BOND ORDINANCE TO APPROPRIATE AN ADDITIONAL SUM OF \$125,000 FOR THE REPLACEMENT OF THE WATER MAIN AT TUELLA AVENUE IN, BY AND FOR THE WATER UTILITY OF THE BOROUGH OF ELMWOOD PARK, IN THE COUNTY OF BERGEN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, TO AUTHORIZE THE ISSUANCE OF BONDS TO FINANCE SUCH ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATION AND TO PROVIDE FOR THE ISSUANCE OF BOND ANTICIPATION NOTES IN ANTICIPATION OF THE ISSUANCE OF SUCH BONDS.

**WHEREAS**, the Borough Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park has heretofore authorized the replacement of the water main at Tuella Avenue in, by and for the Water Utility of said Borough and appropriated \$1,050,000 therefor pursuant to bond ordinance no. 19-24 adopted by the Borough Council of said Borough on September 19, 2019; and

**WHEREAS**, the Borough Council now finds and determines that the additional sum of \$125,000 is required for such purpose, NOW, THEREFORE,

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Borough Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park, in the County of Bergen, New Jersey (the "Borough"), as follows:

Section 1. The additional sum of \$125,000 is hereby appropriated to the payment of the cost of the improvement authorized by bond ordinance no. 19-24 adopted by the Borough Council of the Borough on September 19, 2019 (the "Prior Ordinance"). Said additional appropriation shall be met from the proceeds of the sale of the bonds authorized by this ordinance. No down payment is required for this bond ordinance pursuant to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 40A:2-11(c) and 40A:2-7(h). Said improvement has been and shall be made as a general improvement and no part of the cost thereof has been nor shall be assessed against property specially benefited.

Section 2. It is hereby determined and stated that (1) the making of such improvement (hereinafter referred to as "purpose") is not a current expense of said Borough, and (2) it is necessary to finance the additional cost of said purpose by the issuance of obligations of said Borough pursuant to the Local Bond Law (Chapter 2 of Title 40A of the New Jersey Statutes Annotated, as amended; the "Local Bond Law"), and (3) the estimated cost of said purpose is \$1,175,000, including the sum of \$1,050,000 appropriated by the Prior Ordinance and the \$125,000 appropriated by this ordinance, and (4) the estimated maximum amount of bonds or notes necessary to be issued for such purpose is \$1,175,000, including the \$1,050,000 authorized by the Prior Ordinance and the \$125,000 hereinafter authorized, and (5) the cost of such purpose includes the aggregate amount of \$275,000, including the sum of \$150,000 stated in the Prior Ordinance and the sum of \$125,000 hereby stated, which is estimated to be necessary to finance the cost of such purpose, including architect's fees, accounting, engineering and inspection costs, legal expenses and other expenses, including interest on such obligations to the extent permitted by Section 20 of the Local Bond Law.

Section 3. It is hereby determined and stated that the Water Utility would have been self-liquidating, as defined in Section 47(a) of the Local Bond Law, during the fiscal year beginning January 1, 2018, had there been included in the interest and debt redemption charges for such year an amount equal to interest for one year at the rate of four and one half percentum  $(4\ 1/2\%)$  per annum on said bonds or notes, and the amount of the first installment of serial bonds legally issuable to finance such purpose plus an amount for charges as aforesaid with respect to all bonds and notes authorized but not issued for such Water Utility.

Section 4. To finance said purpose, bonds of said Borough of an aggregate principal amount not exceeding \$125,000 are hereby authorized to be issued pursuant to the Local Bond Law. Said bonds shall bear interest at a rate per annum as may be hereafter determined within the limitations prescribed by law. All matters with respect to said bonds not determined by this ordinance shall be determined by resolutions to be hereafter adopted.

Section 5. To finance said purpose, bond anticipation notes of said Borough of an aggregate principal amount not exceeding \$125,000 are hereby authorized to be issued pursuant to the Local Bond Law in anticipation of the issuance of said bonds. In the event that bonds are issued pursuant to this ordinance, the aggregate amount of notes hereby authorized to be issued shall be reduced by an amount equal to the principal amount of the bonds so issued. If the aggregate amount of outstanding bonds and notes issued pursuant to this ordinance shall at any time exceed the sum first mentioned in this section, the moneys raised by the issuance of said bonds shall, to not less than the amount of such excess, be applied to the payment of such notes then outstanding.

Section 6. Each bond anticipation note issued pursuant to this ordinance shall be dated on or about the date of its issuance and shall be payable not more than one year from its date, shall bear interest at a rate per annum as may be hereafter determined within the limitations prescribed by law and may be renewed from time to time pursuant to and within limitations prescribed by the Local Bond Law. Each of said notes shall be signed by the Mayor and by a financial officer and shall be under the seal of said Borough and attested by the Borough Clerk or Deputy Borough Clerk. Said officers are hereby authorized to execute said notes in such form as they may adopt in conformity with law. The power to determine any matters with respect to said notes not determined by this ordinance and also the power to sell said notes, is hereby delegated to the Chief Financial Officer who is hereby authorized to sell said notes either at one time or from time to time in the manner provided by law.

Section 7. It is hereby determined and declared that the period of usefulness of said purpose, according to its reasonable life, is a period of forty years computed from the date of said bonds.

Section 8. It is hereby determined and stated that the Supplemental Debt Statement required by the Local Bond Law has been duly made and filed in the office of the Borough Clerk of said Borough, and that such statement so filed shows that the gross debt of said Borough, as defined in Section 43 of the Local Bond Law, is increased by this ordinance by \$125,000, but said \$125,000 shall be deducted from gross debt pursuant to Section 44(c) of the Local Bond Law and that the issuance of the bonds and notes authorized by this ordinance is permitted by an exception to the debt limitations prescribed by the Local Bond Law as provided in Sections 47(a) and 7(h) of the Local Bond Law.

Section 9. Any funds received from private parties, the County of Bergen, the State of New Jersey or any of their agencies or any funds received from the United States of America or any of its agencies in aid of such purpose, shall be applied to the payment of the cost of such purpose, or, if bond anticipation notes have been issued, to the payment of the bond anticipation notes, and the amount of bonds authorized for such purpose shall be reduced accordingly.

Section 10. The Borough intends to issue the bonds or notes to finance the cost of the improvement authorized by the Prior Ordinance and described herein. If the Borough incurs such costs prior to the issuance of the bonds or notes, the Borough hereby states its reasonable expectation to reimburse itself for such expenditures with the proceeds of such bonds or notes in the maximum principal amount of bonds or notes authorized by this bond ordinance.

Section 11. The full faith and credit of the Borough are hereby pledged to the punctual payment of the principal of and the interest on the obligations authorized by this ordinance. Said obligations shall be direct, unlimited and general obligations of the Borough, and the Borough shall levy ad valorem taxes upon all the taxable real property within the Borough for the payment of the principal of and interest on such bonds and notes, without limitation as to rate or amount.

Section 12. The capital budget is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency therewith and the resolutions promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing full detail of the amended capital budget and capital program as approved by the Director, Division of Local Government Services, is on file with the Borough Clerk and is available for public inspection.

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A "4-WAY STOP" AT THE INTERSECTIONS OF SPEIDEL AVENUE AND MILLER AVENUE AND TO AMEND CHAPTER VII OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF ELMWOOD PARK TITLED "TRAFFIC" MORE SPECIFICALLY SECTION 7-21 TITLED "MULTI-WAY STOP INTERSECTIONS"

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council have become aware of the necessity to regulate the particular four-way intersection of Speidel Avenue and Miller Avenue for safety concerns of traffic and pedestrian crossing, in order to protect the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Borough of Elmwood Park.

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park, County of Bergen, and State of New Jersey and pursuant to N.J.S.A. 39:4-140 of the laws of the state of New Jersey the Mayor and Council ordains as follows:

**SECTION 1:** That by way of this Ordinance the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park do hereby designate and establish a "4-Way Stop" at the intersections of Speidel Avenue and Miller Avenue in the Borough of Elmwood Park.

**SECTION 2:** The designated "4-Way Stop" is in the interest of the public and its health, safety and welfare and the inhabitants in and near said intersection.

**SECTION 3:** The responsible department of the Borough of Elmwood Park shall be responsible and directed through the Borough Administrator to install the necessary "4-Way Stop" signs at the abovementioned intersection.

**SECTION 4:** Be it further Ordained by the Mayor and Council that Chapter VII of the Code of the Borough of Elmwood Park titled "Traffic" more specifically section 7-21 titled "Multi-Way Stop Intersections is hereby amended so as to include thereto the "4-Way Stop" intersection of Speidel Avenue and Miller Avenue as follows:

### 7-21 Multi-way stop intersections.

Is hereby amended to include the "4-Way Stop" intersection of Speidel Avenue and Miller Avenue. That traffic will stop in all direction.

**SECTION 5: Penalties for violation.** Any person who violates the provision of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be fined in accordance to the respective and appropriate fine sections of the Borough of Elmwood Park and or as set forth in the Laws of the State of New Jersey.

**SECTION 6:** The Police Chief and the Police Department of the Borough of Elmwood Park, shall assist and enforce the provisions of this Ordinance.

**SECTION 7: Repealer.** All Ordinances of the Borough of Elmwood Park to the extent that same are not inconsistent with this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect until modified or repealed pursuant to law. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed as to such inconsistencies.

**SECTION 3: Invalid Provisions.:** If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

**SECTION 4: Effective Date.:** This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage and publication thereof as provide by law.

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and Council have become aware of the necessity to regulate the particular four-way intersection of Speidel Avenue and Philip Avenue for safety concerns of traffic and pedestrian crossing, in order to protect the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Borough of Elmwood Park.

**SECTION 4**: Be it further Ordained by the Mayor and Council that Chapter VII of the Code of the Borough of Elmwood Park titled "Traffic" more specifically section 7-21 titled "Multi-Way Stop Intersections is hereby amended so as to include thereto the "4-Way Stop" intersection of Speidel Avenue and Philip Avenue as follows:

### 7-21 MULTI-WAY STOP INTERSECTIONS.

Is hereby amended to include the "4-Way Stop" intersection of Speidel Avenue and Philip Avenue. That traffic will stop in all direction.

**SECTION 5**: Penalties for violation. Any person who violates the provision of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be fined in accordance to the respective and appropriate fine sections of the Borough of Elmwood Park and or as set forth in the Laws of the State of New Jersey.

**SECTION 6**: The Police Chief and the Police Department of the Borough of Elmwood Park, shall assist and enforce the provisions of this Ordinance.

**SECTION 7**: Repealer. 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#### **COMMITTEE REPORTS**

Councilman Fasolo made two announcements in regards to an upcoming Trunk-or-Treat and Class of 2020 Fundraiser. He thanked those that participated in the town wide clean-up and dress down day to raise money for the Stigma Free committee. Councilman Fasolo then congratulated the two new businesses who recently held grand openings. At the end of his report, he took the time to acknowledge a recent loss of a staff member in the School District.

Councilwoman Wechtler, on behalf of the Homeowner's Association, announced that there will not be a meeting held in November and December. However, bus trip fundraisers will continue.

Councilwoman Balistrieri conveyed the following for her Recreation report: soccer training is currently available, the Halloween party will take place on October 30<sup>th</sup>, installation of the new equipment at Cherry Hill Park is set to begin, and a sign/ribbon cutting for the Dog Park will be implemented in the very near future. Moving on to the DPW report, she shared that branch and leaf pick-up will continue with a requirement of separating and tying up branches, the Army Tank and Veterans Monument have been decorated for the season, and it is currently the last week for yard waste pick-up. Councilwoman Balistrieri discussed the dress down day which benefitted the Stigma Free committee and expressed her gratitude. Lastly, she voiced her sentiments in regards to the loss of a staff member in the School District.

Councilwoman Fava stated that she has yet to be assigned to a committee, therefore she has no committee report. However, she took the time to thank the DPW for the recent décor and shared her condolences for the loss of the staff member and his family.

Councilwoman Ingui provided her current Ambulance Corps. report. She informed those in attendance of the success of the Crusader Clean-up and requested that the Mayor and Council consider recognizing the coaches that voluntarily participated at the November Regular Meeting. Councilwoman Ingui provided the Governing Body and Administration with Breast Cancer Awareness pins prior to the meeting and discussed the importance of Breast Cancer Awareness Month. The last comment of her committee report was dedicated to the passing of the School District staff member where she stated they are in her prayers.

Council President Pellegrine informed the public of her Board of Health update which included the announcement of a Health Fair scheduled for October 27<sup>th</sup> and Rabies Clinic for November. The Chamber of Commerce will be sponsoring a fundraiser where all funds raised will be donated to Rare is Beautiful and the Residents Assistance Program in addition to a Career Night in November at the High School. She went on to congratulate the Police Department for completing their re-accreditation.

Mayor Golabek updated the public on the Tuella Avenue Improvements project and the FY2019-2020 CDBG & 2019 Road Program paving projects as they have recently been awarded and are expected to begin shortly. Additionally, Mayor Golabek shared that the Borough Hall parking lot is going to be resurfaced and reconfigured so that the rear portion will be dedicated to employees and the front lot will be available strictly for the convenience of visitors. He noted that in order to complete this task, foliage had to be removed from Borough property. Upon its completion, 4 trees will be planted to kick start the 222 New Trees by 2022 campaign of which approximately 20 residents have currently signed up for. The Mayor finished off by wishing all candidate on the November General Election ballot good luck.

#### PUBLIC COMMENT

Richard Trawinski, Walnut Street, inquired about the new appointment within the Building Department. He questioned how an individual will be able to dedicate 20 hours per week to the Borough when they are currently full-time in another municipality and whether or not this is a temporary solution. Mr. Trawinski then stated that the appointment should be provisional as it is a civil service position that would trigger a test.

Joseph Dombrowski, Lincoln Avenue, addressed the Governing Body and audience by asking where the GOP is. He commended the job done at Mola Boulevard in regards to the recent décor. He concluded his comments by asking for clarification on the cost savings and timeframe of the new appointment within the Building Department

Jeffrey Freitag, Hillman Drive, informed the Mayor that he is aware of a resident that signed up for the 222 New Trees by 2022 campaign but did not receive follow-up from Borough Hall.

Laurie Lavorgna, Martha Avenue, stated that the parking in her neighborhood is horrendous as people with driveways do not utilize them. She asked that they address this as soon as possible.

A motion was made by Councilwoman Wechtler and seconded by Councilwoman Ingui to adjourn. Motion carried unanimously.
