**AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A “NO LEFT TURN” AT THE SOUTH BOUND LOCATION ON RIVER DRIVE AND THE ELMWOOD PARK HIGH SCHOOL ENTRANCE OR DRIVEWAY AMENDING CHAPTER VII, “TRAFFIC” OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF ELMWOOD PARK MORE SPECIFICALLY ARTICLE 7-23, “TURN PROHIBITIONS”**

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park have determined that hazardous conditions exist which require the adoption of traffic regulations prohibiting left-hand turns at certain designated intersections as a result of multiple complaints from the residents regarding vehicle turning in certain areas; and

**WHEREAS**, the governing body of the Borough of Elmwood Park finds it necessary to regulate traffic and has determined a need to regulate said traffic by prohibiting vehicles from making a left-hand turn from the southbound lane of River Drive, into the Elmwood Park Memorial High School property or driveway.

**WHEREAS**, the governing body of the Borough of Elmwood Park believes that these traffic regulations are necessary in order to protect the health, safety and welfare of those individuals who reside in the area of these designated intersections, as well as the safety of the public at large.

**NOW THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY ORDANED**, by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park, in County of Bergen and State of New Jersey, as follows:

**SECTION 1.** That Chapter VII, entitled “Traffic” of the code of the Borough of Elmwood Park more specifically subsection 7-23 entitled “turn Prohibitions” is hereby amended so as to reflect and include the following no left turns wording:

No person shall make a left turn on River Drive from the southbound direction into the Elmwood Park Memorial High School property or driveway.

**SECTION 2.** The responsible department of the Borough of Elmwood Park shall be responsible and directed through the Borough Administrator to install the necessary signs at the above-mentioned intersection.

**SECTION 3. Penalties for violation.** Any person who violates the provision of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be fined in accordance to the respective and appropriate fine sections of the Borough of Elmwood Park and or as set forth in the Laws of the State of New Jersey.

**SECTION 4. Enforcement.** The Police Chief and the Police Department of the Borough of Elmwood Park shall assist and enforce the provisions of this Ordinance.

**SECTION 5. Repealer.** All Ordinances of the Borough of Elmwood Park to the extent that same are not inconsistent with this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect until modified or repealed pursuant to law. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed as to such inconsistencies.

**SECTION 6: Invalid Provisions.:** If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

**SECTION 7: Effective Date.:** This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage and publication thereof as provide by law.

ON CERTAIN DAYS”**

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park have been and are aware of multiple complaints from the residents regarding vehicle parking in certain areas; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and Council has determined that there is a need to limit and or prohibit and control such parking in certain areas; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and Council has determined that such limitation, control and or prohibition would advance the health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the Borough of Elmwood Park.

**NOW THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY ORDANED**, by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park that Chapter VII, Article 7-14.1 is hereby amended so as to reflect the following wording:

No person shall park any vehicle on 16<sup>TH</sup> Avenue north side of the street approximately 125 feet from a point 175 feet West of 53<sup>rd</sup> Street to a point of 300 feet west of 53<sup>rd</sup> Street. Same shall be designated as “SCHOOL BUS PARKING ONLY” between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 8:30 a.m. and 2:30 p.m. to 3:30 p.m. Monday through Friday school days except for Saturday, Sunday, and Holidays

**BE IT, FURTHER ORDANED**, by the Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park, that if any provision of this amended Ordinance shall be held invalid, or contrary to the law, then such provision of the Ordinance shall be deemed separable from the remaining provisions of this Ordinance and shall not affect the validity of the other provisions of the Ordinance.

**BE IT, FURTHER ORDANED**, by the Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park, that all other language contained therein shall still be valid and remain in full force and effect.

**BE IT, FURTHER ORDANED**, this Amended Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its final passage and publication as required by law.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park, in the County of Bergen, State of New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1. The Borough of Elmwood Park, in the County of Bergen, State of New Jersey (the "Borough") is hereby authorized to undertake the improvement of 13th Avenue and 14th Avenue (each from East 53rd Street to East 55th Street), including road resurfacing, construction of ADA compliant sidewalk ramps and drainage, curb and sidewalk improvements, where necessary, in, by and for the Borough. Said improvements shall include all work, materials and appurtenances necessary and suitable therefor. It is hereby determined and stated that said roads being improved are of "Class B" or equivalent construction as defined in Section 22 of the Local Bond Law (Chapter 2 of Title 40A of the New Jersey Statutes Annotated, as amended; the "Local Bond Law").

Section 2. The sum of \$200,000 is hereby appropriated to the payment of the cost of making the improvements described in Section 1 hereof (hereinafter referred to as "purpose"). Said appropriation shall be met from the proceeds of the sale of the bonds authorized and the down payment appropriated by this ordinance. It is anticipated that a grant in the amount of \$130,000 from the Bergen County Community Development Program, pursuant to the Federal Housing and Community Development Act, shall be received by the Borough to finance the cost of the improvements described in Section 1 hereof. Any of said grant funds so received shall be applied as set forth in Section 10 hereof. Said improvements shall be made as general improvements and no part of the cost thereof shall be assessed against property specially benefited.

Section 3. It is hereby determined and stated that (1) the making of such improvements is not a current expense of said Borough, and (2) it is necessary to finance said purpose by the issuance of obligations of said Borough pursuant to the Local Bond Law, and (3) the estimated cost of said purpose is \$200,000, and (4) \$10,000 of said sum is to be provided by the down payment hereinafter appropriated to finance said purpose, and (5) the estimated maximum amount of bonds or notes necessary to be issued for said purpose is \$190,000, and (6) the cost of such purpose, as hereinbefore stated, includes the aggregate amount of \$35,000 which is estimated to be necessary to finance the cost of such purpose, including architect's fees, accounting, engineering and inspection costs, legal expenses and other expenses, including interest on such obligations to the extent permitted by Section 20 of the Local Bond Law.

Section 4. It is hereby determined and stated that moneys exceeding \$10,000, appropriated for down payments on capital improvements or for the capital improvement fund in budgets heretofore adopted for said Borough, are now available to finance said purpose. The sum of \$10,000 is hereby appropriated from such moneys to the payment of the cost of said purpose.

Section 5. To finance said purpose, bonds of said Borough of an aggregate principal amount not exceeding \$190,000 are hereby authorized to be issued pursuant to the Local Bond Law. Said bonds shall bear interest at a rate per annum as may be hereafter determined within the limitations prescribed by law. All matters with respect to said bonds not determined by this ordinance shall be determined by resolutions to be hereafter adopted.

Section 6. To finance said purpose, bond anticipation notes of said Borough of an aggregate principal amount not exceeding \$190,000 are hereby authorized to be issued pursuant to the Local Bond Law in anticipation of the issuance of said bonds. In the event that bonds are issued pursuant to this ordinance, the aggregate amount of notes hereby authorized to be issued shall be reduced by an amount equal to the principal amount of the bonds so issued. If the aggregate amount of outstanding bonds and notes issued pursuant to this ordinance shall at any time exceed the sum first mentioned in this section, the moneys raised by the issuance of said

bonds shall, to not less than the amount of such excess, be applied to the payment of such notes then outstanding.

Section 7. Each bond anticipation note issued pursuant to this ordinance shall be dated on or about the date of its issuance and shall be payable not more than one year from its date, shall bear interest at a rate per annum as may be hereafter determined within the limitations prescribed by law and may be renewed from time to time pursuant to and within limitations prescribed by the Local Bond Law. Each of said notes shall be signed by the Mayor and by a financial officer and shall be under the seal of said Borough and attested by the Borough Clerk or Deputy Borough Clerk. Said officers are hereby authorized to execute said notes and to issue said notes in such form as they may adopt in conformity with law. The power to determine any matters with respect to said notes not determined by this ordinance and also the power to sell said notes, is hereby delegated to the Chief Financial Officer, who is hereby authorized to sell said notes either at one time or from time to time in the manner provided by law.

Section 8. It is hereby determined and declared that the period of usefulness of said purpose, according to its reasonable life, is a period of ten years computed from the date of said bonds.

Section 9. It is hereby determined and stated that the Supplemental Debt Statement required by the Local Bond Law has been duly made and filed in the office of the Borough Clerk of said Borough, and that such statement so filed shows that the gross debt of said Borough, as defined in Section 43 of the Local Bond Law, is increased by this ordinance by \$190,000 and that the issuance of the bonds and notes authorized by this ordinance will be within all debt limitations prescribed by said Local Bond Law.

Section 10. Any funds received from private parties, the County of Bergen, the State of New Jersey or any of their agencies or any funds received from the United States of America or any of its agencies in aid of such purpose, shall be applied to the payment of the cost of such purpose, or, if bond anticipation notes have been issued, to the payment of the bond anticipation notes, and the amount of bonds authorized for such purpose shall be reduced accordingly.

Section 11. The capital budget is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency therewith and the resolutions promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing full detail of the amended capital budget and capital program as approved by the Director, Division of Local Government Services, is on file with the Borough Clerk and is available for public inspection.

Section 12. The Borough intends to issue the bonds or notes to finance the cost of the improvements described in Section 1 of this bond ordinance. If the Borough incurs such costs prior to the issuance of the bonds or notes, the Borough hereby states its reasonable expectation to reimburse itself for such expenditures with the proceeds of such bonds or notes in the maximum principal amount of bonds or notes authorized by this bond ordinance.

Section 13. The full faith and credit of the Borough are hereby pledged to the punctual payment of the principal of and the interest on the obligations authorized by this ordinance. Said obligations shall be direct, unlimited and general obligations of the Borough, and the Borough shall levy ad valorem taxes upon all the taxable real property within the Borough for the payment of the principal of and interest on such bonds and notes, without limitation as to rate or amount.

Section 14. This ordinance shall take effect twenty days after the first publication thereof after final passage.

**INTENT OF THIS ORDINANCE**

This Ordinance intends to address and clarify a specific section of the housing regulation regarding assessing penalties for the violation. It is further the intent of the Mayor and Council to update and clarify the penalties for the violation so as to allow a grace period after notice of violation for the owner, occupant and resident time to cure said violation and upon failure to do so establish a graduating fine amounts to be assessed as penalties to discourage habitual violations.

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and Council have become aware of health, safety and welfare concerns that exist with regards to the abuse of unlawful apartments and their use in the Borough, and this amended is being introduced to promote the compliance and deter the use of unlawful apartment in dwellings being used in violation of the zoning Code of the Borough and in furtherance of the health, safety and welfare concerns of the residents of the Borough of Elmwood Park; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and Council have acknowledged and determined that the utilization of unlawful apartment have reached a level of concerns and have become a hazard to the health, safety and the welfare of the public; and

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED** by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park, County of Bergen, and State of New Jersey as follows:

**SECTION 1:** Chapter XI of the Code of the Borough of Elmwood Park entitled "Housing" more specifically section 11-4.14 entitled "Penalty for Violation" more specifically part a. is hereby amended and replaced by the following language:

- a. Upon determination that a violation exists:
  1. Whereupon there is a determination that a violation exists the owner, landlord, tenant and or occupant shall be served with a notice of said violation which shall provide a 30 day period in which the owner, landlord, tenant or occupant shall be afforded the opportunity to cure or abate the condition and shall also be afforded an opportunity for a hearing before a court of competent jurisdiction for an independent determination concerning the violation.
  2. if a court has not determined otherwise or, upon reinspection of the property, it is determined that the abatement has not been substantially completed.
    - a. Whereupon there is a determination that the court finds that a violation exists, upon such findings and determination, the court shall impose one or more of the following for each and every violation hereof:, Subsequent to the expiration of the 30-day period and or subsequent to the afforded opportunity for a hearing before a court of competent jurisdiction and the determination thereof, a fine shall be imposed and shall be assessed by a court of competent jurisdiction
      1. For the first offense there shall be assessed a fine of a minimum of \$1,500.00.
      2. For the second violation and offense there shall be a minimum sum of \$2,000.00.
      3. For a third violation and offense there shall be assessed a fine of not less than \$2,500.00
      4. For any and all subsequent violation the court can impose a term of imprisonment not to exceed 90 days and/or
      5. A period of community service not exceeding 90 days.
    - b. Each day in which the owner, landlord, tenant and/or occupant violates a provision of this section it shall be deemed a separate offense.



**SECTION 2.** In the event any section, part or provision of this Ordinance shall be held unconstitutional or invalid by any Court, such holding shall not affect the validity of this Ordinance, or any remaining part of this Ordinance other than the part held unconstitutional or invalid.

**SECTION 3.** All ordinances or parts thereof, which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance, are hereby repealed to the extent of their inconsistencies.

To finance said purpose, bond anticipation notes of said Borough of an aggregate principal amount not exceeding \$104,700 are hereby authorized to be issued pursuant to the Local Bond Law in anticipation of the issuance of said bonds. In the event that bonds are issued pursuant to this ordinance, the aggregate amount of notes hereby authorized to be issued shall be reduced by an amount equal to the principal amount of the bonds so issued. If the aggregate amount of outstanding bonds and notes issued pursuant to this ordinance shall at any time exceed the sum first mentioned in this section, the moneys raised by the issuance of said bonds shall, to not less than the amount of such excess, be applied to the payment of such notes then outstanding.

Section 7. Each bond anticipation note issued pursuant to this ordinance shall be dated on or about the date of its issuance and shall be payable not more than one year from its date, shall bear interest at a rate per annum as may be hereafter determined within the limitations prescribed by law and may be renewed from time to time pursuant to and within limitations prescribed by the Local Bond Law. Each of said notes shall be signed by the Mayor and by a financial officer and shall be under the seal of said Borough and attested by the Borough Clerk or Deputy Borough Clerk. Said officers are hereby authorized to execute said notes and to issue said notes in such form as they may adopt in conformity with law. The power to determine any matters with respect to said notes not determined by this ordinance and also the power to sell said notes, is hereby delegated to the Chief Financial Officer, who is hereby authorized to sell said notes either at one time or from time to time in the manner provided by law.

Section 8. It is hereby determined and declared that the period of usefulness of said purpose, according to its reasonable life, is a period of ten years computed from the date of said bonds.

Section 9. It is hereby determined and stated that the Supplemental Debt Statement required by the Local Bond Law has been duly made and filed in the office of the Borough Clerk of said Borough, and that such statement so filed shows that the gross debt of said Borough, as defined in Section 43 of the Local Bond Law, is increased by this ordinance by \$104,700 and that the issuance of the bonds and notes authorized by this ordinance will be within all debt limitations prescribed by said Local Bond Law.

Section 10. Any funds received from private parties, the County of Bergen, the State of New Jersey or any of their agencies or any funds received from the United States of America or any of its agencies in aid of such purpose, shall be applied to the payment of the cost of such purpose, or, if bond anticipation notes have been issued, to the payment of the bond anticipation notes, and the amount of bonds authorized for such purpose shall be reduced accordingly.

Section 11. The capital budget is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency therewith and the resolutions promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing full detail of the amended capital budget and capital program as approved by the Director, Division of Local Government Services, is on file with the Borough Clerk and is available for public inspection.

Section 12. The Borough intends to issue the bonds or notes to finance the cost of the improvement described in Section 1 of this bond ordinance. If the Borough incurs such costs prior to the issuance of the bonds or notes, the Borough hereby states its reasonable expectation to reimburse itself for such expenditures with the proceeds of such bonds or notes in the maximum principal amount of bonds or notes authorized by this bond ordinance.

Section 13. The full faith and credit of the Borough are hereby pledged to the punctual payment of the principal of and the interest on the obligations authorized by this ordinance. Said obligations shall be direct, unlimited and general obligations of the Borough, and the Borough shall levy ad valorem taxes upon all the taxable real property within the Borough for the payment of the principal of and interest on such bonds and notes, without limitation as to rate or amount.

Section 14. This ordinance shall take effect twenty days after the first publication thereof after final passage.

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ARTICLE III OF THE CODE OF THE  
BOROUGH OF ELMWOOD PARK TITLED "DEPARTMENT OF THE

2-27 ENTITLED "POLICE DEPARTMENT." MORE SPECIFICALLY  
SECTION 2-27.1 ENTITLED "CREATION OF THE DEPARTMENT;  
MEMBERS" CREATING THE POSITION OF CHAPLAIN FOR THE  
ELMWOOD PARK POLICE DEPARTMENT**

**WHEREAS**, the governing body of any municipality, by ordinance, may provide for the appointment of one or more chaplains to the police department or force pursuant to **N.J.S.A. 40A:14-141**; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and Council have determined that a presence of a chaplain(s) position(s) in the Police Department would be a great help and assistance to the members of the Police Department, and by doing so would provide a moral and invaluable service to the police department in assisting to make the same more efficient in its operation and to protect the health and safety of the residents of the Borough of Elmwood Park.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED** by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park, County of Bergen, and State of New Jersey as follows:

**SECTION 1:** Chapter 2, Article III of the Code of the Borough of Elmwood Park titled "Department of Local Government" more specifically section 2-27.1 Creation of the Department; Members, shall be amended to so as to add the following language and the following.

**Section a.** Shall be amended to reflect a new subsection 5 which shall read as follows:

5. There shall be created the position of Police Chaplain(s)

**New Section 2-27.27** shall be inserted to read as follows:

**2-27.27 Creation of position; statutory authority; qualifications; duties; term.**

- A. The position of Police Chaplain for the Borough of Elmwood Park is hereby created in accordance with N.J.S.A. 40A:14-141. The position will be a volunteer position. The position of Police Chaplain shall be subject to the control of the Chief of Police.
- B. The Chief of Police shall recommend to the Borough Administrator person(s) that he/she believes meets the qualifications of N.J.S.A. 40A:14-141 as well as the rules and regulations of the Borough of Elmwood Park Police Department with reference to chaplains, if any. All applicants for the position of Chaplain shall be reviewed by the Chief of Police and Borough Administrator to determine that his/her qualifications are in accordance with this article and shall make recommendations to the Mayor and Council. The Mayor and Council shall appoint Chaplains in accordance with this article.
- C. Any person appointed as Chaplain shall be an ordained clergyman in good standing in the religious body from which he/she is selected. The Chaplain shall be a certified Police Chaplain credentialed in accordance with the rules and regulations of the Borough of Elmwood Park Police Department and shall be qualified in accordance with N.J.S.A. 40A:14-141.
- D. The duties of the Police Chaplain shall include, but not be limited to, assisting the Borough of Elmwood Park Police Department and all other Elmwood Park emergency service organizations in any duties that may be assigned by the Chief of Police that pertain to the Police Chaplaincy.
- E. Any person appointed as Chaplain shall serve in that capacity without rank or salary. The position will be a volunteer position.
- F. A person appointed as Chaplain shall serve from the date of appointment and shall continue in that capacity for a period of one year or until such time as reappointed or a replacement is appointed, the initial period shall be from the first date of appointment till December 31 of the year of appointment, and every year thereafter until termination, resignation, or retirement from the position. The Chief of Police shall be notified and consulted should any of these options be exercised.

**SECTION 2: Remaining Part Unchanged.** All of the remaining parts of the Ordinance relating to Article III, known as Department of the Local Government of the Borough of Elmwood Park to the extent that they are not inconsistent with this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect until modified or repealed pursuant to law. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed as to such inconsistencies.

**SECTION 3: Invalid Provisions.** If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

**SECTION 4: Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage and publication thereof as provided by law.
