1. CALL TO ORDER:

The Re-Organization Meeting of the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park was called to order on Thursday, January 2nd, 2020 at 8:07P.M. in the Council Chambers of the Municipal Building, 182 Market Street, Elmwood Park, New Jersey.

Mayor Colletti entered into the Council Chambers following the Elmwood Park Volunteer Honor Guard. Ms. Delaney invited the remainder of the Colletti family to the dais. Mayor Colletti was sworn into office by his brother and Former Mayor of Woodland Park Gary Colletti.

Councilman Golabek entered into the Council Chambers following the Elmwood Park Volunteer Honor Guard. Ms. Delaney invited the remainder of the Golabek family to the dais. Councilman Golabek was sworn into office by Congressman Bill Pascrell.

Councilmember Francesco Fasolo Installing Officer: Congressman Bill Pascrell

Councilman Fasolo entered into the Council Chambers following the Elmwood Park Volunteer Honor Guard. Ms. Delaney invited the remainder of the Fasolo family to the dais. Councilman Fasolo was sworn into office by Congressman Bill Pascrell.

Mayor Colletti then began his welcoming address in which he thanked the Borough of Elmwood Park for having faith in him to lead the Borough for the next 4 years and his family for his love and support. Mayor Colletti took the time to congratulate both incoming Councilmen Golabek and Fasolo, state Councilwoman Pellegrine led a well-fought race, and advised his two running mates to stay the course while commending their efforts. Continuing on with his remarks, he informed the audience that he would like to find common ground with the current council in order to advance initiatives while also ensuring accountability. Lastly, Mayor Colletti ended his speech by sharing specific goals including, but not limited to: fiscal responsibility, more businesses, revitalization of Market Street and Route 4 corridors, alleviate parking issues and over crowdedness, address illegal dwellings, and improving the education system while working hand in hand with the Board of Education.

Councilman Golabek started his opening remarks by thanking his family for their support and the dignitaries in the audience for attending the reorganization meeting and for representing Elmwood Park as well as they do in Congress and in the Legislature. He congratulated his running mate, Councilman Fasolo, on his victory, acknowledged the uniqueness of Elmwood Park having a female-majority Council along with two millennial Councilpersons, and congratulated Mayor Colletti for his election as Mayor. Councilman Golabek noted that he and Mayor Colletti met up numerous occasions prior to the reorganization meeting to ensure a smooth transition. In conclusion, Councilman Golabek highlighted accomplishments that took place during his 3-year term on the Council and recognized that more work needs to get done. He then took the time to share his plans moving forward and ended by thanking the voters for electing him for another term.

Councilman Fasolo first thanked Elmwood Park's "Fighter in Washington", Congressman Bill Pascrell, for performing his swearing in ceremony. Secondly, he thanked the residents for entrusting him to serve on the council, thanked his family for their endless love and support, and congratulated his running mate Councilman Golabek for being re-elected. Councilman Fasolo shared, through a famous quote, what an honor it is to be of public service and stated that he sits alongside a Governing Body, of which he looks forward to working with, that has love and passion for their community.

Councilwoman Balistrieri congratulated Mayor Colletti, Councilman Golabek, and Councilman Fasolo. She advised the candidates that ran but were not successful to never give up if they have a passion for serving their community. Councilwoman Balistrieri then pointed our that Councilwoman Pellegrine worked hard, ran a positive campaign, and would have done a fine job at being Mayor.

Councilwoman Wechtler shared congratulatory remarks to Mayor Colletti, Councilman Golabek, and Councilman Fasolo. She thanked Councilman Golabek for what he has done on the council thus far and officially welcome Councilman Fasolo to their team.

Councilwoman Pellegrine congratulated Mayor Golabek, Councilman Golabek, and Councilman Fasolo while also stating that she looks forward to working with them. Councilwoman Pellegrine then wished everyone a Happy and Healthy New Year.

Councilwoman Ingui congratulated Mayor Colletti and his wife on his successful Mayoral race. She stated to Councilman Fasolo that she is very proud of him and

congratulated Councilman Golabek. Councilwoman Ingui noted that she looks forward to working with everyone.

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED, "AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH THE WATER DEPARTMENT OF THE BOROUGH OF ELMWOOD PARK, BERGEN COUNTY, NEW JERSEY, TO FIX THE RATES AND PRICES TO BE CHARGED FOR THE USE OF WATER AND ESTABLISH RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE DISTRIBUTION, SUPPLY, USE AND PROTECTION OF SAID WATER AND PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION OF CERTAIN SAID RULES AND REGULATIONS.

WHEREAS, due to an aggregate 3.5% increase in water consumption from bulk water supplier, Passaic Valley Water Commission, the following is necessary;

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Council, of the Borough of Elmwood Park as follows:

Section 1: A fixed charge known as "the service charge," will be made to each Consumer for each meter based on the size of the meter or connection regardless of the amount of water consumed as follows:

5/8 in. Meter (average 1 and 2 family homes)	\$50.82
¾ in. Meter	\$57.19
1 in. Meter	\$60.97
1 ½ in. Meter	\$66.03
2 in. Meter	\$67.31
3 in. Meter	\$96.44
4 in. Meter	\$114.21

Section 2: The following water rates and changes are hereby established for water supplied by the Department.

The minimum quarterly bill for metered service shall be "the service charge" entitling the consumer to 5,000 gallons of water per quarter. All water supplied through meters in excess of the minimum quarterly bill, shall be charged to each consumer at the rate of:

\$5.61 per 1,000 gallons over 5,000 gallons

\$6.09 per 1,000 gallons over 70,000 gallons

\$6.89 per 1,000 gallons over 150,000 gallons

\$7.40 per 1,000 gallons over 300,000 gallons

3 in. Service	\$203.20
4 in. Service	\$317.02
6 in. Service	\$581.20
8 in. Service	\$912.79
10 in. Service	\$1,137.99
12 in. Service	\$1,524.11

The above schedule for stand by fire line and/or sprinkler connections shall be quarterly charges upon presentation of proper bills from the Water Department of the Borough of Elmwood Park.

Section 3:

The following are hereby established as charges for the installation, repair, replacement and other charges in connection with the operation of the Water Department of the Borough of Elmwood Park:

Installation, replacement, and repair of existing meters shall be charged at actual current cost for labor and material incurred by the Water Department of the Borough of Elmwood Park and/or Passaic Valley Water Commission.

F. All commercial users having meters in excess of ¾" must have them in working order at all times. In the event said meter is inoperative, and no attempt is made for repair/replacement of same, the existing estimated bill shall be tripled the existing estimated rate, upon the effective date of this ordinance. In the event no meter in excess of ¾" exist, in addition to the tripled estimated bill, the landlord shall be required to purchase and install same upon written order of the Superintendent of Public Works.

Section 4: "In the event that payment for water charges is in arrears for 30 days from date of billing, the Borough shall send a delinquent notice regular mail, to the owner, occupier, user or responsible party being billed. After 60 days, a door tag shall be hand delivered to terminate water service. On the 67th day of non-payment from date of billing, water service will be terminated and not reinstated until all fees, penalties, are paid in full in cash.

\$149.11 turn on fee is made to the Borough of Elmwood Park.

Section 4b: "In the event that water charges are in the arrears, after 60 days, a door tag will be hand delivered to terminate water service and a fee of \$40.00 will be assessed on to the delinquent water bill.

Section 5: All unpaid water charges as of 12/31 of the present year shall become a Tax Lien on said premises

Section 6: All ordinance or parts of ordinances inconsistent with or in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict or inconsistency. This shall take effect after final passage and publication as required by law.

Section 7: All billings as of January 1, 2020 and thereafter will be subject to said rate.

BOROUGH OF ELMWOOD PARK BERGEN COUNTY, NEW JERSEY ORDINANCE NO.: 20-02

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF ELMWOOD PARK COUNTY OF BERGEN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH CHAPTER XXIV, ENTITLED "WATER," MORE SPECIFICALLY THE RESERVED SECTION 24-4 SO AS TO READ "RESRICTIONS ON DISCHARGE OF SUMP PUMPS AND GROUNDWATER"

INTENT OF THIS ORDINANCE

The intent of this Ordinance is to establish rules and regulations governing the installation, use and discharge of sump pumps or other ground water conveyance systems and to establish the structure and penalties required to enforce said rules and regulations.

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council have become aware of health and safety concerns that exist with the discharge of sump pump and or other ground water and in order to protect the health and safety of the residents of the Borough of Elmwood Park.

WHEREAS, the Borough of Elmwood Park finds that the discharge of any clean surface water including water from roof or cellar drains, springs, basement sump pumps and French drains contributes to the flooding and overloading of the Borough's Wastewater Collection System.

Such overloading may result in sewage flowing into basements and/or residences, businesses and over land creating hazardous public health conditions and significant damage to properties.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park, County of Bergen, and State of New Jersey as follows:

SECTION 1: Chapter XXIV of the Code of the Borough of Elmwood Park titled "Water" more specifically the reserved section 24-4 is hereby amended to contain the following:

24-4 Sump Pump and Groundwater Standard, Rule and Regulation.

24-4.1 Intent

The intent of this chapter is to establish rules and regulations governing the installation, use and discharge of sump pumps or other ground water conveyance systems and to establish the structure and penalties required to enforce said rules and regulations.

24-4.2 Definitions

- a. Nuisance: any act or physical condition in or on the exterior of any premises which is potentially dangerous, detrimental or hazardous to the life, health or safety of persons on, near or passing within the proximity of the premises where said conditions are created or exist.
- b. Premises: a lot, plot of land, right of way or multiple thereof including the building or structures thereon

24-4.3 Prohibited Water

- a. It shall be unlawful for any owner or occupant of any premises to direct or allow any storm water, surface water, or ground water to drain into the street, right of way, or onto neighboring properties.
- b. It shall be unlawful for any owner or occupant of any premises to direct into or allow any storm water, surface water, or ground water to drain into the sanitary sewer system of the Borough of Elmwood Park.

24-4.4 Exceptions

Any sump pump that is discharged to the street, right of way, or premises that is not creating a nuisance prior to the passage of this ordinance will be exempt; however, if at any time after the passage of this ordinance the conditions change and the discharge creates said

nuisance, it will be considered non-compliant, and must be rectified in accordance with this ordinance.

24-4.5 Method of Installation

- a. Discharge of sump pumps, ground water and/or roof runoff shall be directed onto a green area or into a seepage pit within the boundaries of the premises from which the discharge is generated.
- b. Discharge shall not be directed any closer than ten feet from a property line so as not to impact neighboring properties.
- c. A plumbing permit shall be required for the installation or alteration of sump pump piping.

24-4.6 Enforcement

This chapter shall be enforced by the Building Department, and such building department officials shall, in pursuance of his or her duties herein, be deemed, for the purposes of this chapter, the enforcement agency.

24-4.7 Enforcement Procedure

- a. Whenever the enforcement agency determines that there is or has been a violation of any provision of this chapter, he or she shall give notice of such violation to the person, persons or entities responsible therefor under this chapter. The notice shall state that unless the violation is abated, removed, cured, prevented or desisted from within 10 days of the date of service of such notice, a summons shall be issued for such violation. The enforcement officer may, at the time he or she issues the notice, extend the period for correction of the violation stated in the notice for a period in excess of the aforesaid 10 days, if, in his or her judgment, abatement, removal, prevention, cessation of or cure of the condition violated cannot reasonably be effected within the ten-day period; and in such cases the enforcement officer shall state such reasonably required extended period in the notice, not to exceed 30 days, which shall then be applicable instead of the aforesaid 10 days. In the event the violation is not abated, removed, cured, prevented or desisted from or otherwise fully remedied within said ten-day period or within such extended period as set forth in the notice, pursuant to the foregoing, a summons shall then be issued against the person, persons, entity or entities so notified.
- b. If the person responsible for the abatement, removal, prevention, cessation or cure of the condition referred to in the notice sent by the Building Department Officer has not been corrected within 10 days after receipt of the same, then the Building Department Officer shall be and is hereby authorized and directed to correct or cause to be corrected the condition cited in the notice. In such case the Building Department Officer shall certify the costs of such correction to the Borough Council, who shall examine such certificate and, if it finds the same correct, shall cause the cost as shown thereon to be charged against said land. The amount so charged shall forthwith become a lien upon said land and premises and shall be added to, form and become part of the taxes next to be assessed and levied upon said land and shall bear interest at the same rate as taxes and shall be collected and enforced in the same manner as taxes.

24-4.8 Service of Notice

- a. The notice shall be served by the Elmwood Park Building Department upon the property owner in person, by registered or certified mail, or by leaving it at the owner's usual place of residence. If the property owner shall not reside in the municipality, notice may be served upon the occupant of the property or upon the agent of the owner in charge thereof. Where lands are held in trust, service shall be made upon the trustee. Where lands are held by joint tenants, tenants in common or tenants by the entirety, service upon one (1) of the owners shall be sufficient and deemed and taken as notice to all.
- b. In addition to the foregoing method of service of the notice, the posting of a notice or sticker on the front access door of the premises shall be deemed sufficient notice of such violation.

24-4.9 Emergency conditions

Whenever the enforcement officer finds that an emergency condition in violation of this chapter exists, which condition requires immediate attention in order to protect the public health or safety, he may issue an order by service of notice as set forth in this ordinance reciting the existence of such an emergency condition and requiring that such action be taken by the violator as soon as is reasonably necessary to meet the emergency. Notwithstanding any other provision of this chapter, such order shall be effective immediately.

24-4.10 Violations and penalties

- a. Any person or entity who shall violate any of the provisions of this chapter or any order promulgated hereunder, shall be issued a summons under the terms hereof, and upon conviction, be punished as follows:
- b. Fine not less than \$100; however, not to exceed \$500
- c. Each violation of any of the provisions of this chapter, and each day that each such violation shall continue shall be deemed to be a separate and distinct offense.

SECTION 2. In the event any section, part or provision of this Ordinance shall be held unconstitutional or invalid by any Court, such holding shall not affect the validity of this Ordinance or any remaining part of this Ordinance other than the part held unconstitutional or invalid.

SECTION 3. All ordinances or parts thereof, which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance, are hereby repealed to the extent of their inconsistencies.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its final passage and publication as required by law.

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A "4-WAY STOP" AT THE INTERSECTIONS OF IOZIA TERRACE AND 16TH AVENUE AND TO AMEND CHAPTER VII OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF ELMWOOD PARK TITLED "TRAFFIC" MORE SPECIFICALLY SECTION 7-21 TITLED "MULTI-WAY STOP INTERSECTIONS"

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council have become aware of the necessity to regulate the particular four-way intersection of Iozia Terrace and 16th Avenue for safety concerns of traffic and pedestrian crossing, in order to protect the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Borough of Elmwood Park.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park, County of Bergen, and State of New Jersey and pursuant to N.J.S.A. 39:4-140 of the laws of the state of New Jersey the Mayor and Council ordains as follows:

SECTION 1: That by way of this Ordinance the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park do hereby designate and establish a "4-Way Stop" at the intersections of Iozia Terrace and 16th Avenue in the Borough of Elmwood Park.

SECTION 2: The designated "4-Way Stop" is in the interest of the public and its health, safety and welfare and the inhabitants in and near said intersection.

SECTION 3: The responsible department of the Borough of Elmwood Park shall be responsible and directed through the Borough Administrator to install the necessary "4-Way Stop" signs at the above-mentioned intersection.

SECTION 4: Be it further Ordained by the Mayor and Council that Chapter VII of the Code of the Borough of Elmwood Park titled "Traffic" more specifically section 7-21 titled "Multi-Way Stop Intersections is hereby amended so as to include thereto the "4-Way Stop" intersection of Iozia Terrace and 16th Avenue as follows:

7-21 Multi-way stop intersections.

Is hereby amended to include the "4-Way Stop" intersection of Iozia Terrace and 16th Avenue. That traffic will stop in all direction.

SECTION 5: Penalties for violation. Any person who violates the provision of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be fined in accordance to the respective and appropriate fine sections of the Borough of Elmwood Park and or as set forth in the Laws of the State of New Jersey.

SECTION 6: The Police Chief and the Police Department of the Borough of Elmwood Park, shall assist and enforce the provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 7: Repealer. All Ordinances of the Borough of Elmwood Park to the extent that same are not inconsistent with this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect until modified or repealed pursuant to law. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed as to such inconsistencies.

SECTION 3: Invalid Provisions.: If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4: Effective Date.: This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage and publication thereof as provide by law.

WHEREAS, Chapter 231 of the Public Laws of 1975, known as the Open Public Meetings Act, was approved on October 21, 1975 to become effective on January 19, 1976; and

WHEREAS, said law requires the fixing of regular meetings of the Governing Body of the Borough of Elmwood Park for the calendar year 2020 and the giving of adequate notice thereof to the public and to the press, and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Governing Body of the Borough of Elmwood Park, County of Bergen, State of New Jersey, as follows:

- 1. The regular public meetings of the Governing Body of the Borough of Elmwood Park for the calendar year 2020 shall be held generally on the third Thursday of each month, with the exception of legal holidays and during the summer schedule. Formal action will be taken.
- 2. The regular scheduled work sessions and or executive meeting of the Governing Body for the calendar year 2020 shall be held generally on the first and second Thursdays of each month with the exception of legal holidays and during the summer schedule. Formal action may be taken.
- **3.** All the meetings regularly scheduled, as set forth in paragraphs 1 and 2 above, shall be held in the Municipal Building of the Borough of Elmwood Park, New Jersey.
- **4.** All persons who request that the Governing Body mail copies of this meeting schedule, and any revisions thereto, and any written forty-eight (48) hour advance notice of the agenda to the extent known, and the time, date and location of any regular, special or rescheduled meeting, shall be mailed such notices upon prepayment by such persons of the sum of \$15.00 to the Borough Clerk. The Borough Clerk shall further prepare a list of such persons and shall mail the requested notices in accordance with the provisions of the Open Public Meetings Act.
- **5.** All persons who request copies of minutes of any of said meeting shall receive such copies upon payment to the Borough Clerk in the amount of .05 cents for letter sized paper and .07 cents for legal sized paper.
- **6.** The Record and Herald News of Woodland Park, NJ are hereby designated as the newspapers which shall receive all notices required to be sent pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 231 of the Public Laws of 1975.
- **7.** The Schedule of Business for meetings and actions shall be as follows:
 - A. Roll Call
 - B. Invocation and Flag Salute
 - C. Approval of minutes
 - D. Introduction and passage of ordinances
 - E. Presentation of bills
 - F. Resolutions

- G. Reading of reports, raffle licenses, communications, petitions, etc.
- H. Report of standing committees
- I. Report of special committees to be called in order of appointment
- J. Report of presiding officer and or report of Auditor, Attorney, Clerk and Engineer
- K. Public Hearing (Open to the public allowing a 10-minute time frame with the opportunity for a 3-minute rebuttal)

CASH MANAGEMENT PLAN

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park that the following Cash Management Plan as submitted by the Chief Financial Officer, be and the same is hereby approved.

Objective

The purpose of the Cash Management Plan ("the Plan") is to provide the Borough of Elmwood Park ("the Borough") with maximized current interest income earning that are consistent with providing liquidity and the preservation of principal. This plan is in compliance with the requirements of N.J.S.A. 40A:5-14, which regulates investments by county and local government units and is administered by the NJ Division of Local Government services.

The plan establishes the policies and administrative framework regarding cash flow budgeting, investments and financial institutions including banks and joint government investment programs as permitted by N.J.S.A. 60a:5-15.a and P.L. 1997, Chapter 148 enacted June 30, 1997.

Cash Flow Budgeting

The Plan acknowledges that an accurate cash flow budget is prerequisite to the effective management and utilization of the Borough's cash balances.

Prior to the beginning of each budget year the Borough Treasurer/CFO shall cause to be prepared a monthly projection of all anticipated receipts and disbursements for the major operating accounts of the Borough of Elmwood Park for the coming year.

The information derived from the cash flow projections will be utilized by the Treasurer/CFO in designating an investment strategy that is consistent with the projections.

The anticipated cash requirements as evidenced by the projections when considered in conjunction with current and projected market trends for interest rates shall be used to construct an appropriate investment portfolio matrix. The portfolio shall be at all times cognizant of cash needs and market conditions as evidenced by the yield curve of eligible investment instruments.

In all cases of relationship with financial institutions, the Treasurer/CFO shall be aware, through the utilization of an external rating source, that the total amount of funds on deposit or invested with any single institution will be in accordance with parameters adopted annually to establish limits for deposit concentration among designated depositories.

The Borough reserves the right to reject quotations and withhold deposits from any institutions deemed by the Treasurer/CFO, based on data from the rating service, to be a financial risk.

Banking Relationships

The Borough acknowledges that banking relationships help the foundations upon which an effective and efficient cash management program is constructed.

Relationships that involve the provision of specialized or customized services that the Borough deems essential should be evidences in writing and should include information regarding fees and charges as well as methodology used to compensate the bank providing these services.

As required to implement the Plan, the Borough Treasurer/CFO is authorized to establish account relationships with designated depositories on the Treasurers/CFO's signature in accordance with the Borough's Administrative code to securely, efficiently, and expeditiously move fund amounts to the depositories accordingly, of certain employees that should be authorized to affect transfers between accounts and to affect investment on behalf of the Borough. Any Bank providing documentation of qualification under the Government Unit Deposit Protection Act and having an office in the Borough of Elmwood Park shall be designated depository for the Borough Funds. However, the decision as to which bank shall receive those funds and in what concentration shall be made in accordance with guidelines adopted by the Borough based on information supplied by the external rating agency service utilized by the Borough to insure maximum safety of those funds.

To assure that the Borough is receiving fair and competitive value from its relationships, the Borough Treasurer/CFO will undertake, at least annually, a review and analysis of relationships. The review shall include, but not be limited to, an analysis of balances, fees, and charges, services provided, earnings credited and interest rates paid or allowed on accounts maintained by the Borough. Further, the Borough Treasurer/CFO shall examine at least twice a year the services offered and the charges and rates available for the provision thereof in the banking community to insure a competitive atmosphere for the acquisition of the state-of-the-art services for the Borough.

Reports

Annually, or at the discretion of the council, with concurrence with the Treasurer/CFO, shall prepare a report for the Governing Body which shall include a summary of all investment activity as well as a compilation of deposits by depository and account number. The report shall include all new accounts established, if any.

A RESOLUTION TO AFFIRM THE BOROUGH OF ELMWOOD PARK'S CIVIL RIGHTS POLICY WITH RESPECT TO ALL OFFICIALS, APPOINTEES, EMPLOYEES, PROSPECTIVE EMPLOYEES, VOLUNTEERS, INDEPENDENT CONTRACTORS, AND MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC THAT COME INTO CONTACT WITH MUNICIPAL EMPLOYEES, OFFICIALS AND VOLUNTEERS

WHEREAS, it is the policy of the Borough of Elmwood Park to treat the public, employees, prospective employees, volunteers and contractors in a manner consistent with all applicable civil rights laws and regulations including, but not limited to, the Federal Civil Rights Act of 1964 as subsequently amended, the New Jersey law against Discrimination, the Americans with Disabilities Act and the Conscientious Employee Protection Act; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park has determined that certain procedures need to be established in order to accomplish this policy.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ADOPTED, by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park as follows:

Section 1. No official, employee, appointee or volunteer of the Borough of Elmwood Park by whatever title known, or any entity that is in any way a part of the Borough of Elmwood Park shall engage, either directly or indirectly, in any act, including the failure to act, that constitutes discrimination, harassment or a violation of any person's constitutional rights while such official, employee, appointee, volunteer or entity is engaged in or acting on behalf of the Borough's business or using the facilities or property of the Borough.

Section 2. The prohibitions and requirements of this resolution shall extend to any person or entity, including but not limited to, any volunteer organization or inter-local organization, whether structured as a governmental entity or private entity, that receives authorization or support in any way from the Borough to provide services that otherwise could be performed by the Borough.

<u>Section 3.</u> Discrimination, harassment and civil rights shall be defined for purposes of this resolution using the latest definitions contained in the applicable Federal and State laws concerning discrimination, harassment and civil rights.

Section 4. The Borough Administrator shall establish written procedures for any person to report alleged discrimination, harassment and violations of civil rights prohibited by this resolution. Such procedures shall include alternate ways to report a complaint so that the person making the complaint need not communicate with the alleged violator in the event the alleged violator would be the normal contact for such complaints.

<u>Section 5.</u> No person shall retaliate against any person who reports any alleged discrimination, harassment or violation of civil rights, provided however, that any person who reports alleged violations in bad faith shall be subject to appropriate discipline.

<u>Section 6.</u> The Borough Administrator shall establish written procedures that require all officials, employees, appointees and volunteers of the Borough as well as all other entities subject to this resolution to periodically complete training concerning their duties, responsibilities and rights pursuant to this resolution.

<u>Section 7.</u> The Borough Administrator shall establish a system to monitor compliance and shall report the results of the monitoring at least annually to the Mayor and Council.

<u>Section 8.</u> At least annually, the Borough Administrator shall cause a summary of this resolution and the procedures established pursuant to this resolution to be communicated within the Borough. This communication shall include a statement from the Mayor and Council expressing the unequivocal commitment to enforce this resolution. This summary shall also be posted on the Borough of Elmwood Park's web site.

Section 9. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
