The presentation consisted of an overview of renovations to the three public schools that need additional space for students.

Gantner Avenue Elementary School, proposed is a 8,102 foot addition south of the existing structure plan, removal of islands in the parking lot which will add additional parking spaces on-site. Existing 40 spaces, when completed 65 parking spaces. The addition will have its own entrance adjacent to the circular drive. Four proposed pre-k classrooms and an electrical storage room, two bathrooms, and a small group instruction space will be constructed with a connection at the end of the corridor and can be constructed without school interruption. Two-hour rated fire walls/fire doors will be installed in accordance with fire safety.

Gantner Avenue Elementary addition will be built structurally to hold a potential second floor in the future.

Gilbert Avenue Elementary School is proposing a 6,744 square foot addition being constructed in the front of the building on Gilbert Avenue, with the connection back to the building. There is a stage in the multi-purpose room, the renovations will drop the stage down to the main level and create an instruction classroom and corridor with two-hour rated fire walls/doors as per fire codes. There is water retention under the proposed addition, and the proposal is to install storm water detention as part of the project which will pick up what is existing and the new impervious coverage from the buildings. building will not have the potential for a second floor. The renovation will not change the main entrance to the school. They will remain the same.

16th Avenue Elementary School is proposing an 8,100 square foot addition, two feet lower than the finished floor of the existing building. Applicant wanted to minimize the steps. This addition is located off to the plan west of the existing building. This addition will be separated from the existing school building, due to an electrical transformer location, needing certain distance requirements. There will be a ramping down the corridor staying close to the elevation of the existing building.

1	A total of three pre-kindergarten
2	classrooms, and a small instruction room.  Breaking ground is anticipated for
3	March, 2024 completing the connections by August 25, 2024 and completed for the start of the new
4	school year. All three schools will begin construction at the same time.

7	board recommends consideration of more parking and relocation of the main office for emergency medical
8	reasons.  There were no comments or
