AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH SPECIFICALLY CHAPTER IV, ENTITLED "LICENSING AND BUSINESS REGULATION," MORE SPECIFICALLY SECTION 4-37.2 ENTITLED "LICENSE; APPLICATION" MORE SPECIFICALLY SECTION 4-37.2b AND SECTION 4-37.3 "LICENSE FEE; IDENTIFICATION" SAME TO BE DELETED AND REPLACED BY THE LANGUAGE CONTAINED HEREIN

INTENT OF THIS ORDINANCE

This Ordinance intends to amend a specific section of the Borough Ordinance relating to Landscaping. It is further the intent of the Borough Council to updating the particular section of the Borough Code so as to reflect the current procedure and process that is used in the issuance of the licenses need to be procured by all landscaping contractors providing landscaping and related services to the residents and property owners of the Borough of Elmwood Park.

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council have been made aware that the Building Department of the Borough of Elmwood Park, and Not the Borough Clerk, has been assigned the responsibility of accepting application from Landscaping Contractor, and issuing the required identification badges and/or stickers; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council have acknowledged and determined that there is a need to amend the Borough Code to reflect same.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park, County of Bergen, and State of New Jersey as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 4-37.2b of the Borough Code of the Borough of Elmwood Park; License; Application is hereby amended and replaced by the following language:

b. Every applicant for a license under this section shall sign an application on forms furnished by the Building Department of the Borough of Elmwood Park.

SECTION 2. Chapter 4-37.3 of the Borough Code of the Borough of Elmwood Park; License Fee; **Identification.** is hereby amended and replaced by the following language:

The license fee shall be \$25 for the first truck and \$15 for each truck thereafter per calendar year and no part of this fee shall be prorated for any part of the year. Upon payment of fee, the Building Department of the Borough of Elmwood park shall issue an identification badge or sticker for the calendar year for which the application was filed, which shall be affixed to the vehicle visibly displayed.

SECTION 3. In the event any section, part or provision of this Ordinance shall be held unconstitutional or invalid by any Court, such holding shall not affect the validity of this Ordinance, or any remaining part of this Ordinance other than the part held unconstitutional or invalid.

SECTION 4. All ordinances or parts thereof, which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance, are hereby repealed to the extent of their inconsistencies.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its final passage and publication as required by law.

BOND ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE IMPROVEMENT OF 13TH AVENUE (ENTIRE LENGTH) AND 17TH AVENUE (FROM EAST 53RD STREET TO EAST 55TH STREET) IN, BY AND FOR THE BOROUGH OF ELMWOOD PARK, IN THE COUNTY OF BERGEN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, TO APPROPRIATE THE SUM OF \$300,000 TO PAY THE COST THEREOF, TO MAKE A DOWN PAYMENT, TO AUTHORIZE THE ISSUANCE OF BONDS TO FINANCE SUCH APPROPRIATION AND TO PROVIDE FOR THE ISSUANCE OF BOND ANTICIPATION NOTES IN ANTICIPATION OF THE ISSUANCE OF SUCH BONDS.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park, in the County of Bergen, State of New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1. The Borough of Elmwood Park, in the County of Bergen, State of New Jersey (the "Borough") is hereby authorized to undertake the improvement of 13th Avenue (entire length) and 17th Avenue (from East 53rd Street to East 55th Street), including road resurfacing, construction of ADA compliant sidewalk ramps and drainage, curb and sidewalk improvements, where necessary, in, by and for the Borough. Said improvements shall include all work, materials and appurtenances necessary and suitable therefor. It is hereby determined and stated that said roads being improved are of "Class B" or equivalent construction as defined in Section 22 of the Local Bond Law (Chapter 2 of Title 40A of the New Jersey Statutes Annotated, as amended; the "Local Bond Law").

Section 2. The sum of \$300,000 is hereby appropriated to the payment of the cost of making the improvements described in Section 1 hereof (hereinafter referred to as "purpose"). Said appropriation shall be met from the proceeds of the sale of the bonds authorized and the down payment appropriated by this ordinance. It is anticipated that a grant in the amount of \$122,205 from the Bergen County Community Development Program, pursuant to the Federal Housing and Community Development Act, shall be received by the Borough to finance the cost of the improvements described in Section 1 hereof. Any of said grant funds so received shall be applied as set forth in Section 10 hereof. Said improvements shall be made as general improvements and no part of the cost thereof shall be assessed against property specially benefited.

Section 3. It is hereby determined and stated that (1) the making of such improvements is not a current expense of said Borough, and (2) it is necessary to finance said purpose by the issuance of obligations of said Borough pursuant to the Local Bond Law, and (3) the estimated cost of said purpose is \$300,000, and (4) \$15,000 of said sum is to be provided by the down payment hereinafter appropriated to finance said purpose, and (5) the estimated maximum amount of bonds or notes necessary to be issued for said purpose is \$285,000, and (6) the cost of such purpose, as hereinbefore stated, includes the aggregate amount of \$55,590 which is estimated to be necessary to finance the cost of such purpose, including architect's fees, accounting, engineering and inspection costs, legal expenses and other expenses, including interest on such obligations to the extent permitted by Section 20 of the Local Bond Law.

Section 4. It is hereby determined and stated that moneys exceeding \$15,000, appropriated for down payments on capital improvements or for the capital improvement fund in budgets heretofore adopted for said Borough, are now available to finance said purpose. The sum of \$15,000 is hereby appropriated from such moneys to the payment of the cost of said purpose.

Section 5. To finance said purpose, bonds of said Borough of an aggregate principal amount not exceeding \$285,000 are hereby authorized to be issued pursuant to the Local Bond Law. Said bonds shall bear interest at a rate per annum as may be hereafter determined within the limitations prescribed by law. All matters with respect to said bonds not determined by this ordinance shall be determined by resolutions to be hereafter adopted.

Section 6. To finance said purpose, bond anticipation notes of said Borough of an aggregate principal amount not exceeding \$285,000 are hereby authorized to be issued pursuant to the Local Bond Law in anticipation of the issuance of said bonds. In the event that bonds are issued pursuant to this ordinance, the aggregate amount of notes hereby authorized to be issued shall be reduced by an amount equal to the principal amount of the bonds so issued. If the aggregate amount of outstanding bonds and notes issued pursuant to this ordinance shall at any time exceed the sum first mentioned in this section, the moneys raised by the issuance of said bonds shall, to not less than the amount of such excess, be applied to the payment of such notes then outstanding.

Section 7. Each bond anticipation note issued pursuant to this ordinance shall be dated on or about the date of its issuance and shall be payable not more than one year from its date, shall bear interest at a rate per annum as may be hereafter determined within the limitations prescribed by law and may be renewed from time to time pursuant to and within limitations prescribed by the Local Bond Law. Each of said notes shall be signed by the Mayor and by a financial officer and shall be under the seal of said Borough and attested by the Borough Clerk or Deputy Borough Clerk. Said officers are hereby authorized to execute said notes and to issue said notes in such form as they may adopt in conformity with law. The power to determine any matters with respect to said notes not determined by this ordinance and also the power to sell said notes, is hereby delegated to the Chief Financial Officer, who is hereby authorized to sell said notes either at one time or from time to time in the manner provided by law.

Section 8. It is hereby determined and declared that the period of usefulness of said purpose, according to its reasonable life, is a period of ten years computed from the date of said bonds.

Section 9. It is hereby determined and stated that the Supplemental Debt Statement required by the Local Bond Law has been duly made and filed in the office of the Borough Clerk of said Borough, and that such statement so filed shows that the gross debt of said Borough, as defined in Section 43 of the Local Bond Law, is increased by this ordinance by \$285,000 and that the issuance of the bonds and notes authorized by this ordinance will be within all debt limitations prescribed by said Local Bond Law.

Section 10. Any funds received from private parties, the County of Bergen, the State of New Jersey or any of their agencies or any funds received from the United States of America or any of its agencies in aid of such purpose, shall be applied to the payment of the cost of such purpose, or, if bond anticipation notes have been issued, to the payment of the bond anticipation notes, and the amount of bonds authorized for such purpose shall be reduced accordingly.

Section 11. The capital budget is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency therewith and the resolutions promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing full detail of the amended capital budget and capital program as approved by the Director, Division of Local Government Services, is on file with the Borough Clerk and is available for public inspection.

Section 12. The Borough intends to issue the bonds or notes to finance the cost of the improvements described in Section 1 of this bond ordinance. If the Borough incurs such costs prior to the issuance of the bonds or notes, the Borough hereby states its reasonable expectation to reimburse itself for such expenditures with the proceeds of such bonds or notes in the maximum principal amount of bonds or notes authorized by this bond ordinance.

Section 13. The full faith and credit of the Borough are hereby pledged to the punctual payment of the principal of and the interest on the obligations authorized by this ordinance. Said obligations shall be direct, unlimited and general obligations of the Borough, and the Borough shall levy <u>ad valorem</u> taxes upon all the taxable real property within the Borough for the payment of the principal of and interest on such bonds and notes, without limitation as to rate or amount.

Section 14. This ordinance shall take effect twenty days after the first publication thereof after final passage.

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park have been made and are aware of multiple complaints from the residents regarding vehicle parking in certain areas; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council have determined that there is a need to limit and or prohibit and control such parking in certain areas; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council have determined that such limitation, control and or prohibition would advance the health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the Borough of Elmwood Park.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park that Chapter VII, Article 7-13.1 is hereby amended so as to reflect the following wording:

No person shall park any vehicle on both sides of Church Street from and between a point of 320 feet South of Market Street and from a point of 100 feet North of Memorial Place.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park, that if any provision of this amended Ordinance shall be held invalid, or contrary to the law, then such provision of the Ordinance shall be deemed separable from the remaining provisions of this Ordinance and shall not affect the validity of the other provisions of the Ordinance.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, by the Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park, that all other language contained therein shall still be valid and remain in full force and effect.

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council have become aware of the necessity to regulate the particular intersection of Florence Place and St. Anne Street for safety concerns of traffic and pedestrian crossing, in order to protect the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Borough of Elmwood Park.

SECTION 1: That by way of this Ordinance the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park do hereby designate and establish a "One Stop" at Florence Place and St. Anne Street in the Borough of Elmwood Park.

SECTION 2: The designated "One Stop" is in the interest of the public and its health, safety and welfare and the inhabitants in and near said intersection.

SECTION 3: The responsible department of the Borough of Elmwood Park shall be responsible and directed through the Borough Administrator to install the necessary "One Stop" signs at the abovementioned intersection on St. Anne right side of the intersection.

SECTION 4: Be it further Ordained by the Mayor and Council that Chapter VII of the Code of the Borough of Elmwood Park titled "Traffic" more specifically section 7-20 titled "Stop Intersections" is hereby amended so as to include thereto the "One Stop" at Florence Place and St. Anne Street as follows:

Is hereby amended to include the "One Stop" intersection of Florence Place and St. Anne Street. That traffic will stop in the direction of St. Anne Street to Florence Place.

SECTION 5: Penalties for violation. Any person who violates the provision of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be fined in accordance with the respective and appropriate fine sections of the Borough of Elmwood Park and or as set forth in the Laws of the State of New Jersey.
