of Elmwood Park, the provisions hereof shall be determined to govern. All other parts, portions and provisions of the Revised General Ordinances of the Borough of Elmwood Park are hereby ratified and confirmed, except where inconsistent with the terms hereof.

10. If any article, section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is, for any reason, held to be unconstitutional or invalid, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this Ordinance and they shall remain in full force and effect, and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are hereby declared severable.

11. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed or amended to the extent of such inconsistency.



**WHEREAS**, AT&T Corp., through its operating subsidiaries, including AT&T Communications of New Jersey, L.P., Teleport Communications America, LLC, and Teleport Communications New York (collectively, "AT&T"), is a communications carrier authorized to provide service by the New Jersey Board of Public Utilities (BPU) and the Federal Communications Commission (FCC); and

**WHEREAS**, AT&T, as a public utility and common carrier, has requested approval to install communications facilities in Elmwood Park public right-of-way; and

**WHEREAS**, AT&T is seeking to lease or obtain conduit space and access to poles with other utilities, particularly Verizon New Jersey Inc., and Verizon has required that AT&T obtain approval of the Elmwood Park Borough Council as a condition of such access;

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ELMWOOD PARK BOROUGH COUNCIL THAT:**

1. Permission and authority are hereby granted to AT&T to install communications facilities, or lease or obtain for such communications facilities space on existing poles or in existing conduits, in the public right-of-way in Elmwood Park in order to provide communications services to the public, and to operate, maintain and repair said facilities, subject to the following:
  - A. The facilities shall be installed in underground conduit and/or on to existing utility poles in the public right-of-way.
  - B. AT&T, its successors and assigns, shall adhere to all applicable Federal, State, and Local laws regarding safety requirements for the use of the public right-of-way.
  - C. AT&T, its successors and assigns, shall comply with all Federal, State, and Local laws requiring permits prior to beginning construction.
  - D. Such permission be and is hereby given upon the condition and provision that AT&T, its successors and assigns, not only indemnify and save harmless the Borough of Elmwood Park, its officers, agents, and servants, from any claims whatsoever arising from or in any way connected to the acts or omissions of AT&T in use of the public right-of-way but shall agree on behalf of the Borough to defend any action at law or equity which may be brought against the Borough upon such claims or from claims arising during the construction period, excluding in all instances claims arising out of gross negligence or willful misconduct on the part of the Borough.
  - E. In addition to the aforesaid indemnity agreement, AT&T, its successors and assigns shall at its own cost and expense procure and keep at all times in full force and effect paid up policies for Comprehensive General Liability Insurance in favor of the Borough, in the amount of at least


\$5,000,000, covering bodily injury and property damage arising out of any one accident. Proof of said coverage, naming the Borough as an insured and including the indemnification clause in Section D shall be filed with the Borough Clerk prior to the installation of any plant. The Borough shall have the right to increase the amount of Comprehensive General Liability Insurance and to alter the terms of insurance called for under this section provided it does so generally for all companies using the public right-of-way within the Borough. Said insurance shall not be subject to cancellation or change until thirty (30) days after the Borough Clerk has received written notice thereof as evidenced by return receipt of certified or registered letter.

- F. Such permission be and is hereby given upon the further condition that in the use of the public right-of-way AT&T, its successors and assigns, shall become subject to any lawful Ordinance or Resolution now or hereafter adopted by the Borough.
- G. Such permission be and is hereby given upon the condition that AT&T shall obtain all applicable permits which may be required by the Borough.
- H. AT&T shall be responsible for the repair of damage to paving, existing utility lines, or any surface or subsurface installations, etc., arising from the construction, installation or maintenance of said plant.
- I. Notwithstanding any provision contained herein, neither the Borough nor AT&T shall be liable to the other for consequential, incidental, exemplary or punitive damages on account of any activity pursuant to this instrument.
- J. This instrument shall be adopted on behalf of the Borough by the Elmwood Park Borough Council and attested to by the Borough Clerk who shall affix the Borough Seal thereto. Said execution, approval, and filing shall constitute the existence of public notification.
- K. The permission and authority hereby granted shall be for a period of five (5) years. Such permission and authority shall be automatically extended for additional periods of five (5) years each; provided, however, that the Borough shall have the right to terminate permission and authority effective at the end of the currently effective term, by Resolution with a minimum one year notice to AT&T to sell or liquidate its facilities in the public right-of-way. Conversely, AT&T shall be allowed to terminate permission and authority effective at the end of the currently effective term, by request of Resolution with a minimum of one year from passage of such Resolution to sell or liquidate its facilities in the public right-of-way.
