AN ORDINANCE EASTABLISHING A "4-WAY STOP" AT THE INTERSECTIONS OF KIPP AVENUE AND RAY STREET AND TO AMEND CHAPTER VII OF THE CODEOF THE BOROUGH OF ELMWOOD PARK TITLED "TRAFFIC" MORE SPECIFICALLY SECTION 7-21 TITLED "MULTIWAY STOP INTERSECTIONS"

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council have become aware of the necessity to regulate the particular four-way intersection of Kipp Avenue and Ray Street for safety concerns of traffic and pedestrian crossing, in order to protect the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Borough of Elmwood Park.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park, County of Bergen, and State of New Jersey and pursuant to N.J.S.A. 39:4-140 of the laws of the state of New Jersey the Mayor and Council ordains as follows:

SECTION 1: That by way of this Ordinance the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park do hereby designate and establish a "4-Way Stop" at the intersections of Kipp Avenue and Ray Street in the Borough of Elmwood Park.

SECTION 2: The designated "4-Way Stop" is in the interest of the public and its health, safety and welfare and the inhabitants in and near said intersection.

SECTION 3: The responsible department of the Borough of Elmwood Park shall be responsible and directed through the Borough Administrator to install the necessary "4-Way Stop" signs at the abovementioned intersection.

SECTION 4: Be it further Ordained by the Mayor and Council that Chapter VII of the Code of the Borough of Elmwood Park titled "Traffic" more specifically section 7-21 titled "Multi-Way Stop Intersections is hereby amended so as to include thereto the "4-Way Stop" intersection of Kipp Avenue and Ray Street as follows:

7-21 Multi-way stop intersections.

Adopted: December 15, 2022

Is hereby amended to include the "4-Way Stop" intersection of Kipp Avenue and Ray Street. That traffic will stop in all direction.

SECTION 5: Penalties for violation. Any person who violates the provision of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be fined in accordance to the respective and appropriate fine sections of the Borough of Elmwood Park and or as set forth in the Laws of the State of New Jersey.

SECTION 6: The Police Chief and the Police Department of the Borough of Elmwood Park, shall assist and enforce the provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 7: Repealer. All Ordinances of the Borough of Elmwood Park to the extent that same are not inconsistent with this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect until modified or repealed pursuant to law. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed as to such inconsistencies.

SECTION 3: Invalid Provisions.: If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4: Effective Date.: This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage and publication thereof as provide by law.

AN ORDINANCE EASTABLISHING A "4-WAY STOP" AT THE INTERSECTIONS OF GROVE STREET AND GRANT STREET AND TO AMEND CHAPTER VII OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF ELMWOOD PARK TITLED "TRAFFIC" MORE SPECIFICALLY SECTION 7-21 TITLED "MULTI-WAY STOP INTERSECTIONS"

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council have become aware of the necessity to regulate the particular fourway intersection of Grove Street and Grant Street for safety concerns of traffic and pedestrian crossing, in order to protect the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Borough of Elmwood Park.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park,

County of Bergen, and State of New Jersey and pursuant to N.J.S.A. 39:4-140 of the laws of the state of New Jersey the Mayor and Council ordains as follows:

SECTION 1: That by way of this Ordinance the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park do hereby designate and establish a "4-Way Stop" at the intersections of Grove Street and Grant Street in the Borough of Elmwood Park.

SECTION 2: The designated "4-Way Stop" is in the interest of the public and its health, safety and welfare and the inhabitants in and near said intersection.

SECTION 3: The responsible department of the Borough of Elmwood Park shall be responsible and directed through the Borough Administrator to install the necessary "4-Way Stop" signs at the abovementioned intersection.

SECTION 4: Be it further Ordained by the Mayor and Council that Chapter VII of the Code of the Borough of Elmwood Park titled "Traffic" more specifically section 7-21 titled "Multi-Way Stop Intersections is hereby amended so as to include thereto the "4-Way Stop" intersection of Grove Street and Grant Street as follows:

7-21 Multi-way stop intersections.

Is hereby amended to include the "4-Way Stop" intersection of Grove Street and Grant Street. That traffic will stop in all direction.

SECTION 5: Penalties for violation. Any person who violates the provision of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be fined in accordance to the respective and appropriate fine sections of the Borough of Elmwood Park and or as set forth in the Laws of the State of New Jersey.

SECTION 6: The Police Chief and the Police Department of the Borough of Elmwood Park, shall assist and enforce the provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 7: Repealer. AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE BOROUGH CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF ELMWOOD PARK CHAPTERS 2 ADMINISTRATION, ARTICE II OFFICES CREATED, SECTION 2-23 TO BE REFERED TO AS BOROUGH PHYSICIAN AND MEDICAL PROVIDER. SECTION 2-24 THROUGH 26 SHALL REMAIN RESERVED

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council have deemed it necessary and appropriate to amend the Borough Code to create the position of Borough Physician and Medical Provider so as to allow the Borough flexibility in hiring appropriate medical professionals to provide medical services for Borough employee cases.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park, County of Bergen, and State of New Jersey as follows:

SECTION 1: CHAPTER II of the code of the borough of Elmwood Park titled "**ADMINISTRATION**" more specifically **ARTICLE II "OFFICES CREATED" SECTION 2-23** titled "**RESERVED**" shall be titled "**BOROUGH PHYSICIAN AND MEDICAL PROVIDER**".

Section 2-23 shall be amended to be referred to and read "BOROUGH PHYSICIAN AND MEDICAL PROVIDER"

Section 2-23.1 Shall be titled to as Appointment; Term; Removal.

- (a) The Physician and Medical Provider will be selected annually by the Mayor and Council upon review of proposals submitted pursuant to requests for proposals advertised under the fair and open process described under N.J.S.A. 19:44A-1 et seq. Requests for proposals shall be issued annually.
- **(b)** The Physician and Medical Provider will serve for a period of one year from the date of hire and will be and remain in effect at the pleasure of the Governing Body.

Section 2-23.2 shall be titled to and be read as **Qualifications.**

- (a) The Physician and Medical Provider shell be licensed to practice in the State of New Jersey.
- (b) The Physician and Medical Provider shall be certified by ABIM/ABMS.
- (c) The Physician and Medical Provider shall be a member in good standing in the medical community of the State of New Jersey.
- (d) The Physician and Medical Provider shall be Board Certified and maintain a valid State of New jersey medical license

Section 2-23.2 shall be titled to and be read as Compensation.

(a) The compensation for the Physician and Medical Provider position shall be the sum of \$5,500 annually to be paid in equal monthly installments.

Section 2-23.3 shall be titled to and be read as **Duties.**

- (a) Physician shall be responsible for:
 - 1. Conducting preemployment or preservice medical examinations.
 - 2. Conducting return from illness or injury examinations for any illness or injury lasting more than three days
 - 3. Providing a written report regarding the findings and status of the policeman or fireman examined regarding his/her fitness for duty.
 - 4. Medical evaluation of injured member officers, municipal member employees and or suspects and detainees
 - 5. Medical evaluation of 504 requests.
 - 6. On site emergency physician services for events and catastrophes.
 - 7. Emergency medical planning for all hazards including CBRN
 - 8. Medical liaison for State and Local DOH
 - 9. Stand by and/or in person, medical coverage of township special events, i.e. July 4th, local emergency, etc.

- 10. Being available on an on-call basis to schedule physical examinations at other times during the normal business week or arranging for such examination by another physician under his/her direction and control at no additional cost to the Borough of Elmwood Park.
- 11. Providing an annual physical to member employees of the Borough and members of the fire and police force on a voluntary basis.
- 12. Medical directions were indicated for policies involving illness or injury
- 13. Medical review of use of force policies and procedures for potential injuries, when applicable for the police department.
- 14. Medical coverage and emergency care for training sessions, ie qualifications, UOF, etc.
- 15. Standing orders and 24/7 consultation for member employees and police, i.e., oxygen, Narcan, EpiPen, ACLS medications, vaccinations, etc.

Section 2-23.5 shall be titled as **Compensation.**

(a) The Borough Physician and or Medical Provider shall receive compensation as shall be fixed, from time to time, by general salary ordinance. However, said compensation shall not be reduced during the term of office, except by a two-thirds (2/3) majority vote of the Borough Council.

SECTION 2: Repealer.

All of the remaining part of the Ordinance relating to Article II known as Offices Created of the Local Government of the Borough of Elmwood Park to the extent that same are not inconsistent with this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect until modified or repealed pursuant to law. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed as to such inconsistencies.

WHEREAS, The New Jersey Local Redevelopment and Housing Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:12A-1 et. seq. (the "LRHL") authorizes municipalities to determine whether certain parcels of land within the municipality constitute an "area in need of redevelopment" as described in Section 5 of the LRHL; and

WHEREAS, to determine whether a certain parcel of land constitutes an area in need of redevelopment, the Governing Board of the Borough of Elmwood Park by way of Resolution No.: 206-22 dated May 19, 2022, authorized and directed the Elmwood Park Planning Board to conduct a preliminary investigation to determine whether the area identified as Block 1202, Lot 21 as shown on the Tax map of the Borough of Elmwood Park consisting of approximately .733 acres (the "Study Area") meets the criteria set forth in Section 5 of the LRHL and should be designated as an "area in need of redevelopment, non-condemnation"; and

WHEREAS, the Board authorized the undertaking of the preliminary investigation as to whether the Study Area, or any portion thereof, constitutes an area in need of redevelopment, non-condemnation, in accordance with the LRHL; and

WHEREAS, the LRHL requires the Board to conduct a public hearing prior to making its determination whether the Study Area should be designated as "as area in need of redevelopment, non-condemnation", at which hearing the Board shall hear all persons who are interested in or would be affected by a determination that the Study Area is a redevelopment area; and

WHEREAS, the LRHL requires that the Board, prior to conducting such public hearing, publish notice in a newspaper of general circulation in the Borough once each week for two consecutive weeks, with the last publication made not less than ten (10) days prior to such public hearing; and

WHEREAS, the LRHL further requires that such notice be mailed at least ten (10) days prior to such public hearing to the last owners of the relevant properties in accordance with the Borough's assessment records; and

WHEREAS, the Board held a public hearing (the "Public Hearing") to determine whether the Study Area is "an area in need of redevelopment" under the criteria set forth in Section 5 of the LRHL at a regular meeting of the Board on November 10, 2022; and

WHEREAS, notice of the Public Hearing was provided in the official newspaper of the Borough on two consecutive weeks, the last being not less than ten (10) days before the Public Hearing; and

WHEREAS, the Public Hearing, Daniel Hauben, P.P. ("Hauben") of the Firm DMR Architects, the Borough's Special Planner, presented a report dated June 2022 entitled, "Preliminary Investigation for Determination of an Area in Need of Redevelopment, Block 1202, Lot 21" concerning the determination of the Study Area as an "area in need of redevelopment"

WHEREAS, at the Public Hearing, the Board reviewed the Report, heard the testimony of Hauben, as well as members of the public who were given the opportunity to testify and to ask questions of the Board and of Reiner; and

WHEREAS, after the conclusion of the Public Hearing, the Board voted to determine that Block 1202, Lot 21 should be designated as an Area in Need of Re-Development; and

WHEREAS, on December 14, 2022, the Planning Board adopted a Resolution memorializing its finds and recommending that the subject property be designated as an Area In Need of Redevelopment by the Governing Body; and

WHEREAS, on December 15, 2022 the Governing Body of the Borough of Elmwood Park reviewed December 14, 2022 Planning Board Resolution along with the Report prepared by DMR Architects; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the Borough of Elmwood Park determines that, based upon the Planning Board's recommendation there is substantial credible evidence to designate the Study Area as an "area in need of redevelopment, non-condemnation"; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Board of the Borough of Elmwood Park determines that Block 1202, Lot 21 meets the statutory criteria as an "area in need of redevelopment" pursuant the LRHL; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park as follows:

- 1. The aforementioned recitals hereof are incorporated herein as though set forth at length herein;
- 2. The Mayor and Council adopt the Study and Findings of the Area In Need of Redevelopment Study for the Study Area as though set forth at length herein;
- 3. Block 1202, Lot 21 satisfies the criteria of N.J.S.A. 40A:12A-5 as set forth in the Study, testified to by Mr. Hauben and set forth herein and is hereby designated as an area in need of redevelopment, non-condemnation;
- 4. In connection with the redevelopment of the properties in the Study Area, the Borough shall be authorized to use all the powers provided under the LRHL for use in a redevelopment area with the except of the power of eminent domain.
- 5. DMR Architects is hereby authorized and directed to prepare a redevelopment plan for the Study Area.
