WHEREAS, the 2024 Municipal Budget did not pass at the May 30, 2024 special meeting.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park, in the County of Bergen, State of New Jersey hereby adopt the 2024 Municipal Budget set forth herein and shall constitute an appropriation for the purposes stated of the sums therein set forth as appropriations, and authorization in the amount of \$21,657,228.00 for municipal purposes:
